Designed and made by Sally Ablett

Size 60" x 60" - unfinish block size $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ "



Main diagram

Requirements

Fabrics from the Thalssophile collection:

- 1. A463.2 Under the sea on dark cream 1yd 1mtr
- 2. A467.2 Boats on sea green ³/₄yd ³/₄mtr
- 3. A465.3 Shells on blue grey 3/2 yd 40cm
- 4. A466.3 Seahorses on coral 3/8yd 40cm
- 5. A464.3 Coastal stripe on dark blue 1yd 1mtr
- 6. BB111 Bumbleberries Indigo 1¼yd 1.10
- 7. BB94 Bumbleberries Light grey 3/8yd 40cm

Wadding and backing 64" x 64"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You will need to join your strips to get the length for the inner border

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

10 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1) 5 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1) 20 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

16 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2) 4 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 2) 16 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 2

20 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block1) 5 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1) 20 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 3 cut

20 x 3³/₈" x 3³/₈" (block 1) 16 x 3³/₈" x 3³/₈" (block 2)

From fabric 4 cut

8 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2) 4 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2) 16 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

From fabric 5 cut

56 x 4¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" (border)

From fabric 6 cut

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " (sides for inner border) $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " (top & bottom of inner border) $10 \times 4\frac{1}{8}$ " x $4\frac{1}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block1) $10 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block1)

From fabric 7 cut

 $8 \times 4\%$ " x 4%" cut in half diagonally once (block2) 8 x 5%" x 5%" cut in half diagonally twice (block2)

Making up the blocks

Block 1 and block 2 are made up in the same way.









Lay out the fabric pieces for the centre of the block.



Stitch the small triangles to the larger

triangle. Long sides of small triangle to the short sides of the larger triangle. Lay out as in the diagram and stitch the rows and then sew the rows together to complete the centre of the block.

Next



Stitch a small triangle to each side of

the square and then sew a larger triangle to each side of this unit.

Corner squares

Sew the two triangles together to made a square. Now lay your piece for the block. Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the blocks. 5 of block 1 and 4 of block 2

Complete the quilt centre

Place your blocks out as in the main diagram. Sew the rows together and the rows together to complete the centre of the quilt.

Press each row in the opposite way this will help when sewing the rows together.

Inner border

Sew the side strips to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

Outer border

Lay out as in the diagram, stitch 13 of the squares together for the sides and stitch to quilt. For the top and bottom strips you need 15 squares.

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.



Fabrics from the Thalssophile collection:

- 1. A463.1 Under the sea on pale blue 1yd 1mtr
- 2. A467.3 Boats on dark blue ³/₄yd ³/₄mtr
- 3. A465.1 Shells on coral pink 3/yd 40cm
- 4. A466.1 Seahorses on sand 3/8 yd 40cm
- 5. A464.1 Coastal stripe on dark cream 1yd 1mtr
- 6. BB205 Bumbleberries Duck egg 1¼yd 1.10
- 7. BB216 Bumbleberries Pink terracotta 3//yd 40cm

Wadding and backing 64" x 64"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You will need to join your strips to get the length for the inner border

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

10 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1) 5 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1) 20 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

16 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2) 4 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 2) 16 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 2

20 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block1) 5 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1) 20 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 3 cut

20 x 3³/₈" x 3³/₈" (block 1) 16 x 3³/₈" x 3³/₈" (block 2)

From fabric 4 cut

8 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2) 4 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2) 16 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

From fabric 5 cut

56 x 4¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" (border)

From fabric 6 cut

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " (sides for inner border) $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " (top & bottom of inner border) $10 \times 4\frac{1}{8}$ " x $4\frac{1}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block1) $10 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block1)

From fabric 7 cut

 $8 \times 4\%$ " x 4%" cut in half diagonally once (block2) 8 x 5%" x 5%" cut in half diagonally twice (block2)

Making up the blocks

Block 1 and block 2 are made up in the same way.





Block 1



Lay out the fabric pieces for the centre of the block.



triangle. Lay out as in the diagram and stitch the rows and then sew the rows together to complete the centre of the block.

Stitch a small triangle to each side

of the square and then sew a larger triangle to each side of this unit.

Corner squares

Sew the two triangles together to made a square. Now lay your piece for the block. Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the blocks. 5 of block 1 and 4 of block 2

Complete the quilt centre

Place your blocks out as in the main diagram. Sew the rows together and the rows together to complete the centre of the quilt.

Press each row in the opposite way this will help when sewing the rows together.

Inner border

Sew the side strips to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

Outer border

Lay out as in the diagram, stitch 13 of the squares together for the sides and stitch to quilt. For the top and bottom strips you need 15 squares.

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.

Wadding and backing 64" x 64"

10 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1) 5 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1) 20 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

16 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2) 4 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 2) 16 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 2

20 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block1) 5 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1) 20 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 3 cut

20 x 3³/₈" x 3³/₈" (block 1) 16 x 3³/₈" x 3³/₈" (block 2)

From fabric 4 cut

8 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2) 4 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2) 16 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

From fabric 5 cut

56 x 41/2" x 41/2" (border)

From fabric 6 cut

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " (sides for inner border) $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " (top & bottom of inner border) $10 \times 4\frac{1}{8}$ " x $4\frac{1}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block1) $10 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block1)

From fabric 7 cut

 $8 \times 4\%$ " x 4%" cut in half diagonally once (block2) 8 x 5%" x 5%" cut in half diagonally twice (block2)

Making up the blocks

Block 1 and block 2 are made up in the same way.

Lay out the fabric pieces for the centre of the block.



Stitch the small triangles to the larger
