4. A466.3-Seahorses on coral $-3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
5. A464.3-Coastal stripe on dark blue - 1yd - 1 mtr
6. BB111-Bumbleberries Indigo- $11 / 4 \mathrm{yd}-1.10$
7. BB94-Bumbleberries Light grey $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$

Wadding and backing 64" x 64"
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.
You will need to join your strips to get the length for the inner border

$10 \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block 1 ) $5 \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ (block 1 )
$20 \times 2^{7 / 8 "} \times 2^{7 / 8 "}$ cut in half diagonally once (block 1 )
$16 \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block 2 )
$4 \times 5 \frac{1}{4} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 4} \mathbf{4}^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)
$16 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{11 / 2 " ~(b l o c k ~ 2) ~}$

## From fabric 2

$20 \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block1)
$5 \times 51 / 4 " \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice (block 1 )
$20 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{11 / 2 " ~(b l o c k ~ 1) ~}$

$20 \times 33 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 33 /{ }^{\prime \prime \prime}$ (block 1)
$16 \times 33 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (block 2)

## From fabric 4 cut

$8 \times 47 / 8$ " $\times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block 2)
$4 \times 4 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 411 / 2 "$ (block 2)
$16 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block 2 )

$56 \times 41122^{\prime \prime} \times 4 ½ "$ (border)

## From fabric 6 cut

$2 \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 52^{1 / 2 " 1}$ (sides for inner border)
$2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (top \& bottom of inner border)
$10 \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block1)
$10 \times 51^{1 / 4} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice (block1)

## From fabric 7 cut

$8 \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block2) $8 \times 5 \frac{1}{4} 4 \times 51 / 4 "$ cut in half diagonally twice (block2)

## Making up the blocks

Block 1 and block 2 are made up in the same way.


Block 1


Block 2

Lay out the fabric pieces for the centre of the block.


Stitch the small triangles to the larger
triangle. Long sides of small triangle to the short sides of the larger triangle. Lay out as in the diagram and stitch the rows and then sew the rows together to complete the centre of the block.

## Next



Stitch a small triangle to each side of the square and then sew a larger triangle to each side of this unit.

## Corner squares

Sew the two triangles together to made a square. Now lay your piece for the block. Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the blocks. 5 of block 1 and 4 of block 2

## Complete the quilt centre

Place your blocks out as in the main diagram. Sew the rows together and the rows together to complete the centre of the quilt.
Press each row in the opposite way this will help when sewing the rows together.

## Inner border

Sew the side strips to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

## Outer border

Lay out as in the diagram, stitch 13 of the squares together for the sides and stitch to quilt. For the top and bottom strips you need 15 squares.

## Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size.

## Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.

$16 \times 47 / 8{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2 )
$4 \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)
$16 \times 2 ½ " \times 2 ½ "(b l o c k 2)$

$16 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block 2 )

$10 \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block1)
$10 \times 51^{1 / 4} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice (block1)

$8 \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block2) $8 \times 5 \frac{1}{4} 4 \times 51 / 4 "$ cut in half diagonally twice (block2)
