1. A448.3 - Marigold leaves on grass - long $1 / 4$
2. A449.2 - Spring blossom on spring green - long $1 / 4$
3. A451.2-Duck pond on grey $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
4. A447.2 - Village scene on light grass $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
5. A448.2 - Marigold leaves on blossom pink - long $1 / 4$
6. A449.1 - Spring blossom on cream - long $1 / 4$
7. A451.3-Ducks on pink terracotta $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
8. A447.3 - Village scene on dark earth $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
9. A450.2 - Duck pond on sky blue $-3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}-3 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$
10. A450.1 - Duck pond on light blue $-3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}-3 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$
11. BB94-Bumbleberries Light grey $-7 / 8 y d-80 \mathrm{~cm}$

## Wadding and backing 57" x 72"

All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

## From fabric 1 cut

$1 \times 21 / 2 " \times 44 "$ (block 1)
$1 \times 21 / 2 " \times 20$ " (block 1)

## From fabric 2 cut

$1 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44$ " (block 1)
$1 \times 21 / 2 " \times 20$ " (block 1)

## From fabric 3 cut

$12 \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block 1 )

## From fabric 4 cut

$6 \times 5 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 4$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)
$6 \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2 \mathrm{x} \times 41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ (block 1)

## From fabric 5 cut

$1 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44$ " (block 2)
$1 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ (block 2)

## From fabric 6 cut

$1 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44$ " (block 2)
$1 \times 2 ½ " \times 20$ " (block 2)

## From fabric 7 cut

$12 \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (block 2 )

## From fabric 8 cut

$6 \times 5 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 4 "}$ cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)
$6 \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2 \mathrm{x} \times 41122^{\prime \prime}$ (block 2)

## From fabric 9 cut

$8 \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} \times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$ sashing
$7 \times 3122^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ sashing
$10 \times 4$ " $\times 4$ " (for sashing)
From fabric 10 cut
$8 \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} \times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$ sashing
$8 \times 3122^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ sashing
$10 \times 4$ " $\times 4$ " (for sashing)

## From fabric 11 cut

$12 \times 51 / 4$ " $\times 51 / 4$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for both blocks)
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ (for both blocks)
$4 \times 21 / 2 " \times 20 "$ (for both blocks)
From fabric 12 cut
You will need to join your fabric to get the length
$2 \times 3$ " x 63½" sides
$2 \times 3^{\prime \prime} \times 53^{1} / 22^{\prime \prime}$ top \& bottom

## Making up the blocks

Block 1 and block 2 are made up in the way. Take your strips of fabrics $1,2,5$ and 6 now sew them to your strips of fabric 11. Press open and then cut at $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew them in to pairs, two sets for each block.

## Block 1

Block 2


Lay out all your pieces for each block. Sew the two small triangles together and then sew this to the large triangle to make a square.

Sew the rows together and then stitch your row to complete the block. 6 sets of each of the blocks.

## Making up the quilt.

Take your squares of fabrics 9 and 10. Draw a diagonally line onto the back of fabrics 10 and place this onto fabric 9 with right sides together.
Looking at which way your fabrics will come out when cut in half diagonally.

Stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ each side of the line, cut on the line and press open. You may need to trim back to a $31 / 2$ " square.
Lay out all your blocks, small squares and sashing strips as in main diagram.

Sew in rows and then the rows together to complete the quilt


## Rows

When all your rows are stitch together the centre of the quilt is competed.

## Border

Take your side strip of fabric 12, sew them to each sides of the quilt.
Next stitch the top and the bottom strips to the quilt.

## Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size.

## Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 12 to bind the quilt.

7. A451.1-Ducks on spring yellow $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
8. A447.1-Village scene on light grey $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
9. A450.2 - Duck pond on duck egg $-3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}-3 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$
10. A450.3 - Duck pond on sky blue $-3 / 4 y d-3 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$
11. BB211-Bumbleberries Soft green $-7 / 8 y d-80 \mathrm{~cm}$
12. BB207-Bumbleberries Yellow - $11 / 8 y d-1.10 \mathrm{mtr}$

## Wadding and backing 57" x 72"

All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

$1 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44$ " (block 1)
$1 \times 21 / 2 " \times 20 "($ block 1)

## From fabric 2 cut

$1 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44$ " (block 1)
$1 \times 21 / 2 " \times 20$ " (block 1)

## From fabric 3 cut

$6 \times 47 / 8$ " $\times 47 / 8$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1 )

## From fabric 4 cut

$6 \times 5 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 4$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)
$6 \times 41 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ (block 1)

## From fabric 5 cut

$1 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44$ " (block 2)
$1 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ (block 2)

## From fabric 6 cut

$1 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44$ " (block 2)
$1 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ (block 2)

## From fabric 7 cut

$6 \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

## From fabric 8 cut

$6 \times 5 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 4 "}$ cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)
$6 \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2 \mathrm{x} \times 41122^{\prime \prime}$ (block 2)

## From fabric 9 cut

$8 \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} \times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$ sashing
$8 \times 31 / 2 " \mathrm{H} \times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ sashing
$10 \times 4$ " x 4" (for sashing)
From fabric 10 cut
$8 \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} \times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$ sashing
$7 \times 3122^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 121 / 22^{1} \mathrm{~W}$ sashing
$10 \times 4 " \times 4$ " (for sashing)

## From fabric 11 cut

$12 \times 51 / 4 " \times 51 / 4 "$ cut in half diagonally twice (for both blocks)
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ (for both blocks)
$4 \times 21 / 2 " \times 20 "$ (for both blocks)
From fabric 12 cut
You will need to join your fabric to get the length
$2 \times 3$ " x 63½" sides
$2 \times 3^{\prime \prime} \times 53^{1} / 22^{\prime \prime}$ top \& bottom
