QUILT PROJECT

LIBERTY.
FABRICS

This is a quilt made from 3 blocks which showcase The Woodland Walk fabric range. The inspiration for this quilt came from the gorgeous tones of this range which made me think of my family's favourite musical Into The Woods where the characters are repeatedly warned to be home before dark.

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 60" X 84"

Each finished block measures 12" x 12 1/2" with seam allowance.

The instructions are written for hand piecing.

Diagrams are drawn looking at the wrong side of the fabric.

This enables you to visualise reversed templates and any registration marks you have transferred.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Into The Woods 016668117A	3.2m (allows extra for fussy cutting) + 55cm extra for binding if desired
Rustling Leaves 016668126A	30cm
Daisy Delight 016668120A	1.5m
Thistle Field 016668127A	15cm
Forest Floor 016668122A	1.45m
Woodland Forage 016668121A	40cm
Nature's Garden 016668116A	75cm
Hedgerow Chorus 016668115A	60cm
Hillside 016668124A	1m
Autumn Meadow 016668119A	70cm
Woodland Melody 16668118A	1.1m
Forest Friends 016668123A	65cm

BLOCKS

Block 1

Make 5 blocks total.

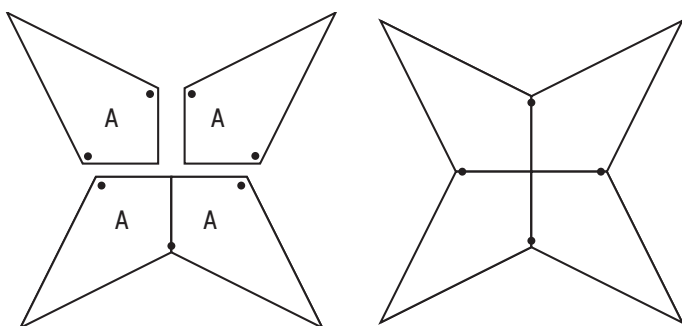
CUTTING

For each block (for whole quilt)

- 4 of Template A - from 016668127A Thistle Field (20)
- 4 of Template B - from 016668120 A Daisy Delight (20)
- 4 of Template C - from 016668126 A Rustling Leaves (20)
- 8 of Template D - from 016668128 A Wicker (40)
- 4 of Template E and 4 of Template E in reverse
- from 016668117 A Into The Woods (20 + 20 in reverse)

ASSEMBLY

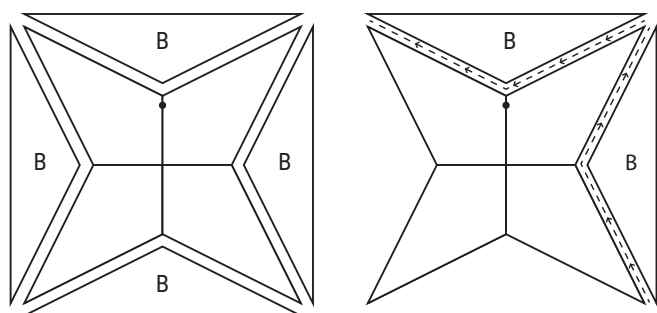
Take Template A and stitch together as follows



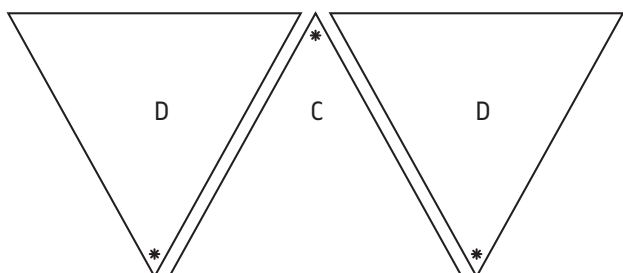
Leave the 1/4" seam allowance unstitched at the junction marked •. This becomes an inset seam.

Next stitch Template B onto the 4 sides, pivoting at the seam junction.

This can be stitched as one continuous seam.

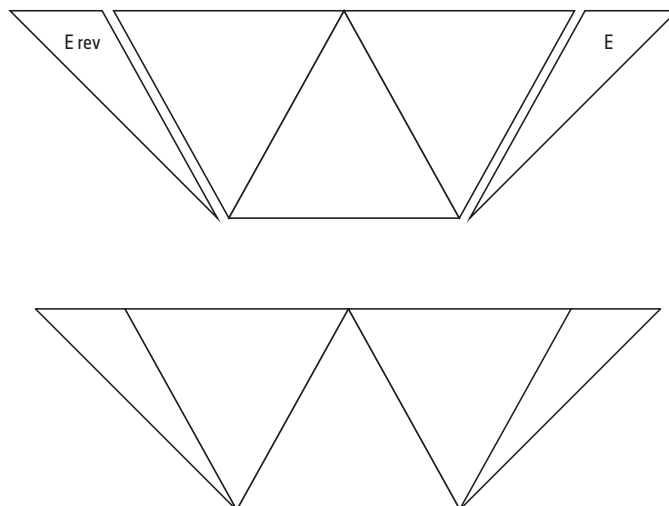


Take Template C cut from #8126 A and stitch Template D cut from #8128 A to either side.



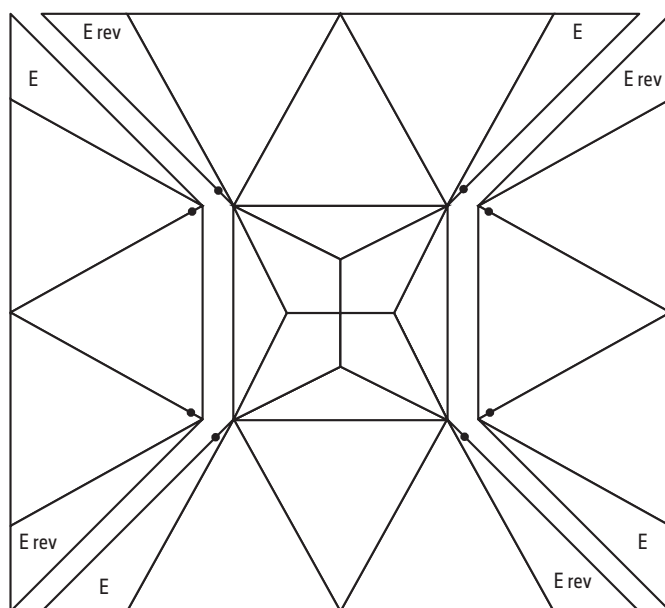
Note Registration marks as this is not an equilateral triangle.

Make 4 units.



Take the A/B unit and stitch a C/D/E unit to each side. Leave the 1/4" seam allowance unstitched at the seam junction at each corner marked •.

Close the seam between Template E and E reverse on each corner.



Block 2

Make 14 blocks total.

CUTTING

4 of Template F - from 016668115 A Hedgerow Chorus (56)

4 of Template G - from 016668121 A Woodland Forage (56)

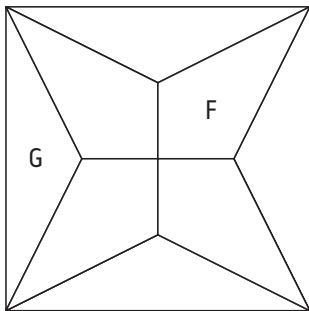
4 of Template H - from 016668116 A Nature's Garden (56)

4 of Template I and 4 of Template I in reverse
- from 016668122 A Forest Floor (56 + 56 in reverse)

4 of Template J and 4 of Template J in reverse
- from 016668117 A Into The Woods (56 + 56 in reverse)

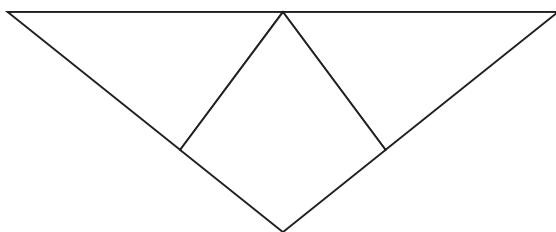
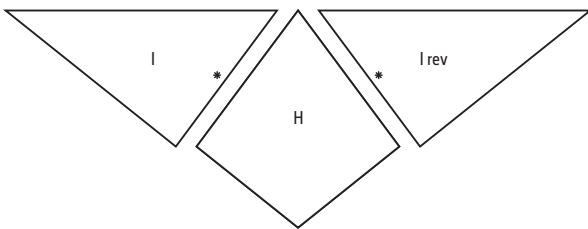
ASSEMBLY

Take Template F and Template G and stitch together (use instructions from Block 1).

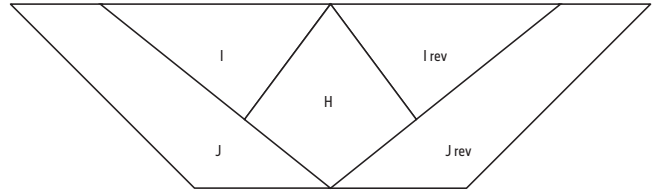


Take Template H and stitch Template I and I reverse to either side.

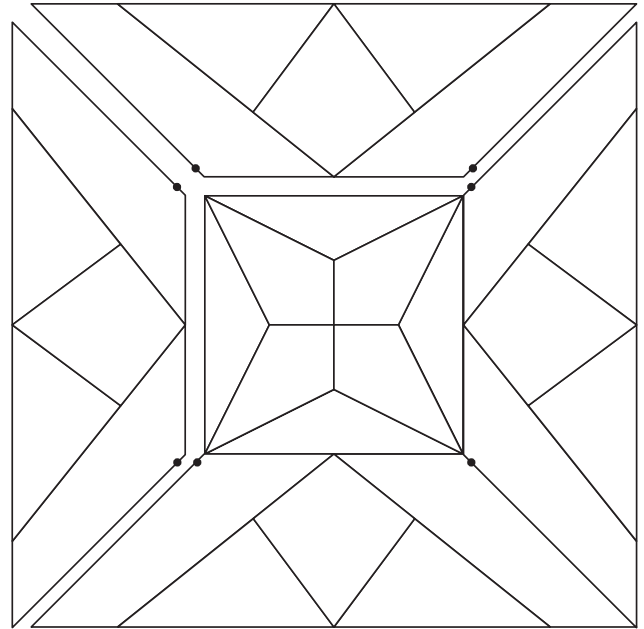
*Note registration marks to help stitch the reversed templates correctly.



Then stitch Template J and J reverse to each side of the above units.



Using the instructions from Block 1, stitch the H/I/J units to the F/G unit.



Block 3

Make 16 Blocks total.

CUTTING

4 of Template K - from 016668124 A Hillside (64)

4 of Template L - from 016668119 A Autumn Meadow (64)

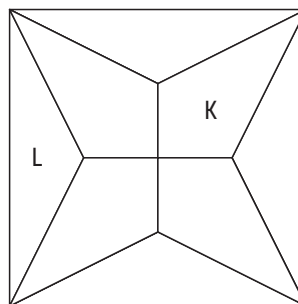
4 of Template M - from 016668118 A Woodland Melody (64)

4 of Template N and 4 of Template N in reverse - from 016661820 A Daisy Delight (64 + 64 in reverse)

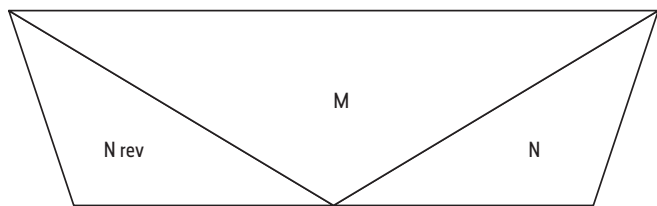
4 of Template O - from 016668123 A Forest Friends (64)

ASSEMBLY

Take Template K and L and stitch together (using instructions from Block 1).

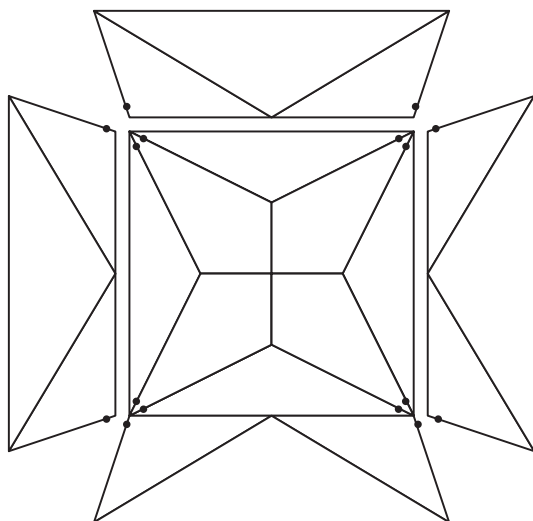


Next take Template M and stitch Template N and N reverse to either side.

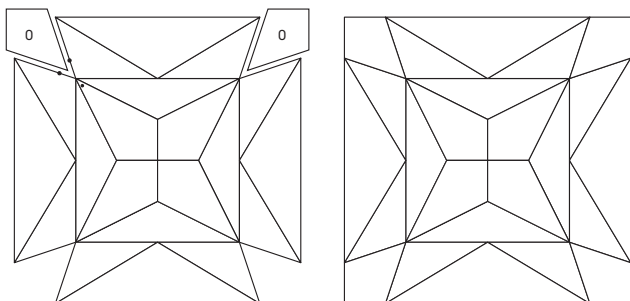


Make 4 units.

Take the K/L unit and stitch a M/N unit to each side. Leave a 1/4" seam allowance unstitched at points marked •.



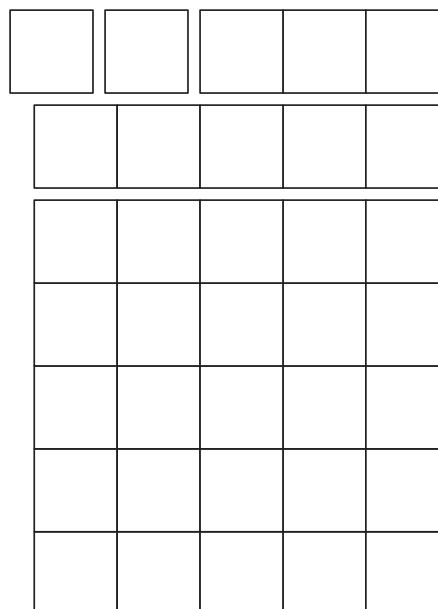
Lastly stitch Template O into each corner.



Now all the blocks are completed, lay them out in the following sequence.

3	3	2	3	3
3	2	2	2	3
3	2	1	2	3
2	1	1	1	2
3	2	1	2	3
3	2	2	2	3
3	3	2	3	3

Stitch blocks together in rows



Then stitch rows together to create your quilt top. Baste, quilt as desired and bind.
