CORRECTIONS: (applied Sep 29, 2006)

#### **BACK**

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#### **Shape Raglan Armhole**

**Next Row (Dec Row):** Sk first dc, 1 (1, 2) V-sts, and first dc of next V-st, join yarn in ch-1 sp, ch 3, work V-st in next 10 (12, 12) V-sts, dc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, ch 3, leave rem 1 (1, 2) V-sts and dc unworked. Turn. **Next Row (Dec Row):** Ch 3, dc in next V-st, work V-st across until last V-st, work V-st dec in next V-st and last st -- 8 (10, 10) 9 (11, 11) V-sts and dc as first and last st. Rep last row 7 (8, 8) more times -- 2 (3, 3) V-sts and dc as first and last st. Fasten off.

#### **SLEEVE**

...

Work 17 rows total or until piece measures 8 in. [20.5 cm] 18 in. [46 cm] from beg. Fasten off

#### Shape Raglan Armhole

**Next Row (Dec Row):** Sk first dc, 1 (1, 2) V-sts, and first dc of next V-st, join yarn in ch-1 sp, ch 3, work V-st in next 5 (7, 7) V-sts, dc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, leave rem 1 (1, 2) V-sts and dc unworked. Turn. Work 2 (1, 1) rows in V-st pattern.

**Next Row (Dec Row):** Ch 3, de in next V-st, work V-st across until last V-st, work V-st dec in next V-st and last st  $-\frac{3(5,5)}{4(6,6)}$  4 (6, 6) V-sts and dc as first and last st. Rep last row  $\frac{6(7)}{4(6,6)}$  more times -- 0 V-sts and dc as first and last st. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

#### Sleeve Edging

From RS, join yarn at wrist edge of Sleeve.

**Row 1:** Work 17 sc evenly spaced along opposite edge of beg-ch. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc. Fasten off.

#### **Coat Edging**

From RS, join yarn to lower left Front edge. Sc evenly along lower edge of Coat. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc. Fasten off

#### **MATERIALS**

- 640-131 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick: Grass</u>
   9 (10,11) Skeins
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size N-13
- · Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

#### **GAUGE:**

7 sts (2% V-sts) = 3 in. [7.5 cm] in V-st pattern.

#### BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

• V-st pattern (multiple of 3)

Ch a multiple of 3 + 6 extra.

**Row 1:** Working in 6th ch from hook, \* (dc, ch 1, dc) in next st -- V-st made, sk 2 ch, rep from \*, dc in last st. Turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work Vst in ch-1 sp of each V-st in previous row, dc in 3rd ch of beg-ch. Turn each row.

Rep Row 2 for V-st pattern.

- **V-st dec** (Yo, draw up a lp, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in next V-st, (yo, draw up a lp, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in top of ch 3, yo, draw through all lps on hook.
- dc2tog (dc dec) Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a lp, yarn over and draw through 2 lps. Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a lp. Yarn over, draw through 2 lps, yarn over and draw through all lps on hook.

#### COAT BACK

Ch 54 (60, 66).

**Row 1:** Work Row 1 of V-st pattern across -- 16 (18, 20) V-sts with dc as first and last st.

Row 2-12: Rep Row 2 of V-st pattern.

#### Shape A-line

**Next Row (Dec Row):** Dc in next V-st, make V-st in next 14 (16, 18) V-sts, work V-st dec in next V-st and last st. Turn.

Next Row (WS): Ch 3, work V-sts in


next 14 (16, 18) V-sts across, dc in last dc -- 14 (16, 18) V-sts with dc as first\ and last st

Continue in V-st pattern for 3 more rows or until piece measures 18 in. [45.5 cm] from beg. Fasten off.

#### Shape Raglan Armhole

**Next Row (Dec Row):** Sk first dc, 1 (1, 2) V-sts, and first dc of next V-st, join yarn in ch-1 sp, ch 3, work V-st in next 10 (12, 12) V-sts, dc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, ch 3, leave rem 1 (1, 2) V-sts and dc unworked. Turn.

**Next Row (Dec Row):** Ch 3, work V-st across until last V-st, work V-st dec in next V-st and last st 9 (11, 11) V-sts and dc as first and last st. Rep last row 7 (8, 8) more times - 2 (3, 3) V-sts and dc as first and last st. Fasten off.



#### **LEFT FRONT**

Ch 24 (27, 30).


**Row 1 (RS):** Work Row 1 of V-st pattern across -- 6 (7, 8) V-sts with dc as first and last st.

Row 2-12: Rep Row 2 of V-st pattern.

#### Shape A-line

Row 13 (Dec Row): Dc in next V-st, make V-st in next 5 (6, 7) V-sts, dc in top of beg-

Continue in V-st pattern over these 5 (6, 7) V-sts until piece measures same as Back to armhole shaping.



#### Shape Raglan Armhole

Row 18 (Dec Row): Ch 3, make V-st in next 3 (4, 5) V-sts, dc in next V-st, leave rem sts unworked -- 3 (4, 5) V sts with dc as first and last st.

Row 19 (Dec Row): Ch 3, dc in next V-st, make V-st in next 2 (3, 4) V-sts, dc in last dc.

Row 20 (Dec Row): Ch 3, make V-st in next 2 (3, 4) V-sts, dc2tog over next dc and ch-3.

Row 21 (Dec Row): Ch 3, dc in next V-st, make V-st in next 1 (2, 3) V-sts, dc in last dc.

Row 22 (Dec Row): Ch 3, make V-st in next 1 (2, 3) V-sts, dc2tog over next dc and ch-3.

Row 23 (Dec Row): Ch 3, dc in next V-st, make V-st in next 0 (1, 2) V-sts, dc in last dc.

#### For Size S ONLY

Row 24: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc.

Row 25 (Dec Row): Work dc2tog over dc and ch-3. Fasten off.

#### For Sizes M/L and L/XL ONLY

Row 24 (Dec Row): Ch 3, make V-st in next 1 (2) V-sts, dc2tog over next dc and ch-3.

Row 25 (Dec Row): Ch 3, dc in next V-st, dc in next 0 (1) V-sts, dc in last dc.

Row 26 (Dec Row): Ch 3, dc2tog over dc and ch-3. Fasten off.

#### RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Left Front, reversing shaping.

#### **SLEEVE**

Ch 21.

**Row 1:** Work Row 1 of V-st pattern across -- 5 V-sts with dc as first and last st. Rep Row 2 of V-st pattern and, AT THE SAME TIME, inc 1 dc each edge every row and work new sts into V-st pattern until there are 9 (11, 13) V-sts with dc as first and last st. Work 17 rows total or until piece measures 18 in. [46 cm] from beg. Fasten off.

#### Shape Raglan Armhole

**Next Row (Dec Row):** Sk first dc, 1 (1, 2) V-sts, and first dc of next V-st, join yarn in ch-1 sp, ch 3, work V-st in next 5 (7, 7) V-sts, dc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, leave rem 1 (1, 2) V-sts and dc unworked. Turn. Work 2 (1, 1) rows in V-st pattern.

**Next Row (Dec Row):** Ch 3, work V-st across until last V-st, work V-st dec in next V-st and last st – 4 (6, 6) V-sts and dc as first and last st. Rep last row 4 (6, 6) more times - 0 V-sts and dc as first and last st. Fasten off.



#### FINISHING

#### **Sleeve Edging**

From RS, join yarn at wrist edge of Sleeve.

**Row 1:** Work 17 sc evenly spaced along opposite edge of beg-ch. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc. Fasten off. Sew Sleeves to Back and Fronts along raglan edge. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

#### **Coat Edging**

From RS, join yarn to lower left Front edge. Sc evenly along lower edge of Coat. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc. Fasten off

#### Front Band/Collar

Ch 11.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across -- 10 sts. Turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in BACK LP ONLY of each st. Turn each row. Rep Row 2 until piece measures 52 (54, 54) in. [132 (137, 137) cm] or until Bands/Collar fits along Left Front edge, around Back neck, and along Right Front Edge. Fasten off. Sew Bands/Collar in place.

#### **BELT** (optional)

Ch /

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across -- 3 sc. Turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in BACK LP ONLY of each sc. Turn each row. Rep Row 2 until belt measures 60 in. [152.5 cm] or desired length. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
