SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X

Finished Chest 33 (36, 40, 44, 48) in. [84 (91.5, 101.5, 112, 122) cm]

Finished Length 24 (24, 24, 26, 26) in. [61 (61, 61, 66, 66) cm]

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

#### MATERIALS

- 640-135 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick: Spice
  2 Skeins (A)
- 640-143 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick: Claret
  2 Skeins (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size S-35 'Speed Hook'
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

### GAUGE:

4 dc + 2 rows = 4 in. [10 cm] with 1 strand each of A and B held together BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

**dc2tog (dc dec)** Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

## FRONT AND BACK (make 2)

With 1 strand each of A and B held together, ch 19 (20, 22, 24, 26) loosely.

Row 1 (right side): Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch counts as dc) and in each ch across – 17 (18, 20, 22, 24) dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in each st across.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 16 in. [40.5 cm] from beg.

# Shape Armhole and Neck

**Row 1:** Turn, slip st in first 3 (3, 4, 4, 5) sts, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog, leave remaining 10 (11, 12, 14, 15) sts unworked – 4 dc.


**Row 2:** Ch 2, turn, dc in next st (ch 2 and first dc count as dc2tog), dc2tog – 2 dc.

**Rows 3-4 (4, 4, 5, 5):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in last st – 2 dc. Fasten off.

Join yarn at opposite side edge and repeat Rows 1-4 (4, 4, 5, 5) for armhole and neck shaping. Leave center 3 (4, 4, 6, 6) sts unworked for neck. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Sew side and shoulder seams. Weave in ends.
