SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: Small, Adult Medium, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X

Finished Chest 35¾ (39, 42¾, 46, 48¾ in. [91 (99, 108.5, 117, 127) cm]

Finished Length 21½ (21½, 22, 22¾, 22¾) in. [54.5 (54.5, 56, 58, 58) cm]

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 640-122 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick: Taupe
2 (2, 2, 3, 3) Skeins (A)
- 640-132 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick: Lemongrass
1 Skeins (B)
- 640-189 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick: Butterscotch
1 Skeins (C)
- 640-112 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick: Raspberry
1 Skeins (D)
- 640-145 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick: Plum
1 Skeins (E)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 10.5 [6.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 [9 mm]
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
Circular needle size 10.5 [6.5 mm] 16 in. [40 cm]

GAUGE:

9 sts + 13 rows = 4 in. [10 cm] in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with larger needles. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

K1, p1 Rib

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from *.

Row 2: K the k sts and p the p sts.

Repeat Row 2 for pattern.

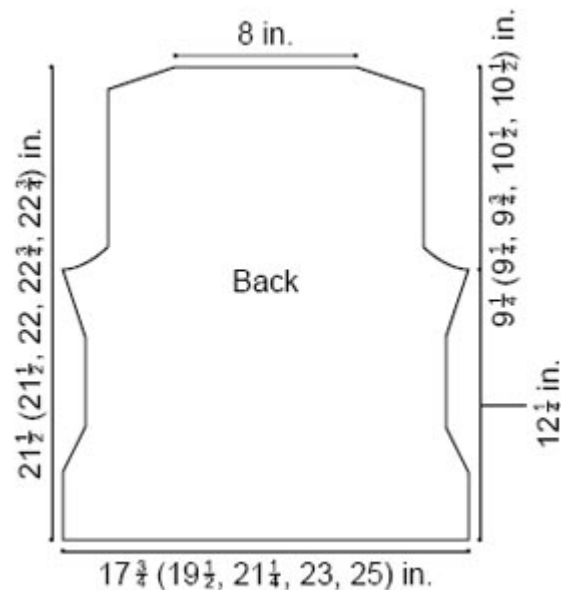
BACK

With smaller needles and A, cast on 40 (44, 48, 52, 56) sts. Work 4 rows in k1, p1 Rib. Change to larger needles and work 4 rows in St st (k on RS, p on WS). Dec 1 st each end of next row -- 38 (42, 46, 50, 54) sts. Work 5 rows even. Dec 1 st each end of next row -- 36 (40, 44, 48, 52) sts. Work 13 rows even. Inc 1 st each end of next row -- 38 (42, 46, 50, 54) sts. Work 9 rows even. Inc 1 st each end of next row -- 40 (44, 48, 52, 56) sts. Work 1 row even.

Armhole Shaping

Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 (2, 2, 2, 2) st (s) at beg of next 2 rows 1 (1, 1, 1, 2) time(s), then dec 1 st at beg of

next 2 rows 1 (1, 2, 3, 2) time(s) -- 32 (32, 34, 34, 36) sts. Work 20 rows even. Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then bind off 4 (4, 4, 4, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows -- 18 sts. Bind off remaining sts.



LEFT FRONT

With smaller needles and A, cast on 20 (22, 24, 26, 28) sts. Work 4 rows in k1, p1 Rib. Change to larger needles and B and work 4 rows in St st. Dec 1 st at beg of next RS row -- 19 (21, 23, 25, 27) sts. Change to C and work 5 rows even. Dec 1 st at beg of next RS row -- 18 (20, 22, 24, 26) sts. Work 9 rows even. Change to A and work 4 rows even. Inc 1 st at beg of next RS row -- 19 (21, 23, 25, 27) sts. Work 9 rows even. Inc 1 st at beg of next RS row -- 20 (22, 24, 26, 28) sts. Work 1 row even.

Armhole Shaping

Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts at beg of next RS row, then dec 1 (2, 2, 2, 2) st (s) at beg of next RS row 1 (1, 1, 1, 2) time(s), then dec 1 st at beg of next RS row 1 (1, 2, 3, 2) time(s) -- 16 (16, 17, 17, 18) sts. Change to D and work 3 rows even.

V-Neck Shaping

Dec 1 st at neck edge every RS row 3 times -- 13 (13, 14, 14, 15) sts. Change to E and dec 1 st at neck edge every RS row 6 times -- 7 (7, 8, 8, 9) sts. Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4, 4) sts at beg of next RS row. Work 1 row even. Bind off.

RIGHT FRONT

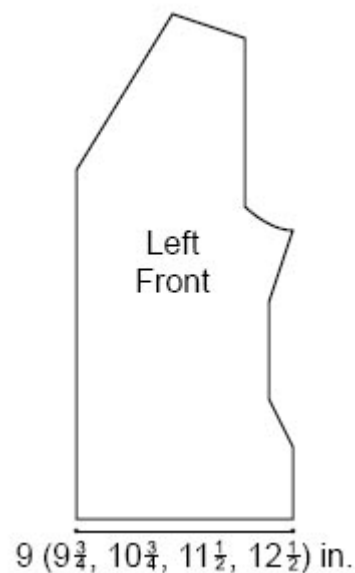
Work as for Left Front, reversing shaping, in the following color sequence:
 4 rows with A (K1, p1 rib)
 10 rows with D
 20 rows with A
 8 (8, 10, 10, 10) rows with E
 16 rows with B
 10 (10, 10, 12, 12) rows with C.

FINISHING

Sew center seam between Left Front and Right Front. Sew shoulder and side seams.

Neck Edging: From RS, with circular needle and A, pick up 12 sts along Left Front neck, place marker, pick up 12 sts along Right Front neck, and pick up 18 sts along Back neck. *Work in k1, p1 Rib to 2 sts before marker, dec 1 st, slip marker, dec 1 st, work in k1, p1 Rib to end of round. Rep from * once more. Bind off in rib.

Armhole Edging: From RS, with circular needle and A, pick up 32 sts around armhole edge. Work 1 round in k1, p1 rib. Bind off in rib. Weave in ends.
