## MATERI ALS

- 640-308 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick \& Quick Yarn: Starlight

2 Balls (A)

- 640-304 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick \& Quick Yarn: Gemstone

1 Ball (B)

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials

Crochet hook size L-11 ( 8 mm )

## GAUGE:

$$
9 \mathrm{sc}+10 \mathrm{rnds}=4 \mathrm{in} .(10 \mathrm{~cm})
$$

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in . [ 10 cm ] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## NOTES:

1. Bag is worked in joined rnds, beginning at bottom of Bag.
2. Handles are worked separately and sewn to Bag.

## BAG

With B, ch 19.
Rnd 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next $16 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in last ch; working across opposite edge of foundation ch, sc in next $16 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in same ch as first sc; join with sl st in first sc - 38 sc at the end of this rnd.
Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in same sc as joining, sc in next $16 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 3 sc , sc in next 16 sc , 2 sc in each of last 2 sc ; join with sl st in first sc-44 sc at the end of this rnd.
Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same sc as joining, sc in next 18 sc , 2 sc in each of next 3 sc , sc in next 19 sc , 2 sc in each of next 3 sc ; join with sl st in first sc -50 sc at the end of this rnd.
Rnd 4: Working in back loops only, ch 1, sc in same sc as joining, sc in next $18 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in next 3 sc , 2 sc in next sc, sc in next $20 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in next sc; join with sl st in first sc - 54 sc at the end of this rnd.
Rnds 5-12: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.
Rnd 13: Ch 1, sc in next $21 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc , sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc , sc in next 23 sc , 2 sc in next sc, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in last 2 sc ; join with sl st in first sc-58 sc at the end of this rnd.
Rnds 14-16: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off B.
Rnd 17: With RS facing and working in back loops only, join A with sc in same sc as joining, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.
Rnd 18: Ch 1, sc in next $22 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc , sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in next 23 sc , 2 sc in next sc, sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in next sc; join with sl st in first sc-62 sc at the end of this rnd.
Rnds 19-31: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.
Edging
Note: RS of Edging is on WS of Bag and will be flipped to RS when Bag is finished.
Rnd 32 (WS of Bag): Turn, working in back loops only, ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.
Rnds 33-35: Working in back loops only, ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. Fold Edging to RS of Bag.
HANDLES (make 2)
With B, ch 39.
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across - 38 sc at the end of this row.
Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.
Fold Handle in half lengthwise, bringing WS together.
Joining Row: Ch 1, turn, working through both thicknesses, sc in each sc across to join first row to last row.
Fasten off.

## FI NISHI NG

Flatten Bag opening. Sew one end of one Handle to top of Bag where edging is folded over, about 3 in . ( 7.5 cm ) in from side edge. Sew other end of same Handle, $3 \mathrm{in} .(7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) in from other side. Turn Bag over and sew 2nd Handle to opposite side of Bag in same way.
Weave in ends.
