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## MATERIALS

- 1 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 3, 3) skeins Lion Brand Hue + Me in Saffron (617-133) for color A
- $2(2,2,3,3,3,3,4)$ skeins Lion Brand Hue + Me in Salt (617-098) for color B
- 1 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 3, 3) skeins Lion Brand Hue + Me in Mustard (617-158) for color $C$
- $2(2,2,2,2,3,3,3)$ skeins Lion Brand Hue + Me in Artichoke (617-171) for color D (bulky, weight 5; 137yds/125m per skein)
- Size US 10 ( 6 mm ) circular knitting needles, 16 "/40cm long
- Size US 10 ( 6 mm ) circular knitting needles, 24 " $/ 60 \mathrm{~cm}$ long
- Size US 11 ( 8 mm ) circular knitting needles, 24 " $/ 60 \mathrm{~cm}$ long
- Stitch holders or scrap yarn
- Removable stitch markers
- Tapestry needle


## GAUGE

11 sts +16 rows $=4 " / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in stockinette on size US 11 ( 8 mm ) needles

## ABBREVIATIONS

All Two of Wands patterns are written in standard US terms.

## NOTES

Sweater body is worked flat from the bottom up, and sleeves are picked up from the body and knit top down. Use the intarsia method to change colors mid-row as instructed. To do so, twist the old color over the new color before picking it up to work the first stitch of the new color. Pattern is written for eight sizes: $X S(S, M, L, X L, 2 X L$, $3 X L, 4 X L)$.

## BACK

With color A and longer US 10 ( 6 mm ) needles, CO $60(66,72,76,82,88,94,100)$ sts.

Rows 1-8 *K 1, P 1, rep from * to end of row.

Change to color B and US 11 (8mm) needles.

Row 9 (RS) $K 36(40,44,46,50,54,58,60)$ with color B, then $K 24(26,28,30,32,34,36,40)$ with color C.

Row 10 (WS) P $24(26,28,30,32,34,36,40)$ with color $C$, then $P 36(40,44,46,50,54,58,60)$ with color B.

Rep rows 9 and 10 until work measures 18.5 (19, 19.5, 20, 20.5, 21, 21.5, 22)"/47 (48.5, $49.5,51,52,53.5,54.5,56) \mathrm{cm}$ from CO, ending with a WS row.

Begin back neck shaping:

Row numbers will restart for simplicity. Continue to change colors as established throughout neck shaping.

Row 1 (RS) $\quad \mathrm{K} 20(23,26,28,30,33,36,39)$, bind off $20(20,20,20,22,22,22,22)$, $K$ to end of row.

Place sts worked BEFORE bind off on a holder and begin working only the sts on the needles to form the left side. ( $20(23,26,28,30,33,36,39)$ sts on needles)

## Left side:

Row 2 (WS) P.

Row 3 K 1, SSK, K to end of row. (19 (22, 25, 27, 29, 32, 35, 38) sts)

Row 4 P.

Bind off.

Place sts from holder back on needles and rejoin yarn at the neckline edge to begin the right side.

## Right side:

Row 2 (WS) P.

Row 3 K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K $1 .(19(22,25,27,29,32,35,38)$ sts $)$

Row 4 P.

Bind off.

## FRONT

With color A and longer US $10(6 \mathrm{~mm})$ needles, CO $60(66,72,76,82,88,94,100)$ sts.
Rows 1-8 *K 1, P 1, rep from * to end of row.

Change to color C and US 11 (8mm) needles.

Row 9 (RS) $K 24(26,28,30,32,34,36,40)$ with color $C$, then $K 36(40,44,46,50,54,58,60)$ with color B.

Row 10 (WS) P $36(40,44,46,50,54,58,60)$ with color B, then P $24(26,28,30,32,34,36,40)$ with color C.

Rep rows 9 and 10 until work measures 16.5 (17, 17.5, 18, 18.5, 19, 19.5, 20)"/42 (43, $44.5,45.5,47,48.5,49.5,51) \mathrm{cm}$ from CO , ending with a WS row.

Begin front neck shaping:

Row numbers will restart for simplicity. Continue to change colors as established throughout neck shaping.

Row 1 (RS) K $25(28,31,33,35,38,41,44)$, bind off $10(10,10,10,12,12,12,12)$, $K$ to end of row.

Place sts worked BEFORE bind off on a holder and begin working only the sts on the needles to form the right side. (28 sts on needles)

## Right side:

| Row 2 (WS) | P. |
| :--- | :--- |
| Row 3 | Sl 1, K 1, Psso, bind off 2 sts, $K$ to end of row. $(22(25,28,30,32,35,38,41)$ sts $)$ |
| Row 4 | P. |
| Row 5 | K 1, SSK, K to end of row. $(21(24,27,29,31,34,37,40)$ sts $)$ |
| Rows 6-9 | Rep rows 4 and 5, two more times. $(19(22,25,27,29,32,35,38)$ sts) |
| Row 10 | P. |
| Row 11 | K. |
| Row 12 | P. |
|  | Bind off. |

Place sts from holder back on needles and rejoin yarn at the neckline edge to begin the left side.

## Left side:

Row 2 (WS) SI 1, P 1, psso, bind off 2 sts, P to end of row. $(22(25,28,30,32,35,38,41)$ sts $)$
Row 3 K.

| Row 4 | P. |
| :--- | :--- |
| Row 5 | K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K $1 .(21(24,27,29,31,34,37,40)$ sts $)$ |

Row 6-9 Rep rows 4 and 5, two more times. (19 (22, 25, 27, 29, 32, 35, 38) sts)

Row 10 P.

Row 11 K.

Row 12 P.

Bind off.

Seam shoulders. Place markers 9.75 (10, 10.5, 11.25, 11.5, 12, 12.75, 13)"/24.5 (25.5, $26.5,28.5,29,30.5,32.5,33) \mathrm{cm}$ down from shoulder seams on both sides of the front and back.

## SLEEVES

## Left sleeve:

With color D, size US 11 ( 8 mm ) needles, and RS facing, pick up and K $54(56,58$, 62, 64, $66,70,72$ ) sts between markers on the left side.

## Next row P.

## Next row K.

Continue the following instructions with color D. AT THE SAME TIME, change to color A when sleeve measures $14^{\prime \prime} / 35.5 \mathrm{~cm}$.

Work $7(7,7,5,5,5,5,5)$ rows of stockinette, knitting the RS rows and purling the WS rows.

Next row (RS) (Dec) K 1, K2tog, K to last 3 sts, SSK, K $1 .(52(54,56,60,62,64,68,70)$ sts)

Rep last $8(8,8,6,6,6,6,6)$ rows $0(3,0,5,3,5,2,1)$ more time(s). (52 (48,56,50,56, $54,64,68)$ sts)

Work $5(5,5,3,3,3,3,3)$ rows of stockinette, knitting the RS rows and purling the WS rows.

Next row (RS) (Dec) K 1, K2tog, K to last 3 sts, SSK, K $1 .(50(46,54,48,54,52,62,66)$ sts)

Rep last $6(6,6,4,4,4,4,4)$ rows $7(3,7,4,7,4,9,11)$ more times. $(36(40,40,40,40$, $44,44,44)$ sts)

Continue in stockinette, knitting the RS rows and purling the WS rows, until sleeve measures $17^{\prime \prime} / 43 \mathrm{~cm}$, ending with a WS row.

Next row (RS) *K 2, k2tog, rep from * to end of row. (27 (30, 30, 30, 30, 33, 33, 33) sts)

Change to color B and US $10(6 \mathrm{~mm})$ needles.

Next row (WS) P to last $2(0,0,0,0,2,2,2)$ sts, P2tog $1(0,0,0,0,1,1,1)$ time(s). $(26(30,30,30,30$, $32,32,32)$ sts)

Next 7 rows *K 1, P 1, rep from * to end of row.

Bind off in rib or with a tubular bind off.

## Right sleeve:

With color A, size US 11 ( 8 mm ) needles, and RS facing, pick up and K $54(56,58$, 62, 64, $66,70,72$ ) sts between markers on the right side.

Work as for left sleeve. AT THE SAME TIME, change to color D when sleeve measures $7.5^{\prime \prime} / 19 \mathrm{~cm}$.

## CONSTRUCTION

Fold sweater at the shoulders. Starting at the bottom hem, seam each side up to the underarm and down the underside of the sleeves.

## NECKBAND

With color A, shorter US 10 ( 6 mm ) needles, RS facing, and starting at right shoulder seam, pick up and K 5 sts down back right neck shaping, 20 (20, 20, 20, 22, 22, 22, 22) sts across back neck bind off, 5 sts up back left neck shaping, 9 sts down front left neck shaping, $16(16,16,16,18,18,18,18)$ sts across front neck bind offs, and 9 sts up front right neck shaping for a total of $64(64,64,64,68,68,68,68)$ sts.

Join in the round and place marker for beginning of round.

Rounds 1-5 *K 1, P 1, rep from * around.

Bind off in rib or with a tubular bind off.

Secure and weave in all ends.


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
