RIPPLE AFGHAN

PATTERN No. M23062 CROCHET • EASY





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SIZE

About 34 x 44 in. (86.5 x 112 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® THE COTTONY ONE (Art. #3040)
 - #140 Primrose Hill 3 balls (A)
 - #158 Gold Medal 3 balls (B)
 - #114 Red Red Wine 2 balls (C)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)

GAUGE

1 ripple = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm), measured from peak to peak. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Afghan is worked, back and forth in rows, in a ripple crochet pattern.
- 2. The ripple pattern consists of alternating peaks and valleys. Peaks are formed by working 3 dc or 3 sc in the center st of the 3-st peaks in the previous row. Valleys are formed by skipping sts centered between peaks. Take care to keep the peaks and valleys of each row aligned.
- 3. When working a crochet ripple, your piece may not lay flat until you've worked a few rows.
- 4. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Fasten off old color. Proceed with new color.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work (8 rows with A, 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C) 3 times, then 8 rows with A, and 8 rows with B, for a total of 88 rows in Stripe Sequence

AFGHAN

With A, ch 130.

Row 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, * sc in next 7 ch, sk next ch, sc in next 7 ch, 3 sc in next ch; rep from * to last 16 ch, sc in next 7 ch, sk next ch, sc in next 7 ch, 2 sc in last ch – 8 ripples.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in first sc, * dc in next 7 sc, sk next 2 sc, dc in next 7 sc, 3 dc in next sc; rep from * to last 17 sts, dc in next 7 sc, sk next 2 sc, dc in next 7 sc, 2 dc in last sc. Row 3: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first dc, * sc in next 7 dc, sk next 2 dc, sc in next 7 dc, 3 sc in next dc; rep from * to last 17 sts, sc in next 7 dc, sk next 2 dc, sc in next 7 dc, 2 sc in top of beg ch-3. Rep Rows 2 and 3, changing yarn color

following Stripe Sequence, until all 88 rows of Stripe Sequence have been completed.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

st(s) = stitch(es)
