

Knitted Measurements

Wingspan 66in/168cm Height 19in/48cm

Materials

- 4 x 50g balls of Noro Silk Garden Lite in #2084.
- One size 8 (5mm) circular needle, 40in/150cm long, OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE.
- Two size 8 (5mm) double-pointed needles.

Stitch Glossary

P5tog To make the p5tog easier, it can be worked as follows: wyif, sl next 4 sts one at a time purlwise, then p next st and lift each slipped st over the last p st, one at a time—4 sts decreased.

Gauge

20 sts and 18 rows to 4in/10cm over Hyacinth Stitch patt using size 8 (5mm) needles. TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.

Abbreviations

Hyacinth Stitch Pattern

(multiple of 6 sts plus 2)

Cast on sts and knit one set-up row.

Row 1 (WS) K1, *p5tog, (k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) in next st; rep from * to last st, end k1.

Row 2 (RS) K1, p to last st, k1.

Row 3 K1, *(k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) in next st, p5tog; rep from * to last st, end k1

Row 4 K1, p to last st, k1.

Row 5 K1, *k next st, wrapping yarn twice around needle; rep from * to last st, end k1.

Row 6 K1, *k next st, letting the extra wrap drop from needle; rep from * to last st, end k1.

Rep rows 1-6 for Hyacinth Stitch pattern.

Note

Markers are placed on the set-up row and moved every row to delineate the edge sts from the patt sts. As sts are increased, it is helpful to add new markers to mark each new set of 6-st patts. Work any increased sts outside of these reps in Stockinette st.

Shawl

With circular needle, loosely cast on 12 sts.

Set-up row (WS) Kfb, k to last st, kfb-14 sts.

Row 1 (RS) Kfb, yo, p to last st, yo, kfb—4 sts increased.

Row 2 (WS) Kfb, k1, (k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) in next st; *p5tog, (k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) in next st; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, kfb—2 sts increased.

Row 3 Rep row 1.

Row 4 Kfb, k4, p5tog, *(k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) in next st, p5tog; rep from * to last 6 sts, k5, kfb.

 $\textbf{Row} \; \textbf{5} \; \text{Rep row} \; \textbf{1}.$

Row 6 Kfb, k2, *k, wrapping yarn around needle twice; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, kfb.

Row 7 Kfb, yo, p3, *k, dropping extra wrap from needle; rep from * to

last 4 sts, p3, yo, kfb.

Row 8 Kfb, k5, *p5tog, (k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) in next st; rep from * to last 6 sts, k5, kfb.

Row 9 Rep row 1.

Row 10 Kfb, k2, *(k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) in next st, p5tog; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, kfb.

Row 11 Rep row 1.

Row 12 Kfb, k5, *k, wrapping yarn around needle twice; rep from * to last 6 sts, k5, kfb.

Row 13 Kfb, yo, p6, *k, dropping extra wrap from needle; rep from * to last 7 sts, p6, yo, kfb.

Row 14 Kfb, k2, *p5tog, (k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) in next st; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, kfb.

Row 15 Rep row 1.

Row 16 Kfb, k5, *(k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) in next st, p5tog; rep from * to last 6 sts, k5, kfb.

Row 17 Rep row 1.

Row 18 Rep row 6.

Row 19 Rep row 7.

Rows 20-55 Rep (rows 8-19) 3 times more—180 sts.

Rows 56-60 Rep rows 8-12-194 sts.

Row 61 Rep row 13.

Row 62 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 14.

Row 63 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 1-216 sts.

Row 64 Rep row 16.

Row 65 Rep row 1.

Row 66 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 6.

Row 67 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 7—240 sts.

Row 68 Rep row 8.

Row 69 Rep row 1.

Row 70 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 10.

Row 71 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 1.

Row 72 Rep row 12—262 sts.

Row 73 Rep row 13.

Row 74 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 14.

Row 75 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 1.

Row 76 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 16.

 $\textbf{Row 77} \; \textbf{Cast on 6 sts, rep row 1.}$

Row 78 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 6.

Row 79 Cast on 6 sts, kfb, yo, p9, *k next st, letting the extra wrap drop from needle; rep from * to last 4 sts, p3, yo, kfb.

Row 80 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 8.

Row 81 Cast on 6 sts, rep row 1—336 sts.

Row 82 Purl. Bind off loosely knitwise.

Finishing

Weave in ends and block shawl to measurements.

Picot Edging

Using 2 dpn, make a slip knot and place on 1 dpn. *Using the cable cast-on, cast on 2 more sts—3 sts on needle. Bind off 2 sts—1 st remains on needle. Sl this st to LH needle—1 picot made.

Rep from * until there are 164 picots. Ensure that this picot edge fits the entire outer edge of the triangle, then continue to work the edging as follows:

Using circular needle, do not turn work and then, working into the straight edge of the picots, *yo, pick up and k1 st in loop of the picot; rep from * to end—328 sts. Knit 4 rows. Bind off. Using mattress st, graft the edging to the outer edge of the triangle from the RS. *
