Finished Measurements

- Hand circumference 7in/18cm.
- Length 11½in/29cm.

Materials

- 1 x 50g skein of Noro *Silk Garden Sock* in #s269.
- One set (4) size US 2/2.75mm double-pointed needles.
- One set (4) size US 4/3.5mm double-pointed needles, or size to obtain gauge.
- Cable needle.
- Stitch markers.

Gauge

21 sts and 28 rnds = 4in/10cm over St st using size larger needles.
TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.

General and Knitting Abbreviations

approx approximately; **beg** begin(ning); **CC** contrasting color; **cm** centimeter(s); **cn** cable needle; **cont** continue(ing); **dec** decrease(ing); **dnp** double-pointed needle(s); **est** established; **fall** follow(s) (ing); **g** gram(s); **in** inch(es); **inc** increase(ing); **k** knit; **kfb** knit into front and back of stitch; **LH** left-hand; **mm** millimeter(s); **MC** main color; **M1** make one (see glossary); **p** purl; **patt(s)** pattern(s); **pm** place marker; **psso** pass slip stitch(es) over; **rem** remain(s) (ing); **rep** repeat; **rev** reverse(ing) (ed); **RH** right-hand; **rnd(s)** round(s); **RS** right side; **SKP** slip 1, knit 1, pass slip stitch over; **SK2P** slip 1, knit 2 stitches together, pass slip stitch over k2tog; **S2KP** slip 2 stitches together knitwise, knit 1, pass slip stitches over knit 1; **sl** slip; **sm** slip marker; **ssk/ssp** slip, slip, knit/purl (see glossary); **st(s)** stitch(es); **St st** Stockinette stitch; **tbl** through back loop; **tog** together; **WS** wrong side(s); **wyib** with yarn in back; **wyif** with yarn in front; **yo** yarn over (hook or needle); * repeat directions following * as many times as indicated; [] repeat directions inside brackets as many times as indicated.

Stitches/Techniques Used

2-st RPC Slip 1 st to cn and hold to back, k1, p1 from cn.

2-st LPC Slip 1 st to cn and hold to front, p1, k1 from cn.

3-st RC Slip 2 sts to cn and hold to back, k1, k2 from cn.

MB (make bobble) (K1, yo, k1, yo, k1) in next st, turn, p5, turn, ssk, k1, k2tog, turn, p3tog, turn, slip st to RH needle.

Left Mitten

With smaller dpn, cast on 42 sts.

Divide sts evenly over 3 needles and join, taking care not to twist sts on needles.

Pm for beg of rnd and sm every rnd.

Rnd 1 *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Rep rnd 1 for k1, p1 rib until piece measures 2½in/6.5cm from beg.

Change to larger dpn and knit 1 rnd.

Begin Chart

Rnd 1 K2, work rnd 1 of chart over 19 sts, k21.

Cont to work chart in this way, working rem sts in St st (knit every rnd) for 19 rnds more**.

Next rnd Work in patts to last 6 sts, bind off 6 sts for thumb opening.

Next rnd Cont in patts and cast on 6 sts over bound-off sts.

Work even in patts until piece measures 10in/25.5cm from beg.

Top Shaping

Next rnd (dec) K1, k2tog, k16, ssk, pm, k1, k2tog, k16, ssk—4 sts dec'd.

Dec rnd [K1, k2tog, k to 2 sts before marker, ssk, sm] twice—4 sts dec'd.

Rep dec rnd every rnd 7 times more—6 sts.

Next rnd [S2KP] twice—2 sts.

Cut yarn and pull end through last 2 sts, draw up and secure.

Cut yarn.

Thumb

With RS facing and smaller dpn, pick up and k 6 sts along lower edge of thumb opening, 1 st at side edge, 7 sts along upper edge, 1 st at side edge—15 sts.

Join and place marker for beg of rnd.

Knit 18 rnds.

Next rnd [K2tog] 7 times, k1—8 sts.

Pull yarn through rem sts, draw up and secure.

Cut yarn.

Right Mitten

Work as for Left Mitten up to **.

Next rnd K2, work chart as established over 19 sts, k2, bind off 6 sts, k to end.

Next rnd Work in patts as established, casting on 6 sts over bound-off sts.

Complete as for Left Mitten. ■
