Neck Scarf

To Fit one size.

Materials

Cabled Poncho

4 [5:6]50g balls Silk Garden Lite. Col. 2116.

Plain Poncho

4 [5:5]50g balls Silk Garden Lite. Col. 2159.

Helmet

1 x 50g Balls of Silk Garden Lite. Col. 2190.

Neck Scarf

1 x 50g Balls of Silk Garden Lite. Col. 2190.

1 Pair of 4mm (US6) Knitting Needles.

1 Pair of 3.25mm (US3) Knitting Needles.

Tension

21sts and 26 rows to 10cm, 4in, over stockinette stitch and pattern **using 4mm (US6) knitting needles**, or the size required to give the correct tension.

2sts are allowed for each cable.

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment therefore knit a tension square.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles; if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

Instructions are given for S, larger sizes are given in square brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

Special Abbreviations

1x1 Rib.

1st Row: *K1, P1, rep from * to last st, K1.

2nd Row: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

St-St. Stockinette Stitch.

1st Row: Knit.

2nd Row: Purl.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

G-St. Garter Stitch.

Every Row: Knit.

C6B. Slip next 3sts onto a CN and hold at back of work, K3 then K3sts from CN.

M1. Make one stitch. Pick up loop between last and next st and work into back of this loop.

VERY IMPORTANT IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as close as possible to the yarn.

CABLED PONCHO

Left side.

Using 4mm needles and thumb method cast on 76 [86:90]sts.

1st Row: K3, P2, K6, (P6 [8:10], K6) 5 times, P2, K3.

2nd Row: K5, (P6, K6 [8:10]) 5 times, P6, K5.

3rd and 4th Rows: As 1st and 2nd rows.

5th Row: K3, P2, C6B, (P6 [8:10], C6B) 5 times, P2, K3.

6th Row: As 2nd row.

7th Row: As 1st row.

8th Row: K5, (P6, K6 [8:10]) 5 times, P6, K5.

1st to 8th row sets cables and g-st border.

Working in patt as set (throughout) cont until work measures 31 [36:41]cm, ending with a ws row.**

Place a marker thread at end of next row.

Work a further 24cm, 9½in, from **marker thread**, ending with a ws row. Cast off.

Right side.

Work as given for Left side until ** is reached.

Place a marker thread at beg of next row.

Work a further 24cm, 9½in, from **marker thread**, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Join cast on edge of Left section to marker at side edge of Right section. Join cast off edge of Right section from marker thread to lower edge of Left section. See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

NECK EDGINGS (Both Alike)

Work 2 sides separately, along each side of neck. With rs facing, **using 3.25mm needles** pick up and knit 50sts evenly along neck edge from point to point. Work 2 rows in g-st. Cast off knitways.

TO COMPLETE

Sew Neck Edgings in positions at points. See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

PLAIN PONCHO

BACK AND FRONT (Both Alike)

Using 3.25mm (US3) needles and thumb method cast on 127 [137:147]sts and work 8 rows in g-st.

Change to 4mm (US6) needles and working in st-st (throughout) work 2 rows.

1st Row: K61 [66:71], s1, K1, pss0, K1, K2tog, K61 [66:71]. 125 [135:145]sts.

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Knit.

4th Row: Purl.

Last 4 rows set shapings.

Work 64 [60:56] rows dec 2sts in centre of row **as before** in next and every foll 4th row. 93 [105:117]sts.

Work 28 [32:36] rows dec 2sts in centre of row **as before** in next and every foll alt row. 65 [73:81]sts.

Cast off.

NECK EDGINGS

Left side.

Join side seams. With rs facing, **using 4mm (US6) needles** pick up and knit 59 [65:69]sts evenly from centre point of V at Back to centre point of V at Front.

Work 6 rows in g-st dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 53 [59:63]sts. Cast off knitways.

Right side.

With rs facing, **using 4mm (US6) needles** pick up and knit 59 [65:69]sts evenly from centre point of V at Front to centre point of V at Back.

Work 6 rows in g-st dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 53 [59:63]sts. Cast off knitways.

TO MAKE UP

Join shaped edges of Neck Edgings at Front and Back. See ball band for care instructions.

HELMET

EAR FLAPS (Work 2)

Using 4mm (US6) needles and thumb method cast on 8sts and working in st-st (throughout) work 2 rows.

Shape sides.

1st Row: K2, m1, K4, m1, K2. 10sts.

2nd Row: P2, m1, P6, m1, P2. 12sts.

3rd Row: K2, m1, K8, m1, K2. 14sts.

4th Row: Purl.

5th Row: K2, m1, K10, m1, K2. 16sts.

6th Row: Purl.

7th Row: K2, m1, K12, m1, K2. 18sts.

8th Row: Purl.

9th Row: K2, m1, K14, m1, K2. 20sts.

10th Row: Purl.

Work 6 rows more without shaping. Leave these 20sts on a stitch holder.

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MAIN PART

Using 4mm (US6) needles and thumb method cast on 15sts, with rs facing knit across 20sts left on a stitch holder for first Ear Flap, cast on 35sts, with rs facing knit across 20sts left on a stitch holder for second Ear Flap, cast on 15sts. 105sts.

Commencing with 2nd row of st-st work for 14cm, 5½in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Crown.

1st Row: K1, (K2tog, K6) 13 times. 92sts.

2nd and Every Alt Row: Purl.

3rd Row: K1, (K2tog, K5) 13 times. 79sts.

5th Row: K1, (K2tog, K4) 13 times. 66sts.

7th Row: K1, (K2tog, K3) 13 times. 53sts.

9th Row: K1, (K2tog, K2) 13 times. 40sts.

11th Row: K1, (K2tog, K1) 13 times. 27sts.

13th Row: K1, (K2tog) 13 times. 14sts.

14th Row: (P2tog) 7 times. 7sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

Edging.

With rs facing, **using 3.25mm (US3) needles** pick up and knit 15sts from cast on sts at back of Hat, 48sts evenly all round edge of Ear Flap, 35sts from cast on sts at front of Hat, 48sts evenly all round edge of Ear Flap and 15sts from cast on sts at back of Hat. 161sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 4 rows.

Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Join back seam. See ball band for care instructions.

NECK SCARF

Using 4mm (US6) needles and thumb method cast on 32sts and work 4 rows in g-st.

1st Row: Knit.

2nd Row: K3, purl to last 3sts, K3.

1st and 2nd rows set st-st with g-st border.

Working in st-st with g-st border (throughout) cont until work measures 15cm, 6in, ending with a ws row.

Divide for Opening.

Next Row: K16, turn, leave rem 16sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 16sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row: K1, purl to last 3sts, K3.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 4 times more.

Leave these 16sts on a stitch holder.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem 16sts left on a stitch holder and knit to end.

Next Row: K3, purl to last st, K1.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 4 times more.

Next Row: K3, purl to end, with ws facing, work across

16sts left on a stitch holder, as follows:-

purl to last 3sts, K3. 32sts.

Cont in st-st with g-st border until work measures 81cm, 32in, ending with a ws row.

Work 3 rows in g-st. Cast off knitways.

TO MAKE UP

See ball band for pressing and care instructions.
