


Cabled Shrug



Cabled Shrug

Size

ONE SIZE To fit bust 34/38in (86/96cm)

Finished Measurements

Width 29in/74cm (flat across back)

Length 18in/46cm Sleeve Length 14in/36cm

Materials

US 10 (6mm) needles (x2)

US 10 (6mm) circular needle

480 gr (about 10 skeins) Noro Kureyon shade #326

Tension

Measured over st.st. using US 10 needles 16sts \times 23rs = 4in (10cm) square.

TENSION

VERY IMPORTANT: Wk a tension square, if too small use a larger needle, if too large use a smaller needle. It is essential to work to correct tension to achieve finished measurements stated.

ABBREVIATIONS (not all abbreviations apply to this pattern)

K = knit. NR = next row. P = purl. foll = following.

st(s) = stitch(es). **st.st.** = stocking stitch (RSF knit.

rs = rows. WSF pur

wk = work. **Rev.st.st.** = reverse stocking stitch

ins = inches. (RSF purl, WSF knit).
dec = decrease(ing). beg = beginning.

inc = increase(ing).

patt = pattern.

beg = beginning
alt = alternate.
ch = chain.

 $\mathbf{rep} = \mathbf{repeat}.$ $\mathbf{dc} = \mathbf{double}$ crochet.

 $\begin{aligned} & \text{tog} = \text{together.} & & \text{tr} = \text{treble.} \\ & \text{RSF/WSF} = \text{right/wrong side facing.} & & \text{yf} = \text{yarn forward.} \end{aligned}$

rem = remaining. $\mathbf{sl}\ 1 = \text{slip}$ one stitch.cont = continue. $\mathbf{psso} = \mathbf{pass}$ slipped stitch over.

M1P = make one stitch purlwise thus: pick up horizontal loop lying between last stitch worked and next stitch and purl into back of loop.

M1K = make one stitch thus: pick up horizontal loop lying between last stitch worked and next stitch and knit into back of loop.

T3F = slip next 2sts onto a cable needle and hold at front of work, purl next st from left hand needle then K2sts from cable needle.

T3B = Slip next stitch onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2sts from left hand needle then Purl stitch from cable needle.

C6F (**C6B**) = slip next 3sts onto a cable needle and hold at front (back) of work, knit next 3sts from left hand needle then K3sts from cable needle.

C4B = slip next 2sts onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2sts from left hand needle then K2sts from cable needle.

Instructions

BODY AND SLEEVES

Make in 1 piece.

RIGHT SLEEVE

With US 10 needles cast on 62sts and wk as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) P1, [K4, P4] 7 times, K4, P1. Row 2: K all K sts and P all P sts to end.

Rep the last 2 rs twice more.

Row 7: P1, [C4B, P4] 7 times, C4B, P1.

Row 8: As row 2.

Row 9: As row 1.

Row 10: As row 2

Rep these 10 rs for a further 72rs.

Place a colored marker at each end of the last row.

BACK

Patt a further 170rs.

Place a colored marker at each end of the last row.

LEFT SLEEVE

Patt a further 82rs.

Cast off.

BODY

RSF with US 10 circular needle pick up and K156 sts evenly from one colored marker to the other colored marker on the same side and then pick up and knit a further 156sts from colored marker to colored marker on the

other side. 312sts. Working in rounds wk as follows: Round 1: *P4, K4, rep from * to end. Rep round 1 for a further 3 rounds. Round 5: * P4, C4B, rep from * to end. Rep round 1 for a further 5 rounds. Rep these 10 rounds twice more. Rep round 1 only for a further 20 rounds. Cast off.

MAKEUP

Sew up right sleeve seam from cast on row to colored marker. Sew up left sleeve seam from cast off row to colored marker.
