# LADIES' SWEATER

**SILK GARDEN LITE** » YS584

## SIZE

One size to fit bust 34-38 in./86-96 cm.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**WIDTH (across back)** 31 in./79 cm.

**LENGTH** 21 in./53 cm.

**SLEEVE LENGTH** 9 in./23 cm.

## MATERIALS

340 grs. Noro **Silk Garden Lite** shade 2109

1 pair of 5 mm. (US8) needles.

## TENSION

Measured over patt using 5 mm. needles 18 sts x 21 rs = 10 cm. (4 in.) square.

## BACK

With 5 mm. needles cast on 94 sts and knit to end tbl.

Wk patt as follows:

**Row 1:** (RSF) K2, \*K1, yf, K2, sl 1, K1, pssso, K2tog, K2, yf, rep from \* to the last 2sts, K2.

**Row 2:** Purl to end.

**Row 3:** K2, \*yf, K2, sl 1, K1, pssso, K2tog, K2, yf, K1, rep from \* to the last 2sts, K2.

**Row 4:** Purl to end.

Rep these 4 rs for a further 50 rs.

Place a coloured marker at the end of the last row.

Cont in patt for a further 58 rs.

Place a coloured marker at the end of the last row.

Cont in patt for a further 54 rs. Cast off.

## FRONT

Wk as given for back.

## SLEEVES

Join shoulder seams by joining from coloured markers out to cast on and cast off rows of back and front. Remove coloured markers. Count down 25 sts on both the back and front from the shoulder seam placing a coloured marker at each point. RSF with 5 mm. needles pick up and K49 sts from coloured marker to coloured marker.

**NR:** (WSF) Purl to end.

Wk lace patt as given for back **AT THE SAME TIME** dec 1 st at each end of row 7 and every foll 4th and 6th row alternatively until 33 sts rem. Wk straight for 5 rs. Cast off.

## MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams.

# Tension

<b>alt</b>	alternate

<b>C4F</b>	slip next 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold at front of work, knit next 2 sts from left hand needle then K2 sts from cable needle
<b>C8B</b>	slip next 4 sts onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 4 sts from left hand needle then K4 sts from cable needle
<b>C10B</b>	slip next 5 sts onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 5 sts from left hand needle then K5 sts from cable needle
<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>ch sp</b>	chain space
<b>cm.</b>	centimeter(s)
<b>cont</b>	continue
<b>dc</b>	double crochet
<b>dec</b>	decrease(ing)
<b>foll</b>	following
<b>grs.</b>	grams
<b>in.</b>	inch(es)
<b>inc</b>	increase(ing)
<b>K</b>	knit
<b>M1K</b>	pick up horizontal loop lying between last stitch worked and next stitch and knit into back of loop
<b>M1P</b>	pick up horizontal loop lying between last stitch worked and next stitch and purl into back of loop
<b>mm.</b>	millimeter(s)
<b>NR</b>	next row
<b>P</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>psso</b>	pass slipped stitch over
<b>rem</b>	remaining
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>Rev.st.st.</b>	reverse stocking stitch (RSF purl, WSF knit)
<b>rs</b>	rows
<b>RSF/WSF</b>	right/wrong side facing
<b>sl 1</b>	slip one stitch
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>St.st.</b>	stocking/stockinette stitch (RSF knit, WSF purl)
<b>tbl</b>	through back of loop
<b>tch</b>	turning chain
<b>tog</b>	together
<b>tr</b>	treble
<b>wk</b>	work
<b>yf</b>	yarn forward
<b>yfrn</b>	yarn forward around needle
<b>yan</b>	yarn around needle
<b>yon</b>	yarn over needle
<b>Twist 3</b>	slip next stitch onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, slip the next stitch onto right hand needle then slip the stitch from cable needle back onto left hand then slip the stitch from right hand needle back onto left hand needle and K3tog tbl

## VERY IMPORTANT!

Work a tension square, if too small use a larger needle, if too large use a smaller needle. It is essential to work to correct tension to achieve the finished measurements stated.
