## LADIES' TOP *SILK GARDEN SOCK »* YS589

### SIZES

To fit bust	32-34 in.	34-36 in.	36-38 in.

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

WIDTH (underarm)	36 in./91 cm.	38½ in./98 cm.	41 in./104 cm.
LENGTH	26 in./66 cm.	27 in./69 cm.	28 in./71 cm.

### MATERIALS

180 grs. Noro <b>Silk</b>	Garden Soc	ck 🛛	
<ul> <li>shade S87</li> </ul>	180 grs.	180 grs.	180 grs.

1 pair of 4 mm. (US6) needles.

### TENSION

Measured over patt using 4 mm. needles 18 sts x 25 rs = 10 cm. (4 in.) square.

### BACK

With 4 mm. needles cast on 81 (87, 93) sts and Knit 6 rs. Then wk patt as follows:

**Row 1:** (RSF) P3, \* yon, twist 3, yfrn, P3, rep from \* to end. **Row 2:** K3, \* P3, K3, rep from \* to end.

Rep the last 2 rs until back measures 18 (18½, 19) in. from beg ending with a wrong side row. Place a coloured marker at each end of the last row. Cont in patt for a further 6 (6%, 7) in. ending with a wrong side row. \*\*

### SHAPE SHOULDER RSF

Row 1: Cast off 4 (5, 5) sts and patt to end.

**Row 2:** As row 1.

Rep the last 2 rs once more.

**Row 5:** Cast off 4 (4, 5) sts and patt to end.

**Row 6:** As row 5.

### SHAPE BACK NECK

- **Row 7:** Cast off 4 (4, 5) sts, patt until 12 (12, 12) sts on right hand needle, turn and put rem sts on a spare needle.
- **Row 8:** Cast off 2 sts and patt to end. **Row 9:** Cast off 4 (4, 4) sts and patt to end.
- **Row 10:** As row 8.

Cast off rem 4 (4, 4) sts. Return to the sts on the spare needle. RSF rejoin yarn and cast off the centre 25 (27, 29) sts.

Cont on rem 16 (16, 17) sts as follows:

- Row 7: Patt to end.
- Row 8: Cast off 4 (4, 5) sts and patt to end.
- Row 9: Cast off 2 sts and patt to end.
- Row 10: Cast off 4 (4, 4) sts and patt to end.

Row 11: As row 9.

Cast off rem 4 (4, 4) sts.

### FRONT

Cast on and wk as given for back up to \*\*

SHAPE FRONT NECK & SHOULDERS RSF

- **Row 1:** Cast off 4 (5, 5) sts, patt until 24 (25, 27) sts on right hand needle, turn and put rem sts on a spare needle.
- Row 2: Wk 2 sts tog and patt to end.
- **Row 3:** Cast off 4 (5, 5) sts, patt to the last 2 sts, wk 2 sts tog. **Row 4:** As row 2.
- **Row 5:** Cast off 4 (4, 5) sts, patt to the last 2 sts, wk 2 sts tog.
- Row 6: Patt to end.
- Row 7: Cast off 4 (4, 5) sts and patt to end.
- Row 8: Patt to end.
- Row 9: Cast off 4 (4, 4) sts and patt to end.
- Row 10: Patt to end.

Cast off rem 4 (4, 4) sts. Return to the sts on the spare needle. RSF rejoin yarn and cast off the centre 25 (27, 29) sts. Cont on rem 28 (30, 32) sts as follows:

- Row 1: Patt to end.
- Row 2: Cast off 4 (5, 5) sts, patt to the last 2 sts, wk 2 sts tog.
- **Row 3:** Wk 2 sts tog and patt to end.
- Row 4: Cast off 4 (5, 5) sts, patt to the last 2 sts, wk 2 sts tog.
- **Row 5:** As row 3.
- Row 6: Cast off 4 (4, 5) sts and patt to end.
- Row 7: Patt to end.
- Row 8: Cast off 4 (4, 5) sts and patt to end.
- Row 9: Patt to end.
- Row 10: Cast off 4 (4, 4) sts and patt to end.
- Row 11: Patt to end.

Cast off rem 4 (4, 4) sts.

### NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. RSF with 4 mm. needles pick up and knit around neck edge as follows:

12 sts evenly down left front neck edge, 25 (27, 29) sts across centre front, 12 sts evenly up right front neck edge, 6 sts down right back neck edge, 25 (27, 29) sts across centre back neck and 6 sts evenly up left back neck edge. 86 (90, 94) sts. Knit 5 rs. Cast off.

### ARMBANDS

Join left shoulder and neckband seams. RSF with 4 mm. needles pick up and K62 (66, 70) sts evenly around armhole from coloured marker to coloured marker. Knit 5 rs. Cast off.

### MAKEUP

Sew up side and armband seams.

C10B	slip next 5 sts onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 5 sts from left hand needle then K5 sts from cable needle

### **VERY IMPORTANT!**

Work a tension square, if too small use a larger needle, if too large use a smaller needle. It is essential to work to correct tension to achieve the finished measurements stated.
