What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 311 White A, 512 Turqua B, 319 Cherry Red C, and 3620 Glowworm D. Note Only small quantities of each color are needed for this project.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 3.75mm [US F-5]

Yarn needle, stitch marker, polyester fiberfill, embroidery floss in black, orange, and white

GAUGE: 4 sc = 1" (2.5 cm); 4 rounds = 1" (2.5 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Amigurumi Snowman Ornaments

This little Snowman is quick to crochet and will add to your décor all winter long. Use him throughout your house, as an ornament or as a package tie-on. You'll love how he reflects your love of crochet!

Ornament measures 6" (15 cm) tall, excluding pompom.

Notes

- 1. All sections except hat are worked in unjoined rounds with right side facing at all times. Place marker for beginning of round and move marker up as each round is completed. Do not join until instructed.
2. Hat is worked in turned rows.

Special Stitch


sc2tog = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

ORNAMENT (make 1 each with B and C for hat) Head

- Beginning at top, with A, ch 2.
Round 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook—6 sc. Place marker for beginning of round and move marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around—12 sc.
Round 3: *Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around—18 sc.
Round 4: *Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around—24 sc.
Round 5: Sc in each sc around.
Round 6: *Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around—30 sc.
Rounds 7-11: Repeat Round 5.
Round 12: *Sc2tog; repeat from * around—15 sc.
Round 13: Repeat Round 5; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Facial Features

Refer to photograph as a guide for placement. With 6 strands of black embroidery floss, embroider French knot eyes on Round 10 and back stitches in a curve where desired for the mouth. With 12 strands of orange embroidery floss, make a French knot between the eyes and mouth, wrapping floss 3 times around needle to make a prominent carrot nose.



Body

- Beginning at bottom, with A, ch 2.
Rounds 1 and 2: Work same as Rounds 1 and 2 of head—12 sc.
Round 3: *Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around—15 sc.
Rounds 4-8: Work same as Round 5 of head.
Round 9: *Sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog; repeat from * around—12 sc.
Round 10: Work same as Round 5 of head. Stuff body with fiberfill.
Round 11: Work same as Round 12 of head; join with slip st in first sc—6 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Weave tail through last round and pull closed.

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Arm (make 2)

With **A**, ch 2.

Round 1: Work same as Round 1 of head—6 sc.

Round 2: Repeat Round 3 of head—9 sc.

Rounds 3–6: Repeat Round 5 of head; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Do not stuff.

Hat

Ribbing

Ch 5.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—4 sc.

Rows 2–30: Ch 1, sc in back loop of each sc across, turn.

Crown

Row 1 (right side): Ch 1, working in ends of rows, sc in each row across, turn—30 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, *sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog; repeat from * across, turn—24 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog; repeat from * across, turn—18 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, *sc in next sc, sc2tog; repeat from * across, turn—12 sc.

Row 6: Ch 1, *sc2tog; repeat from across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Assembly

Arms Weave tail through last round and pull stitches closed, then sew in place at top of body.

Head & Body Stuff head with fiberfill.

Push Round 13 of head onto top of body. With end tail, sew securely around to join head to body.

Hat Weave tail through last row and pull closed. Working through ends of rows, sew back seam. Working in ends of rows of ribbing, sew hat on head.

FINISHING

Pompom (make 2)

Cut a 15" (38 cm) strand of **D** and set aside. Wrap **D** around 4 fingers 50 times. Carefully slide loops off fingers and tie single strand very tightly around center of loops. Do not cut or trim center tie. Cut loops open at both ends. Shake and trim evenly to desired length. Thread ends of center tie through top of hat and secure pompom.

Cut strand of white embroidery floss to desired length for hanging loop, thread through top of ornament and tie ends in a knot.

Weave in ends.

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.;
ch = chain(s); **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
