crochet

Designed by Double Stitch Twins

What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft: 2 (2, 2) balls each 00001 White A, 00004 Wine B and 3 (3, 5) balls 00014 Black C


Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

18 cm [7"] zipper in color to match C, sewing needle and matching thread, stitch markers, yarn needle, hook-and-eye closure.

TENSION/GAUGE: 14 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 11 rows = 10 cm [4"] in half treble crochet. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the tension/gauge.

Baby Doll Top

This one shoulder top is perfect for a romantic dinner in classic black and white with wine trim. Make it in other colours for a different but just as stunning look.

Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium and Large are in parentheses.

To fit bust: 81 (91, 101) cm [32 (36, 40)"]

Finished Bust: 68 (78, 88) cm [27 (30¾, 34½)"]

Finished Length: 45 (46, 47) cm [17¾ (18¼, 18¾)"]

Note

Top is designed to fit snugly, with negative ease. Fit can be customized with back panel.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

Htr2tog = [Yarn over, insert hook into next st, yarn over and pull up loop] 2 times, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

BODICE

With A, ch 83 (91, 99).

Row 1: Htr in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—82 (90, 98) htr.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as htr), htr in each htr across, turn. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 15 (16, 18) cm [6 (6½, 7)"] from beginning. Fasten off.

Band

Row 1: With right side facing, join B in first st, ch 1, dc in each st across, turn.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, dc in each dc across, turn. Fasten off at end of Row 4.

Skirt

Row 1: With right side facing, join C, ch 2 (counts as tr), tr in next 23 (28, 32) sts, *[3 tr in next dc, tr in next 2 dc] 5 times, tr in next 4 dc; repeat from * once more, tr to end—102 (110, 118) tr.

Rows 2-10: Ch 3 (counts as dtr), dtr in each st across, turn.

Row 11: Ch 3 (counts as dtr), dtr in each st across, changing to B on last st, turn. Cut C.

Ruffle

Row 1: With B, ch 3 (counts as htr), htr in next 5 (1, 3) dtr, *2 htr in next dtr, htr in next 5 dtr; repeat from * across, turn—118 (128, 137) sts.

Rows 2: Ch 2 (counts as tr), 3 tr in each htr to last st, tr in last htr, turn—350 (380, 407) tr.

Row 3: Ch 1 (counts as htr), htr in each tr across, changing to C on last st, turn.

Row 4: With C, ch 1, dc in each htr across. Fasten off.

Left Back Panel

Row 1: With C and right side facing, join yarn at corner of ruffle on left back, ch 1 (counts as htr), htr 60 (61, 63) sts evenly spaced up left back, turn.

Rows 2-5 (7, 9): Ch 1 (counts as htr), htr in each htr across, turn. Fasten off at the end of last row. Add more or fewer rows here and on right back panel to customize fit.

Right Back Panel

Row 1: With C and right side facing, join yarn at upper corner of right back, ch 1 (counts as htr), htr 60 (61, 63) sts evenly spaced down right back, turn. Complete as for Left Back Panel.

Insert zipper: Fold tabs at top of zipper to wrong side of zipper. Pin right side of zipper to wrong side of left and right back panels, placing top of zipper 6mm [¼"] below top edge. Sew in place.

With right sides of right and left back panels together, join C below bottom of zipper; single crochet through both back panels to create center back seam.

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Shoulder Strap

Fold piece in half with zipper at center back. With front of top facing, measure 23 (24, 25) cm [9 ½, 9¾"]

from right underarm fold; place marker to indicate beginning of shoulder strap placement.

Row 1: With **A**, join yarn at marked st, ch 1, htr in next 9 sts, turn—9 htr.

Rows 2–6: Ch 2 (counts as htr), htr in each htr across, turn.

Rows 7–11: Ch 1, htr2tog, htr in each htr across, turn—4 htr.

Rows 12–18: Ch 1, htr in each htr across, turn.

Row 19: Ch 1, htr2tog, htr in next 2 htr, turn—3 htr.

Rows 20–31 (32, 33): Ch 1, htr in each htr across, turn. Fasten off at the end of Row 31 (32, 33), leaving a 51 cm [20"] tail.

FINISHING

Try on top and pin strap to upper right back edge to fit. Using yarn tail, sew end of strap to back bodice.

With right side facing, join **A** at top of left back panel, ch 1, dc in each stitch along the top edge of bodice, along left side of shoulder strap, and along top of right back bodice and right back panel. Fasten off.

With right side facing, join **A** at back right corner of shoulder strap, ch 1, dc evenly along the right side of shoulder strap and along remaining top edge of bodice. Fasten off.

Sew hook-and-eye closure at top of zipper.

Shoulder Ruffles (Make 3)

Row 1: With **A**, ch 10, tr in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as tr), 3 tr in each tr across, turn.


Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as tr), 3 tr in each tr across. Fasten off.

With **A**, sew first row of each ruffle vertically along wide base of shoulder strap.

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **dtr** = double treble crochet; **htr** = half treble crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **tr** = triple or treble crochet; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.



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
