What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 2 balls of 09940 Plummy

Double Pointed Needles: 5 mm [US 8]

Straight Knitting Needles: 5 mm [US 8]

Stitch markers, stitch holder, yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 16 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 20 rows = 10 cm [4"] in Stockinette stitch. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the tension/gauge.

Berry-licious Scarf and Wristers

Almost every little girl loves purple, and every little girl who loves purple will love these soft wristers and this purple-licious scarf. They'll keep her warm and cozy all winter long!

Directions are for size 2; changes for size 4, 6, and 8 are in parentheses.

Wristers measure 11 (12, 12, 13) cm [4¼ (4¾, 4¾, 5¼)"] circumference.

Scarf measures approximately 10 cm [4"] wide and 122 cm [48"] long.

SPECIAL STITCHES

M1 = Make 1 (Increase) – Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and knit strand through the back loop, twisting the stitch to prevent a hole in the fabric.

WRISTERS (Make 2)

CUFF

With double pointed needles, cast on 17 (19, 19, 21) sts. Divide sts evenly around needles. Join, being careful that sts are not twisted, and begin working in the round. Place marker for beginning of round.

Round 1 (Right side): Knit around.

Round 2: Purl around.

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 until piece measures approximately 2.5 cm [1"] from cast-on edge. Knit around until piece measures 4.5 (5, 5.5, 6.5) cm [1¾ (2, 2¼, 2½)"] from cast-on edge.

THUMB GUSSET

Round 1: K8 (9, 9, 10), place marker, k1, place marker, k8 (9, 9, 10).

Round 2: Knit to marker, slip marker, M1, knit to next marker, M1, slip marker, knit around – 19 (21, 21, 23) sts.

Rounds 3 and 4: Knit around.

Repeat Rounds 2-4 until there are 7 (7, 9, 9) sts between markers, ending with Round 2 – 23 (25, 27, 29) sts.

Next Round: Knit around to first marker, remove marker, place 7 (7, 9, 9) sts on holder, cast on 1 st, remove marker, knit around.

HAND

Knit around until piece measures approximately 9 (10, 11, 12.5) cm [3½ (4, 4½, 5)"] from cast-on edge.

Round 1: Knit around.

Round 2: Purl around.

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 until piece measures approximately 11 (12, 12.5, 14.5) cm [4¼ (4¾, 5, 5¾)"] from cast-on edge. Cast off all stitches in pattern.

THUMB

Divide 7 (7, 9, 9) sts from holder onto double pointed needles. Pick up and knit 1 st over cast-on st, knit around – 8 (8, 10, 10) sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

Round 1 (Right side): Knit around.

Round 2: Purl around.

Cast off all sts in knit.

SCARF

With straight knitting needles, cast on 18 sts.

Row 1 (Right side): Knit across.

Rows 2-7: Knit across.

Row 8: Purl across.

Row 9: Knit across.

Row 10: Purl across.

Rows 11-18: Repeat Rows 9 and 10 four times.

Row 19-26: Knit across.

Repeat Rows 7-26 for pattern until piece measures approximately 119 cm [47"] from cast-on edge or to desired length.

Cast off all stitches in knit.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; centimeters; **k** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
