What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 2 balls 00014 Black A

RED HEART® Soft Baby Steps®: 2 balls 00004 Strawberry B

Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 10 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 8 rows = 10 cm [4"] in treble crochet. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the tension/gauge.

Bright Stripes Cowl

Sport a bright yarn colour with black for an energized, bold new look. But, of course, you can choose to crochet this cowl in any colour you wish! Cowl measures 20 cm [8"] x 152 cm [60"].

NOTES

Cowl is worked in turned rows then seamed to form circle.

To change colour, work last stitch of old colour to last yarn over. Yarn over with new colour and draw through all loops to complete stitch. Proceed with new colour. Carry old colour loosely up side of piece until next needed.

COWL

With A, ch 153.

Row 1 (Right Side): Tr in 4th ch from hook and in each remaining ch across – 150 sts. Row 2 (Wrong Side): Ch 3 (counts as first tr here and throughout), turn, skip first st, tr in each remaining st across, changing to **B** in last st.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, dc in each st across.

Row 4: Repeat Row 3, changing to A in last st.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, skip first st, tr in each remaining st across.

Row 6: Repeat Row 2.

Rows 7-14: Repeat Rows 3-6 twice.

Rows 15-16: Repeat Rows 3-4 once. Fasten

off.

Edging

Row 1: Join B with slip st in first ch on opposite side of foundation ch, dc in same ch and in each remaining ch across – 150 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, dc in each st across. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

With right sides facing, align row ends and sew seam with yarn tail to form circle. Weave in ends. Wrap around neck twice to wear.

Abbreviations

A, B, C = Colour A, B, C; ch = chain; cm = centimetres; dc = double crochet; mm = millimetres; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = triple or treble crochet.
