

## Circles in Squares Throw

WR2151


Designed by Katherine Eng.

Throw measures 48" x 64".

RED HEART® "Super Saver®": 1 skein each 373 Petal Pink A, 320 Cornmeal B, 505 Aruba Sea D, 624 Tea Leaf E, 376 Burgundy F, 387 Soft Navy G, 406 Medium Thyme H, and 256 Carrot I; 3 skeins 400 Grey Heather C.

Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10].
Yarn needle.
GAUGE: Rnds 1-3 = 4.5" across. Completed square = 15" across. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

NOTE: After the first square, all others are joined while working Joining Round 18.

## THROW

## Square Version 1A (Make 2)

With G, ch 4; join with a slip st to form a ring.
Round 1: Ch 3, 15 dc in ring; join with a slip st in top of ch-3-16 sts.
Round 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in same st as joining and in each dc around; join in first sc - 32 sc.
Round 3: Ch 3, dc in first sc, * dc in next 3 sc **, 2 dc in next sc; repeat from * around, end at **; join - 40 sts. Fasten off.
Round 4: Join Hin any st; ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in same st, * skip next st, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in next st; repeat from * to last st; skip last st; join.
Round 5: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 1, * (sc, ch 2, sc) all in ch-2 space; repeat from * around; join.
Round 6: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 1, * (sc, ch 2, sc) all in ch-2 space, ch 1; repeat from * around; join.
Round 7: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 1, * sc in ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in ch-1 space, ch 1; repeat from * around; join. Fasten off.
Round 8: Join $\mathbf{B}$ in any sc; ch 1, sc in same sc, sc in each ch-1 space and sc around; join - 80 sc.
Round 9: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join. Fasten off.
Round 10: Join I in an sc above a ch-1 space of Rnd 7; repeat Rnd 4. Fasten off.
Round 11: Join $F$ in any ch-2 space; ch 1, sc in same space, ch 2, * sc in next ch-2 space, ch 2; repeat from * around; join.
Round 12: Ch 3, * 2 dc in next ch-2 space **, dc in next sc; repeat from * around, end at **; join.
Round 13: Ch 1, sc in each dc around; join - 120 sc. Fasten off. Round 14: Join E in any sc; ch 1, sc in each sc around; join. Fasten off.
Round 15: Join C in an sc above a dc worked in an sc on Rnd 11 (follow sts above the dc to sc of Rnd 13); ch 1, sc in each sc around; join.
Round 16: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, * hdc in next 3 sc, dc in next 3 sc , tr in next 2 sc , ( 2 tr , ch 2, 2 tr ) all in next sc, tr in next 2 sc , dc in next 3 sc , hdc in next 3 sc , sc in next 3 sc , slip st in next 7 sc , sc in next 3 sc ; repeat from * around ending with sc in last sc; join.
Round 17: Ch 1, sc in each sc, hdc in each hdc, dc in each dc, tr in each tr and slip st in each slip st around and work ( 2 tr, ch 2, 2 tr) all in each corner ch-2 space; join.
Round 18 (Note: Work this rnd only once; all other squares should work Joining Round 18): * Ch 2, skip 1 st, slip st in next st; repeat from * to corner; ch 2, skip next tr, (slip st, ch 4, slip st) all in corner ch-2 space; repeat from * around; ch 2, skip last sc, slip st in slip st of Rnd 17 - 19 ch-2 spaces on each side between ch-4 corners. Fasten off.

Joining Round 18 (Join 1 or 2 sides as required): * Ch 2, skip 1 st, slip st in next st; repeat from * to corner; ch 2, skip next tr, slip st in corner space, ch 2, drop loop from
hook, draw loop under to over through corresponding ch-4 space on completed square, ch 2, slip st in same corner space - corner joined; ** ch 1, drop loop from hook, draw loop under to over through corresponding ch-2 space on completed square, ch 1, skip 1 st, slip st in next st; repeat from ** to corner; join next corner as before; *** ch 2, skip 1 st, slip st in next st; repeat from *** to corner; ch 2, skip next tr, (slip st, ch 4, slip st) all in corner ch-2 space; repeat from *** around; ch 2, skip last sc, slip st in slip st of Round 17. Fasten off.

## Square Version 1B (Make 2)

Work same as Version 1A except work Round 14 with D.

## Square Version 2 (Make 4)

Rounds 1 and 2: Work same as Version 1 with A. Fasten off.
Rounds 3-5: Work with I. Fasten off.
Rounds 6 and 7: Work with G. Fasten off.
Rounds 8, 9, 10: Work with D. Fasten off.
Rounds 11 and 12: Work with F. Fasten off.
Round 13: Work with A. Fasten off.
Round 14: Work with I. Fasten off.
Rounds 15- Joining Round 18: Repeat Rounds 15-Joining Round18.

## Square Version 3 (Make 4)

Rounds 1-3: Work same as Version 1 with E. Fasten off.
Rounds 4 and 5: Work with F. Fasten off.
Round 6: Work with I. Fasten off.
Rounds 7 and 8: Work with B. Fasten off.
Rounds 9 and 10: Work with G. Fasten off.
Rounds 11-13: Work with H. Fasten off.
Round 14: Work with E. Fasten off.
Rounds 15- Joining Rnd 18: Repeat Rounds 15-Joining
Round 18.

## Border

Round 1: With right side facing, join $\mathbf{C}$ in any ch-2 space on any side edge away from corner; * ch 2, slip st in next ch-2 space; repeat from * around working at each joining seam: ch 2, slip st in space to the right of joining seam, ch 2, slip st in next space to the left of seam; and at each of 4 corners work: ch 2, (slip st, ch 4, slip st) in corner ch-4 space. At end of rnd, ch 2, slip st in same space as joining; TURN.
Round 2: Slip st in next ch-2 space, * ch 2, slip st in next ch-2 space; repeat from * around working corners as for Rnd 1. At end of rnd, ch 2 , slip st in first slip st. Fasten off. TURN.
Round 3: With right side facing, join $F$ in any ch-2 space; ch 1, sc in same space, * ch 1, sc in next ch-2 space;
repeat from * around working at each corner: ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-4 space. At end of rnd, ch 1; join. Fasten off.
Round 4: With right side facing, join $\mathbf{G}$ in any ch-1 space away from corner; ch 1, work (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch-1 space around and work (sc, ch 2, sc, ch 3 , sc, ch 2, sc) all in each corner ch-2 space; join; TURN.
Round 5: Slip st to next ch-2 space; ch 1, work (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch-2 space and work (sc, ch 3, sc) in each ch-3 space of corner; join; TURN.
Round 6: Slip st to next ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in same space, ch 1, * sc in next ch-2 space, ch 1; repeat from * to corner; (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-3 space, ch 1; repeat from * around; join. Fasten off.
Round 7: Repeat Round 4 with D. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
