### What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:**  
2 skeins each 324 Bright Yellow **A**,  
1 skein 311 White **B**, 1 skein 672  
Spring Green **C**

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle, stitch holders  
(optional)

**GAUGE:** Daisy Motif measures 6"  
(15 cm) square. **CHECK YOUR  
GAUGE. Use any size hook to  
obtain the gauge.**

## Daisy Garden Blanket

*Fresh as a summer daisy, this pretty blanket is  
perfect for baby or toddler. Crochet it in bright  
shades as shown, or softer colors if you please.  
Then add a ruffle for the perfect finishing touch!*

**Throw measures 41" x 41" (104 cm x 104  
cm)**

### Special Stitch

#### Surface slip st

Holding yarn behind work, insert hook from  
front to back between the posts of two  
stitches on the previous round as indicated,  
yarn over and pull loop through to make a  
slip stitch. Do not pull stitches too tightly, or  
edge will pucker.

### DAISY MOTIF (Make 36)

With **A**, ch 4, join with slip st in first ch to  
form ring.

**Round 1 (Right Side):** Ch 3 (counts as first  
dc now and throughout), work 11 dc into  
ring; slip st in top of ch-3 to join—12 dc.  
Fasten off.

**Round 2:** Join **B** in any dc, ch 3, dc in the  
same dc, \* 2 dc in next dc; repeat from \*  
around; slip st in top of ch-3 to join—24 dc  
(12 pairs). Fasten off.

**Note:** For Round 3, work into the spaces  
between sts, NOT into the sts.

**Round 3:** Join **C** in the space between any  
pair of dc, (ch 3, dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in the same  
space, \* [ch 1, skip 2 dc, 2 dc in next space]  
twice, ch 1, skip 2 dc,\*\* (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in  
next space; repeat from \* twice, then from \*  
to \*\* once; slip st in top of ch-3 to join—32  
dc and 16 ch-1 spaces.

**Round 4:** Slip st in the next dc and ch-1  
space, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same ch-1  
space, \* [skip 2 dc, 3 dc in next ch-1 space]  
3 times, skip 2 dc,\*\* (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in ch-1  
corner space; repeat from \* twice, then from  
\* to \*\* once; slip st in top of ch-3 to join—60  
dc and 4 ch-1 spaces. Fasten off.

**Round 5:** Join **B** in any ch-1 corner space,  
ch 1 (does not count as a st now and  
throughout), \* 3 hdc in ch-1 space, hdc in  
next 15 dc; repeat from \* around; slip st in  
first hdc to join—72 hdc. Fasten off.

**Round 6:** Join **C** in the second hdc of Round  
5 (the corner st), ch 1, \* 3 hdc in the corner  
st, hdc in next 17 hdc; repeat from \* around;  
slip st in first hdc to join—80 hdc. Fasten off  
and weave in ends.

### Joining Motifs

**Note:** Seams are worked by holding 2 Motifs  
with Wrong Sides together and inserting the  
hook through the stitches of both Motifs,  
then drawing up a loop and completing  
the new stitch. (It may be helpful to use  
stitch holders to connect the unworked  
sides and edges of the Motifs so the strips of  
Motifs will hold together until all Seams are  
completed.)

**Horizontal Seam (Make 5):** Match both  
upper right corner hdc; join **A** in corner; ch  
1, \* sc in corner hdc and next 20 hdc, ending  
in upper left corner—21 sc.

Without breaking yarn, continue joining  
pairs of Motifs until there is a strip of 2 rows  
of 6 Motifs each. Fasten off.

Add the next Motif by matching a loose

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Motif to the Motif at the top right of the strip of 12 Motifs (Wrong sides together). Work a Horizontal Seam across these 2 Motifs.

Continue working, joining Motifs across the top of the strip of 12 Motifs. When the third horizontal row is completed, there will be a strip of 18 Motifs.

Continue joining Motifs in the same way until you have 6 strips of 6 Motifs each. Fasten off.

**Vertical Seam (Make 5):** Turn partially joined Blanket and work the unjoined Motifs in the same way as the Horizontal Seams, crocheting over the tops of the Horizontal Seams. Fasten off and weave in ends.

## BORDER

**Round 1 (Right Side):** Join **A** in any corner hdc, ch 1, \*3 hdc in the corner st; hdc in each hdc across the side up to the corner, working into the side of the sc from the Seam instead of in the hdc from Round 6 as needed—123 hdc. Repeat from \* 3 times; slip st in first hdc to join—492 hdc.

**Round 2:** Ch 3, dc in the same hdc, 2 dc in each hdc around; slip st in top of ch-3 to join—984 dc.

**Round 3:** Ch 3, dc in each dc around; slip st in top of ch-3 to join. Fasten off.

**Round 4:** With slip knot on hook, join **B** in the space between any pair of dc, surface slip st around the post of each dc from Round 3 (see Special Stitch above); slip st in first st to join. Fasten off and weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **g** = grams; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **oz** = ounces; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yds** = yards; **( )** = work all directions in parentheses in the indicated stitch or space; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; **\* or \*\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.



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
