What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 2 skeins 319 Cherry Red

Susan Bates® Double Pointed Knitting Needles: 5.5mm [US 9], set of 4

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Yarn needle

GAUGE: 28 sts = 4" (10 cm); 23 rows = 4" (10 cm) in pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Devilish Hat and Scarf

Whether it's a stylish Halloween event or you just want a look that says "hot", this set of knit warmers will charm them.

Directions are written for small/medium with changes for medium/large in parentheses.

Hat measures: 20 (22)" (51 (56) cm) circumference

Scarf measures: 4" (10 cm) wide and 60" (152 cm) long

Special Stitch

Knit Increase (Inc) – knit into the front and back of the stitch indicated (1 stitch increase).

HAT

Body

Cast on 78 (90) sts, evenly on double pointed needles. Join being careful not to twist sts.

Round 1 (RS): (K4, P2) around.

Repeat Round 1 until piece measures approximately 7" (18 cm) from cast on edge.

Crown

Round 1 (RS): (K2 tog, K2, P2) around: 65 (75) sts.

Round 2: (K3, P2) around.

Round 3: (K2 tog, K1, P2) around: 52 (60) sts.

Round 4: (K2, P2) around.

Round 5: K2 tog around: 26 (30) sts.

Cut yarn leaving a 6" (15 cm) end. Thread yarn needle with end and draw through remaining sts. Pull tightly and fasten securely.

Horn (Make 2)

Cast on 3 sts onto one double pointed needle.

Row 1 (RS): Knit across.

Row 2: With RS facing, slide sts to opposite end of needle, keeping yarn to the back and holding tension to prevent gaps, knit across.

Row 3: Inc around: 6 sts.

Transfer first 2 sts to a second double pointed needle and the last 2 sts to a third double pointed needle. Begin working in rounds.

Rows 4 and 5: Knit around.

Row 6: (K2, Inc) around: 8 sts.

Rows 7 and 8: Knit around.

Row 9: (K1, Inc) around: 12 sts.

Rows 10-15: (K3, P1) around.

Bind off all sts leaving a 12" (30 cm) end.

Thread yarn needle with the long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Horn to either side of Crown.

SCARF

Cast on 28 sts.

Row 1 (RS): (K4, P2) across to last 4 sts, K4.

Row 2: K2, P2, K2 (P4, K2) across to last 4 sts, P2, K2.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for pattern until piece measures 60" (152 cm) from cast on edge.

Bind off all sts in knit.

FINISHING

Sew cast-on edge to bind-off edge. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit; **k2tog** = knit 2 sts together; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work instructions in parentheses as indicated.
