What you will need:

RED HEART[®] Super Saver[®]: 4 skeins 520 Minty

Susan Bates* Knitting Needles: 5.5mm [US 9] circular needle 36" [90 cm] needle (or longer)

Cable needle, yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 22 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Cable and Seed stitch pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Easy Cables & Texture Throw

If you're looking to add a color accent while still keeping your relaxing spot calm and peaceful, choose this one color throw. You'll enjoy getting into the rhythm of the alternating cables and seed stitches as you knit this beauty. Throw measures about 50 x 54" [127 x 137 cm].

Notes

- Throw is worked in a Cable and Seed stitch pattern of 5-stitch Seed stitch sections alternated with 8-stitch Cable pattern sections.
- 2. If desired, markers can be placed to separate the Seed stitch and Cable pattern sections.
- Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of stitches. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working with straight needles.
- 4. Throw can be worked by following the written instructions or reading the chart. Read right side rows from right to left and wrong side rows from left to right.

Special Stitches

2/2 LC (2 over 2 Left Cross) = Slip next
2 stitches to cable needle and hold in
front, k2, then k2 from cable needle.
2/2 RC (2 over 2 Right Cross) = Slip
next 2 stitches to cable needle and hold
in back, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

THROW

Cast on 200 sts.

Row 1 (wrong side): K1, [p1, k1] twice for first Seed stitch section, *k2, p4, k2 for Cable pattern section; k1, [p1, k1] twice for Seed stitch section; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 2: K1, [p1, k1] twice, p2, 2/2 LC, p2, k1, [p1, k1] twice, *p2, 2/2 RC, p2; k1, [p1, k1] twice; p2, 2/2 LC, p2; k1, [p1, k1] twice; repeat from * to end of row. **Row 3:** K1, [p1, k1] twice, *k2, p4, k2; k1, [p1, k1] twice; repeat from * to end of row.



Row 4: K1, [p1, k1] twice, *p2, k4, p2; k1, [p1, k1] twice; repeat from * to end of row.

Rows 5 and 6: Repeat Rows 3 and 4. Repeat Rows 1-6 until piece measures about 54" [137 cm] from beginning, end with a Row 3 as the last row you work. With right side facing, bind off as if to knit.


FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es).

Key
knit on right side, purl on wrong side
purl on right side, knit on wrong side
2/2 LC (2 over 2 left cross)
2/2 RC (2 over 2 right cross)
