What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver Stripes®: 1 skein 4961 Preppy Stripe

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 14½ sts = 4" [10 cm]; 18 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette stitch. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

BUY YARN



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yds (333 m); prints, multis, stripes and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yds (215 m); flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Fantastic Ripple Scarf

This pretty scarf is a great project to sharpen your lace knitting skills. We love it in the striping colorways, but it would look great in a solid color too!

Scarf measures 7" [18 cm] wide x 76" [193 cm] long

LACE PATTERN

Row 1 (RS): Knit.
Row 2: K2, p18, k2.
Row 3: K2, [K2tog] 3 times, [yo, k1] 6 times, [k2tog] 3 times, k2.
Row 4: Repeat Row 2.
Repeat Rows 1-4 for pattern.

SCARF

Cast on 22 sts.
Knit 4 rows, ending with a WS row.
Begin Lace Pattern and work until piece measures 70" [178 cm] from cast on edge, when slightly stretched.
Work Lace Pattern Rows 1-3, once.
Knit 4 rows.
Bind off all stitches.

FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends. Block to dimensions using gentle steam to permanently set stitches.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeters; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit next 2 stitches together; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over needle; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.



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
