What you will need:

RED HEART* Super Saver Stripes*: 1 skein 4961 Preppy Stripe

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 14½ sts = 4" [10 cm]; 18 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Fantastic Ripple Scarf

This pretty scarf is a great project to sharpen your lace knitting skills. We love it in the striping colorways, but it would look great in a solid color too!

Scarf measures 7" [18 cm] wide x 76" [193 cm] long

LACE PATTERN

Row 1 (RS): Knit. Row 2: K2, p18, k2.

Row 3: K2, [K2tog] 3 times, [yo, k1] 6

times,

[k2tog] 3 times, k2. **Row 4:** Repeat Row 2. Repeat Rows 1-4 for pattern.

SCARF

Cast on 22 sts.

Knit 4 rows, ending with a WS row. Begin Lace Pattern and work until piece measures 70" [178 cm] from cast on edge,

when slightly stretched. Work Lace Pattern Rows 1-3, once. Knit 4 rows. Bind off all stitches.

FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends. Block to dimensions using gentle steam to permanently set stitches.

cm = centimeters; k = knit; k2tog =
knit next 2 stitches together; mm =
millimeters; p = purl; st(s) = stitch(es);
yo = yarn over needle; [] = work
directions in brackets the number of
times specified.
