What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\text {® }}$ : 1 skein each 722 Pretty ' $n$ Pink A and 528 Medium Purple B

Susan Bates ${ }^{\bullet}$ Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm [US I-9].

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 8 pattern repeats $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ (one pattern repeat consists of one double crochet and one chain space); 10 rows = 6" ( 15 cm ). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge

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## RED HEART

Super Saver ${ }^{\text {® }}$, Art E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd ( 333 m ); prints, multis and heathers 5 oz ( 141 g ), 236 yd (215 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds ( 238 m ) skeins


## Flower Wristers

Easy crochet wristers were designed as a quick finishing touch to our haunting sugar skull costume (see photo at end of pattern).

Mitt is a simple mesh with flowers that coordinate with the headpieces.

For related patterns see photo at end of pattern.

Mitt measures: $8^{\prime \prime}$ circumference x 6½" long ( $20.5 \times 16.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## MITT (make 2)

Leaving a long tail for sewing, with B, ch 34.

Row 1: Dc in 6th ch from hook
(beginning ch count as skipped ch, first dc, ch 1), *ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch; repeat from * across, turn-16 dc and 15 ch-1 spaces.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in first ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space; repeat from * across to last dc, ch 1, skip last dc, dc in beginning ch-5 space, dc in 4th ch of beginning ch, turn-17 dc and $14 \mathrm{ch}-1$ spaces.
Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1 here and throughout), skip next dc, dc in first ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space; repeat from * across, ending last repeat in top of beginning ch-5, turn-16 dc and 15 ch- 1 spaces.
Row 4: Ch 3, dc in first ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space; repeat from * across to last dc, ch 1, skip last dc, dc in beginning ch-4 space, dc in 3 rd ch of beginning ch, turn-17 dc and $14 \mathrm{ch}-1$ spaces.
Rows 5-10: Repeat last 2 rows 3 times. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing

## FINISHING MITT

Fold mitt in half lengthwise. With beginning tail, sew edges together from bottom up until $3^{\prime \prime}(7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) remain, secure tail; with ending tail, sew sides together from top down 1" ( 2.5 cm ) leaving 2" ( 5 cm ) opening for thumb, secure tail.


## FLOWER (make 2)

With B, ch 4; join with slip st to form a ring.
Round 1 (right side): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), 9 hdc in ring; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-10 hdc.
Round 2: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), working in front loops only, dc in same st as join, 2 dc in next st, *(ch 2, slip st, ch 2, dc) in next st, 2 dc in next st; repeat from $* 3$ times, ch 2 ; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-12 dc, 4 slip sts, 9 ch-2 spaces.
Round 3: Working in back loops only, slip st in same st as join, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in same st, 2 hdc in each st and ch around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-68 hdc.
continued...


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Round 4: Ch 2, working in front loops only, dc in same st as join, 2 dc in next st, *(ch 2, slip st, ch 2, dc) in next st, 2 dc in next st; repeat from * around, ch 2 ; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## FINISHING

Sew flower to back of each mitt. Weave in ends.

$\mathbf{A}, \mathbf{B}=$ Color A, Color $\mathrm{B} ; \mathbf{c h}=$ chain(s); $\mathbf{d c}=$ double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); ( ) = work directions in parentheses into same st; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
