What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein 706 Perfect Pink A

RED HEART® Boutique Sashay Fringe™: 1 ball 1969 Flirty B

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6.5mm [US K-10½]

Yarn needle, sewing needle, matching sewing thread

GAUGE: 3 shells and 3 sc in pattern = 5.5" (14 cm); 8 rows alternating shells and spaces in pattern = 3.75" (9.5 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Fringed V-Stitch Shawl

We've used Sashay Fringe to edge this bright, cozy shawl. The pretty openwork pattern is a combination of V-stitches and shells that drapes perfectly with a free spirited Boho outfit.

Shawl (before Fringe) measures 44" (112 cm) wide x 21.5" (54.5 cm) long

Special Stitches

beg V-st = beginning V-stitch: ch 5 (counts as dc, ch-2), dc in indicated stitch or space.

V-st = V-stitch: (dc, ch 2, dc) in indicated stitch or space.

shell: 5 dc in indicated stitch or space.

Note: (Ch-2, slip st) at the beginning of a row does not count as a separate stitch.

SHAWL

With **A**, ch 4.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Skip 3 ch (counts as dc), 2 dc in 4th ch from hook; turn—3 dc.

Row 2 (Right Side): Beg V-st in first dc, ch 1, V-st in top of ch-3; turn—2 V-sts, 1 ch-1 space.

Row 3: Ch 2, slip st in first V-st, beg V-st in same V-st, ch 1, V-st in next ch-1 space, ch 1, V-st in last V-st; turn—3 V-sts, 2 ch-1 spaces.

Row 4: Ch 2, slip st in first V-st, beg V-st in same V-st, ch 3, sc in next ch-1 space, shell in next ch-2 space, sc in next ch-1 space, ch 3, V-st in last V-st; turn—2 V-sts, 2 ch-3 spaces, 2 sc, 1 shell.

Row 5: Ch 2, slip st in first V-st, beg V-st in same V-st, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, sc in 2nd dc of shell, ch 3, sc in 4th dc of shell, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, V-st in last V-st; turn—2 V-sts, 5 ch-3 spaces, 4 sc.

Row 6: Ch 2, slip st in first V-st, beg V-st in same V-st, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, shell in next ch-3 space, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, V-st in last V-st; turn—2 V-sts, 2 ch-3 spaces, 3 sc, 2 shells.

Row 7: Ch 2, slip st in first V-st, beg V-st in same V-st, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, *ch 3, sc in 2nd dc of shell, ch 3, sc in 4th dc of shell; repeat from * in remaining shells across, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, V-st in last V-st; turn—2 V-sts, 7 ch-3 spaces, 6 sc.

Row 8: Ch 2, slip st in first V-st, beg V-st in same V-st, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, *shell in next ch-3 space, sc in next ch-3 space; repeat from * in remaining ch-3 spaces across, ch 3, V-st in last V-st; turn—2 V-sts, 2 ch-3 spaces, 4 sc, 3 shells.

Rows 9-44: Repeat Rows 7 and 8 (18 times)—2 V-sts, 2 ch-3 spaces, 22 sc, 21 shells.

Row 45: Repeat Row 7—2 V-sts, 45 ch-3 spaces, 44 sc.

Row 46: Ch 2, slip st in first V-st, *ch 3, [yarn over, insert hook in same space, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook] twice, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook, ** slip st in next ch-3 space; repeat from * across to last ch-3 space, then from * to ** once; slip st in last V-st—46 groups of sts. Fasten off.

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FRINGE

Note: Open up the Sashay Fringe **B** to smooth it out, and work into the top edge without the fringe. Start 4" (10 cm) from the end, and work into every other loop on the top edge.

Hold **B** and Wrap with Right sides together. Starting at corner of Wrap, Insert hook under outside leg of V-st and through first loop of **B**, draw loop up of **B** to join; working evenly along first side of Wrap, *insert hook under next V-st on Wrap and pull up another loop of **B** and make a slip st; repeat from * across to bottom point of Wrap; in same manner, work into space under side of ch-3; rotate Wrap, work into space under side of dc; continue working evenly along second side of Wrap from * across to other corner of Wrap. Do not fasten off.

FINISHING

Trim **B**, leaving a 4" (10 cm) end, and use sewing needle and thread to sew the last loop of **B** to the Wrap to secure it. Fold under the end of **B** and tack it to the Wrong side to finish the end; repeat for other end. Weave in all yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B = Color A, Color B; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work all directions in parentheses in the indicated stitch or space; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.



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
