What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\text {® }}$ : 2 skeins 319 Cherry Red A, and 1 skein each 368 Paddy Green B and 316 Soft White $\mathbf{C}$

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook 5 mm [US H-8]
$12 \times 16^{\prime \prime}(30.5 \times 40.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and $18 \times 18^{\prime \prime}(46 \times 46 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) pillow forms

Yarn needle

GAUGE: $13 \mathrm{dc}=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm}) ; 8$ dc rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Super Saver*, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd ( 333 m ); prints, multicolor and heather $5 \mathrm{oz}(141 \mathrm{~g}), 236$ yd ( 215 m ), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds ( 238 m ) skeins


## Gift Pillows

Add these pillows to your sofa and transform your living area into a comfortably festive place to relax with friends and family. These will work up quickly and then you tie them up with a crochet ribbon!

Directions are for smaller pillow, changes for larger pillow are in parentheses.

Pillows measure $12 \times 16$ " ( $30.5 \times 40.5$ cm) and $18 \times 18$ " ( $46 \times 46 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## NOTES

Pillows are worked in unjoined round with right side always facing.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

Fdc (foundation double crochet) $=\mathrm{Ch}$ 3 (counts as first fdc). Yarn over and pull up a loop in 3rd ch from hook, yarn over and draw through 1 loop creating a ch st, yarn over and draw though 2 loops, yarn over and draw through remaining 2 loops - second fdc completed, * yarn over and pull up a loop in ch at base of last fdc, yarn over and draw through 1 loop creating a ch st, yarn over and draw though 2 loops, yarn over and draw through remaining 2 loops; repeat from * to desired number of fdc.
Stacked dc (stacked double crochet) $=\mathrm{Sc}$ in indicated st, insert hook behind left-most vertical bar of sc just made and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook.

## PILLOW

Round 1 (right side): Fdc 39 (59), rotate work 180 degrees, dc in back loop of each foundation ch, do not join, do not turn - 78 (118) dc.
Next 31 (35) rounds: Stacked dc in first continued...

dc, dc in each dc around, do not join, do not turn.
Fasten off, leaving a tail at least 48 (54)" (122 (137) cm) long.

## RIBBON

With B, ch 279 (345).
Row 1 (right side): Stacked dc in first
ch, dc in each of next 2 ch, * ch 3 , sk 3 foundation ch, dc in each of next 3 foundation ch; repeat from * to end.
Fasten off.
With right side facing, join $\mathbf{C}$ with slip st in first dc,
Row 2: Sc in same dc and in each of
next 2 dc, * working around ch sts of Row 1 , dc in each of next 3 ch of foundation row, sc in each of next 3 dc ; repeat from * to end.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Insert pillow form and whip st top seam using yarn tail.

Tie Ribbon around pillow.
Weave in all loose ends.
ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C etc; $\mathbf{c h}=$ chain; $\mathbf{d c}=$ double crochet; $\mathbf{s c}=$ single cro-chet; st(s) = stitch(es); * or ** $=$ repeat whatever fol-lows the * or ${ }^{* *}$ as indicated.
