What you will need:

RED HEART* Super Saver*: 2 skeins 385 Royal A, 1 skein each 672 Spring Green B, 706 Perfect Pink C and 512 Turqua D

Susan Bates[®] Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10]

Crochet hook for attaching fringe, yarn needle

GAUGE: 15 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Double Garter stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

Girls' Fringed Scarf

Choose four colorful shades in her favorite colors and knit a triangle scarf. It will keep the chill off on crisp days or add an extra layer of warmth on winter coat days. The Double Garter pattern starts at the top and decreases down to the point. Trendy fringe gives it the ideal finish! Scarf measures 38" [96.5 cm] at widest point x 12" [30.5 cm] at longest point, not including fringe.

PATTERN STITCHES Double Garter Pattern

Row 1 (Right Side): Knit. Row 2: Knit. Rows 3-4: Purl. Repeat Rows 1-4 for Double Garter st.

Color Sequence

Working in Double Garter st, work 4 rows with **A**, 4 rows with **B**, 4 rows with **C** and 4 rows with **D**. Repeat last 16 rows for Color Sequence.

SCARF

With **A**, cast on 142 sts. Beginning with Row 1, work in Double Garter st for 2 rows.

Decrease Row 1 (Right Side): P2tog, purl to last 2 sts, p2tog - 140 sts. Purl 1 row.

Decrease Row 2: Keeping in Color Sequence, k2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 138 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Keeping in Double Garter st and color Sequence, repeat last 4 rows for 12 more times – 90 sts remain on last row worked.

Keeping in Double Garter st and Color Sequence, decrease 1 st at beginning and end of every row for 44 rows – 2 sts remain on last row worked. K2tog. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.



FRINGE

Cut 3 strands of yarn, each 8" [20.5 cm] long for each fringe. Hold 3 strands of yarn together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of piece, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make fringe in center of last row. Make an equal number of fringes spaced in between each purl ridge along both side edges. Trim fringe evenly.

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ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; cm = centimeters; k = knit; k2tog = knit 2 sts together; mm = millimeters; p = purl; p2tog = purl 2 sts together; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together.
