What you will need:

RED HEART° Super Saver°: 1 skein each 334 Buff A, 316 Soft White B, 360 Café Latte C, 312 Black D, 320 Cornmeal E, 885 Delft F, 706 Perfect Pink G, 313 Aran H, 381 Light Blue I, 672 Spring Green J, 324 Bright Yellow K

Note: Only small quantities of **D**, **H**, **I**, **J**, and **K** are needed for this project.

Susan Bates° **Crochet Hooks:** 4mm [US G-6] and 5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle, stitch marker, 16" (40.5 cm) square pillow form, red crayon (to shade cheeks), black embroidery floss (for facial features)

GAUGE: 10 sts = 3" (7.5 cm); 7 rows = 3" (7.5 cm) in alternating rows of double crochet and single crochet with larger hook. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Goldilocks and the Three Bears Pillow

Crochet this delightful accent pillow for a child who has enjoyed this classic tale. It captures the climactic moment when Goldilocks is sleeping restfully as the dismayed bear family wonders who is sleeping in the bed. Back of pillow features Baby Bear appliqué.

Pillow measures 16" x 16" (40.5 x 40.5 cm).

Special Stitches

sc2tog = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.
sc3tog = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

Special Technique

Join with sc = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

Notes

- 1. Pillow is made from 2 sides worked back and forth in rows with larger hook.
- 2. All other pieces are worked separately with smaller hook and sewn to sides of pillow. Fasten off all pieces with long tails for sewing.
- To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

PILLOW

Sides (make 2)

With larger hook and **A**, ch 50.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—49 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each dc across, turn.

Rows 4–17: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 seven times.

Row 18: Repeat Row 2; change to B.

Row 19: Repeat Row 3.

Rows 20–35: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 eight times.

Last round (right side): Ch 1, 3 sc in first st, sc in each remaining st across to last st, 3 sc in last st; working in ends of rows, sc evenly down first side; working across opposite side of foundation ch, 3 sc in first ch, sc in each ch across to last ch, 3 sc in last ch; working in ends of rows, sc evenly up other side; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

PAPA BEAR

Head

Beginning at top of head, with **C**, ch 4. **Row 1 (right side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch, sc in last ch, turn—4 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next 2 sc, sc in last sc, turn—6 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.
Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc, turn—8 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.
Row 6: Ch 1, 3 sc in first sc, sc in last 7 sc, turn—10 sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first 8 sc, sc2tog, turn—9 sc. **Row 8:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in last 7 sc, turn—8 sc.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog, sc in last sc, turn—6 sc.

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in first sc, [sc2tog] twice, sc in last sc—4 sc. Fasten off.

Arm (make 2)

Beginning at hand, with **C**, ch 2.

Row 1 (right side): Work 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn—3 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc, turn—4 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc2tog, sc in last sc; change to **E**, turn—3 sc.

Rows 4–9: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. **Row 10:** Ch 1, sc3tog—1 sc. Fasten off.

Continued...



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Foot (make 2)

Beginning at top of leg, with **C**, ch 4.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—3 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. sc in last 2 sc. turn—4 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sc. 2 sc in last sc. turn—5 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

Ear (make 2)

With C. ch 2.

Round 1 (right side): Work 6 hdc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first hdc—6 hdc. Fasten off.

Shirt

Beginning at neck edge, with **E**, ch 7.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—6 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc. 2 sc in next sc. sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc, turn—8 sc.

Rows 3-7: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

Pants

With **F**. ch 7.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch. sc in next 2 ch. 2 sc in next ch, sc in last ch, turn—8 sc.

Rows 2–4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. First leg

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc; leave remaining sts unworked, turn—4 sc.

Rows 6 and 7: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. turn.

Fasten off.

Second leg

Row 1: With right side of pants and first leg facing, join **F** with sc in first unworked st of Row 5, sc in remaining sts, turn—4 sc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

MAMA BEAR

Head

Work same as Papa Bear head.

Arm

With **C** throughout, work same as Papa Bear arm.

Foot (make 2)

Beginning at top of leg, with **C**, ch 4.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—3 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. sc in last 2 sc. turn-4 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sc. 2 sc in last sc. turn-5 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

Ear

Work same as Papa Bear ear.

Dress

Beginning at neck edge, with **G**, ch 7.

Rows 1–4: Work same as Rows 1–4 of Papa Bear pants—8 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in first 2 sc, sc in next 4 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc—12 sc. Fasten off.

Flower (make 2)

With G. ch 2.

Round 1 (right side): Slip st in 2nd ch from hook, [ch 1, slip st] 4 times in same ch, ch 1; join with slip st in first slip st. Fasten off.

BABY BEAR (front side)

Head

Rows 1-4: Work same as Rows 1-4 of Papa Bear head—8 sc.

Rows 5 and 6: Ch 1. sc in each sc across, turn. **Row 7:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog, sc in last sc, turn—6 sc.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first sc, [sc2tog] twice, sc in last sc—4 sc. Fasten off.

Arm

With C. ch 2.

Row 1 (right side): Work 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn—3 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in last sc, turn—2 sc.

Rows 4–6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc2tog—1 sc. Fasten off.

Foot (make 2)

Beginning at top of leg, with **C**, ch 3.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and next ch. turn—2 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in last sc, turn—3 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc. 2 sc in last sc—4 sc. Fasten off.

Ear (make 2)

With **C**. ch 2.

Round 1 (right side): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first sc—6 sc. Fasten off.

Sun Suit

Beginning at top of suit, with **E**, ch 6.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn—5 sc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 2 sc. turn—6 sc.

Rows 5 and 6: Ch 1. sc in each sc across, turn.

First leg

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sc; leave remaining sts unworked, turn—3 sc.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in last 2 sc—4 sc. Fasten off.

Second leg

Row 1: With right side of sun suit and first leg facing, join **E** with sc in first unworked st, sc in last 2 sc. turn—3 sc.

Rows 2 and 3: Repeat Rows 8 and 9 of first leg.

GOLDILOCKS

Head

Beginning at top of head, with **H**, ch 4.

Rows 1-3: Work same as Rows 1-3 of Papa Bear head—6 sc.

Rows 4 and 5: Ch 1. sc in each sc across, turn. **Row 6:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, [sc2tog] twice, sc in last sc. turn—4 sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, [sc2tog] twice—2 sc. Fasten off.

BED

Mattress

With I. ch 16.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—15 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

Head Post

With **F**. ch 2.

Round 1 (right side): Work 6 hdc in 2nd ch from hook, slip st in first hdc, turn. Continue in rows.

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first hdc, turn—2 sc. Rows 3-15: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

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Foot Post

Work same as Rows 1–12 of head post. Fasten off.

Blanket

With **J**, ch 13.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—12 sc.

Rows 2–11: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

BOAT PICTURE

Background

With E, ch 9.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn—8 sc.

Rows 2–8: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Round 9: Ch 1, working in each st, in ends of rows, and in opposite side of foundation ch, slip st evenly around; join with slip st in first slip st. Fasten off.

Frame

Round 1 (right side): With right side facing, join **F** with sc in back loop of any slip st, working in back loops only, sc in each slip st around working 3 sc in each corner st; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Large Sail

With **B**, ch 6.

Row 1 (right side): Slip st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in last 2 ch. Fasten off.

Small Sail

With B, ch 4.

Row 1 (right side): Slip st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in last ch. Fasten off.

BABY BEAR (back side)

Work all pieces same as Baby Bear for front side including 2 arms.

FINISHING

(See Stitch Illustrations on next page)

Use photograph as a guide for placement of embroidery stitches and pieces. Embroider and sew in place with right side of each piece facing.

Papa Bear

With **D**, embroider satin stitch nose and eyes and a lazy daisy stitch for the mouth.

Mama Bear

Embroider face same as Papa Bear. With **G**, embroider chain stitches along lower edges of feet. Embroider long straight stitches for a strap across each foot. Sew flower to top of each strap.

Baby Bear (front side)

With **D**, embroider satin stitch eyes, nose, and mouth. Stitch mouth in an inverted V-shape so bear appears to be frowning.

Goldilocks

With 3 strands of black embroidery floss held together, embroider couch stitch eyes and mouth. Embroider a French knot on each eye. Color cheeks with red crayon. Hair Beginning at side edge of head near cheek, with **K**, work a small stem stitch over the end of a row, working across ends of rows and in sts, work next stem stitch close to the first allowing a ½-¾" (1.5-2 cm) long loop to form; *holding the loop in place, work next stem stitch close to the last one made; repeat from * across as many times as needed to create curls. Fasten off. Fluff loops up.

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
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Boat Picture

Sew sails in place on picture. With J, embroider satin stitch boat under sails. With **D**, embroider stem stitches between sails for mast. With G. embroider satin stitches for flag.



Embroider eyes and nose same as Baby Bear on front side. Work mouth with satin stitches so bear appears to be smiling.

With right sides facing, arrange all pieces except flowers on front and back sides of pillow, layering as needed, and pin in place. Sew all pieces in place. Weave in ends.

Sides

Hold front and back sides with wrong sides together. With a long strand of B, sew through inner loops around 3 sides, insert pillow form, and sew through remaining stitches to close pillow sides. Weave in ends.


ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.







Lazy Daisy Stitch




Chain Stitches








French Knot









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
