What you will need:
RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 656 Real Teal A, 334 Buff B and 400 Grey Heather C

Susan Bates® Double pointed needles: one set each 4mm [US 6] and 5mm [US 8]

Yarn needle
Stitch marker
GAUGE: 16 sts $=4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}] ; 32$ rows $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in St st with larger needles. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

## Buy Yarn

## PATTERN STITCHES

Stripe Sequence 1
Rounds 1-3: A
Rounds 4-5: B
Round 6: C
Rounds 7-8: B

## Stripe Sequence 2

Rounds 1-3: B
Round 4-5: C

## Rounds 6-8: B

## COVERS

## Putter or Iron Cover

With smaller needles and using A , cast on 20 sts. Arrange stitches evenly around three double-pointed needles. Join, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round. Round 1: [K1, p1] around until piece measures 5 " $[12.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ from beginning. Increase Row: *K4, knit front and back of stitch; repeat from * to end of round - 24 sts. Next Row: Change to larger needles and working in St st, work Stripe Sequence 13 times.
Repeat Rounds 1-3 once AND AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures $31 / 4$ " [ 8.25 cm ] from beginning of St st, work decrease rounds as follows:
Round 1: *K2, k2tog; repeat from * to end of Round - 18 sts.
Round 2: Knit.
Round 3: *K1, k2tog; repeat from * to end of round -12 sts.
Round 4: Knit.
Round 5: *K2tog; repeat from * to end of round - 6 sts.
Round 6: Knit.

## FINISHING

Thread tail through remaining 6 stitches and pull to close. Knot to secure. With using A, B, and C make a pompom and attach to top.

## Weave in ends.

## Large Cover (will fit \#3 or \#5 club)

With smaller needles and using A , cast on 32 sts. Arrange stitches evenly around three double-pointed needles. Join, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.
Round 1: [K1, p1] around until piece measures $10 "[25 \mathrm{~cm}]$ from beginning.
Increase Row: *K3, knit front and back; repeat from * to end of round - 40 sts.
Next Row: Change to larger needles and work in St st for $11 / 2 "$ " 3.8 cm$]$. Work in Stripe Sequence 2 once. Work color A for 1 " $[2.54 \mathrm{~cm}]$ more then begin decrease rounds as follows:
Round 1: *K3, k2tog; repeat from * to end of Round - 32 sts.
Round 2: Knit.
Round 3: *K2, k2tog; repeat from * to end of round - 24 sts.
Round 4: Knit.
Round 5: *K1, k2tog; repeat from * to end of round - 16 sts.
Round 6 : Knit.
Round 7: *K2tog; repeat from * to end of round - 8 sts.
Round 8: Knit.

## FINISHING

Thread tail through remaining 8 stitches and pull to close. Knot to secure. Using A, B, and C make a pompom and attach to top. Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathrm{A}=$ Color $\mathrm{A} ; \mathrm{B}=$ Color B; C = Color C ; de = decrease(s)(d)(ing); inc = increase(s)(d)(ing); $\mathrm{K}=$ knit; $\mathrm{mm}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{P}=$ Purl; $\mathrm{st}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); St st = Stockinette stitch; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
