



What you will need:

RED HEART[®] Super Saver[®]: 1 skein 979 Mistletoe

Susan Bates® Double pointed needles: One set 4mm [US 6]

Susan Bates[®] Easy pompom maker, 1.75" (4.4 cm) diameter

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not important for this project.

Buy Yarn



available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); prints, multicolor and heather 5 oz (141 g), 236 yd (215 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Holiday Bottle Beanies

Turn a simple bottle of wine into a jolly holiday accent just by adding a cute knit hat! It's the perfect idea for when you give holiday spirits!

Bottle Beanies measure 3" (7.5 cm) around brim and 6" (15 cm) in length.

Notes

- 1. Bottle Beanie is worked from the top down, beginning with an I-cord, then increasing and working in the round on double pointed needles towards the brim.
- 2. 1 skein of yarn is enough to make several Bottle Beanies.

Special Technique

I-cord = Cast on 3 sts. * k3. do not turn work, slip all sts back to left needle; repeat from * until I-cord measures indicated length.

Special Abbreviations

M1 = Make 1 (Increase) – Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and work strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole, and knitting it.

BOTTLE Beanies

Work I-cord for 1½" (4 cm). **Begin Increases**

needle.

Continue to work as for I-cord, sliding sts back onto left needle after each round. while working increases as follows: **Round 1:** K1, M1, k2 – 4 sts. Rounds 2 & 3: Knit. Round 4: K1, M1, k3 – 5 sts. Rounds 5 & 6: Knit. Round 7: K1. M1. k4 – 6 sts. Divide sts onto 3 double pointed needles, placing 2 sts on each needle. Rounds 8 and 9: Knit. Round 10: [K1, M1, k1] 3 times (once on each of 3 needles) - 9 sts, 3 sts on each

Rounds 11 and 12: Knit. Round 13: [K1, M1, K2] 3 times - 12 sts, 4 sts on each needle.

Rounds 14 and 15: Knit. Round 16: [K1, M1, K3] 3 times - 15 sts, 5 sts on each needle.

Rounds 17 and 18: Knit.

Round 19: [K1, M1, K4] 3 times – 18 sts, 6 sts on each needle. Knit evenly until Bottle Beanie measures 5" (12.5 cm) in length.

Brim

Next round: * K1, p1; repeat from * around. Repeat the last round until hat measure 6" (15 cm) in length. Bind off.

FINISHING

Make a pompom and sew to top of hat. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[**] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
