



Honeycomb Throw

WR2078



Throw is 34" x 41".

RED HEART® "Super Saver®": 2 skeins each 316 Soft White **A**, 661 Frosty Green **B**, 406 Medium Thyme **C** and 320 Cornmeal **D**.

Circular Knitting Needles: 6 mm [US 10] 29".
Yarn needle, stitch markers.

GAUGE: 14 sts = 4" in Stockinette stitch. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

NOTES:

Throw is worked back and forth in rows. Circular needles are used to accommodate large number of sts.

Wind separate balls or bobbins for each side border.

HONEYCOMB PATTERN (multiple of 8 sts + 4)

Rows 1 (Right Side) and 2: With **A**, knit.

Row 3: With **B**, k1, slip 2, * k6, slip 2; repeat from * across to last st k1.

Row 4: P1, slip 2, * p6, slip 2; repeat from * across, to last st, p1.

Rows 5-8: Repeat Rows 3 and 4, two times.

Rows 9 and 10: With **A**, knit.

Row 11: With **D**, k5, slip 2, * k6, slip 2; repeat from * across to last 5 sts, k5.

Row 12: P5, slip 2, * p6, slip 2, repeat from * across to last 5 sts, p5.

Row 13-16: Repeat Rows 11 and 12, two times.

Rows 17 and 18: With **A**, knit.

Row 19-24: With **C**, repeat Rows 3-8.

Rows 25-26: With **A**, knit.

Rows 27-32: Repeat Rows 11-16.

Repeat Rows 1-32 for Honeycomb Pattern.

THROW

With **A** cast on 142 sts.

Lower Border

Work in Garter st (k every row) for 7 rows.

Set up pattern

Next Row (Right Side): Join separate ball of **A**, work 5 sts in Garter st, place marker, work Row 1 of Honeycomb Pattern over next 132 sts, place marker, join second ball of **A** and work last 5 sts in Garter st. Keeping sts at each end as established for side borders, repeat Honeycomb Pattern 8 times (256 rows). With **B** work Rows 1 – 8 once more. With **A**, work in Garter st for 7 rows to complete border. Bind off. Weave in yarn ends.

Art. E300 available in Solid 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); Multi, Fleck and Print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m) skeins.
