## What you will need:

**RED HEART**<sup>®</sup> Super Saver<sup>®</sup>: 1 skein each of 256 Carrot A. 324 Bright Yellow B. and 334 Buff C Note: Only a small amount of each yarn color is needed.

Susan Bates<sup>®</sup> Crochet Hook: 3.75 mm [US F-5]

Polyester fiberfill, 18" [45.5 cm1 thin gold ribbon (for hanger), stitch marker, yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 20 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 20 rows/rounds = 4" [10 cm] in single crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

### **BUY YARN**

# Hot Dog Ornament

Hot dog lovers will appreciate having their favorite food to enhance the tree! Crochet it for those who prefer hot dogs at a picnic or ballpark to a formal meal.

Ornament measures about 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" [11 cm] long.

#### Notes

- 1. Hot dog is made from 4 pieces: Hot Dog, Mustard, and 2 Buns.
- 2. All pieces are sewn together to complete the ornament.
- 3. Gauge is not critical for this project. Work tightly so stuffing will not show between stitches.
- 4. Use photograph as a guide for placement of pieces to be sewn together.

# **Special Stitch**

sc2tog (single crochet 2 stitches together) = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

# **HOT DOG**

#### With A. ch 2.

Round 1 (right side): Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook–5 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed. Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around-10 sc.

SC.

Rounds 3-19: Sc in each sc around. adding stuffing as you go. Round 20: [Sc2tog] 5 times-5 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Finish stuffing Hot Dog. Thread tail through stitches of last round and pull to close opening at end of Hot Dog.

# **MUSTARD**

With **B**. ch 30. Fasten off, leaving a very long tail. With yarn tail sew Mustard in a squiggle along one side of Hot Dog.



BUN (make 2) With **C**. ch 2. Top Row 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook-5 sc. Row 2: Ch 1. turn. 2 sc in each sc across-10 sc.

Rows 3-18: Ch 1. turn. sc in each sc across.

Row 19: Ch 1, turn, [sc2tog] 5 times-5 SC.

Row 20: [Insert hook in next sc and draw up a loop] 5 times (6 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through all loops on hook. Pull tightly.

#### **Sides and Underside**

Round 1 (right side): Ch 1, work 42 sc evenly spaced all the way around outer edge of top of bun. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed. Round 2: Working in back loops only, [sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog] 6 times—36 sc. Round 3: Working in both loops, [sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog] 6 times—30 sc. Round 4: [Sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog] 6 times—24 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Stuff piece very lightly. Sew lengthwise seam. Sew one long edge of the two pieces of Bun together, sewing through the unused loops of Round 1.

### **FINISHING**

Place Hot Dog into Bun with Mustard facing outwards. With **C**, sew Bun to Hot Dog, trying not to indent Buns.

Fold gold ribbon in half. Insert crochet hook around a few stitches at top of ornament, place ribbon fold on hook and draw through to form a loop. Thread ends of ribbon through loop and pull to tighten. Tie ends together with bow or overhand knot to form hanging loop.

Weave in any remaining ends.

A, B, and C = Color A, B, and C; ch = chain; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
