



What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 (1, 1) skein 358 Lavender

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [I-9 US]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4" (10 cm) in double crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); prints, multis and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yd (215 m), flecks 5 oz (141g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Just Like Mom Cowl

Your little one will be so pleased to be dressed like you with this easy cowl pattern. Three sizes are given, so you can crochet one for any age.

Directions are for size Toddler. Changes for sizes Girl and Woman are in parentheses.

Cowl measures 5 (5, 5)" [12.5 (12.5, 12.5) cm] wide x 22 (24, 26)" [56 (61, 66) cm] circumference.

Special Stitch

bobble = Yo, insert hook in indicated st, yo, draw up a loop, yo and pull through two loops on hook, [yo, insert hook in same st, yo, draw up a loop, yo and pull through two loops on hook] 5 times (7 loops on hook), yo and pull through all 7 loops on hook.

Notes

- 1. Cowl is worked in joined rounds with right side facing throughout.
- 2. Work stitches into the top, not the first "leg", of the bobble.

COWL

Ch 66 (72, 78); being careful not to twist, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring. **Round 1:** Ch 1, sc in each ch; join with slip st in first sc—66 (72, 78) sts.

Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in each st; join with slip st in first sc.

Round 4: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), bobble in first st, *ch 1, skip next st, bobble in next st; repeat from * around, ch 1; join with slip st in first bobble – 33 (36, 39) bobbles and 33 (36, 39) ch-1 sps.

Round 5: Ch 1, sc in each st and ch-1 space; join with slip st in first sc—66 (72, 78) sts.

Rounds 6–9: Repeat Rounds 2–5.

Rounds 10 and 11: Repeat Rounds 2 and 3. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; sp(s) = space(s); st(s) = stitch(es);
