What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:
1 skein 376 Burgundy

**Susan Bates® Straight Knitting
Needles:** 5.5mm [US 9].

Stitch markers, yarn needle, one
1½" (4cm) button (La Mode 1805).

GAUGE: 19 sts = 5" (13 cm); 20
rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette
stitch. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use
any size needles to obtain the
gauge.

7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m);
multicolor, heather and print 5 oz
(141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz
(141g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Knit Change Purse

*This easy beginner project is perfect for
coins, stitch markers, or any little treasures.
Knit it for gifts or to organize your life in any of
the many colors of Super Saver.*

Purse measures 5" x 4" (13 x 10cm)

Special Stitches

Stockinette Stitch:

Row 1 (right side): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for pattern.

Yarn Over Twice:

With yarn at back of work, bring yarn over top
of right needle and back between needles,
then over top of right needle and back
again—2 sts increased.

Knit 2 Together:

Knit 2 sts together as one – 1 st decreased.

PURSE

Cast on 19 sts. Knit 2 rows. Work in
stockinette stitch until piece measures 8"
(20 cm) from beginning, ending with a right
side row. Place a marker at each end of the
last row worked.

Flap

Work in stockinette stitch for 1½" (4 cm)
more, ending with a right side row.

Next row (wrong side): Knit.

Next (buttonhole) row: K7, knit 2 together, yarn
over twice, knit 2 together, k8—19 stitches.

Next row: Knit to yarn overs, knit first yarn
over through the front loop and second yarn
over through the back loop, knit to end of
row—19 stitches.

Next row: Knit.

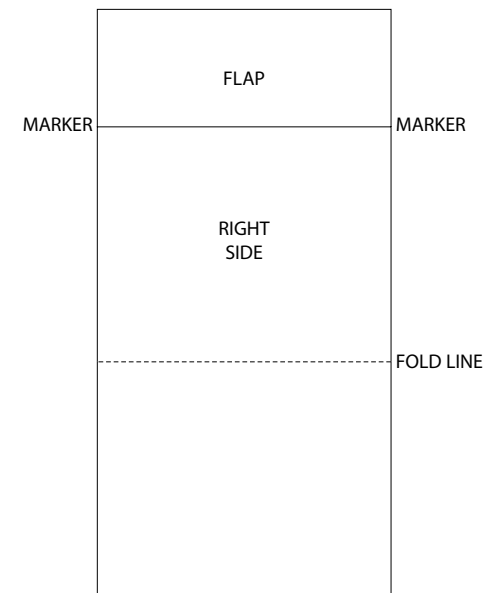
Bind off knitwise.

FINISHING

Fold piece with right sides together and cast
on edge even with markers. Sew sides up to
markers, leaving flap free. Turn to right side.
Sew button opposite buttonhole. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work
directions in brackets the number of times
specified; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as
indicated.
