What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\text { }}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\text {: }} 1$ skein 4334 Buff Fleck

Susan Bates ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Crochet Hook: 5 mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: $14 \mathrm{sc}=4$ " (10 cm); 16 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain gauge.

## Men's Vintage Golf Hat

Perfect for the golf course or for a drive in his convertible, this hat will please men with a sense of style. It won't take long to crochet in Super Saver and you have a choice of over 140 colors!

## Directions are for size Small. Changes

 for size Large are in parentheses.
## Hat stretches to fit 22" (24") [56 (61)

 cm] head circumference.
## Notes

When instructed to work into a stitch "2 rows below", work into the row numbered 2 less than the current row For example, if you are working Row 4, a stitch "2 rows below" is in Row 4-2 = Row 2.

## Special Stitches

hdc2tog $=$ [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop] 2 times, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook.
fpdc (front post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook).
spike sc (spike single crochet) $=\mathrm{Sc}$ in indicated stitch 2 rows below.

## Special Technique

Adjustable-ring method = Wrap yarn into a ring, ensuring that the tail falls behind the working yarn. Grip ring and tail firmly between middle finger and thumb. Insert hook through center of ring, yarn over (with working yarn) and draw up a loop. Work stitches of first round in ring, working over both strands (the tail and the ring). After the first round of stitches is worked, pull gently, but firmly, on tail to tighten ring.

## HAT

Make an adjustable ring.
Round 1: Ch 1, 10 hdc in ring; join with slip st in first hdc-10 hdc. Pull gently on beginning tail to tighten ring.
Round 2: Ch 1, hdc in first st, fpdc around same st, [hdc in next st, fpdc around same st] around; join with slip st in first hdc-10 hdc and 10 fpdc.
Round 3: Ch 1, hdc in first 2 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 2 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-20 hdc and 10 fpdc.
Round 4: Ch 1, hdc in first 3 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 3 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-30 hdc and 10 fpdc.
Round 5: Ch 1, hdc in first 4 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 4 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-40 hdc and 10 fpdc.
Round 6: Ch 1, hdc in first 5 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 5 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-50 hdc and 10 fpdc.
Round 7: Ch 1, hdc in first 6 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 6 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-60 hdc and 10 fpdc.
Round 8: Ch 1, hdc in first 7 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 7 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-70 hdc and 10 fpdc.
continued...


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Round 9: Ch 1, hdc in first 8 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 8 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-80 hdc and 10 fpdc.
Round 10: Ch 1, hdc in first 9 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 9 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-90 hdc and 10 fpdc.
Round 11: Ch 1, hdc in first 10 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 10 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-100 hdc and 10 fpdc.
Round 12: Ch 1, hdc in first 11 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 11 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-110 hdc and 10 fpdc .

## Size Large only:

Round 13: Ch 1, hdc in first 12 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 12 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-120 hdc and 10 fpdc.
Round 14: Ch 1, hdc in first 13 sts, fpdc around last st worked, [hdc in next 13 sts, fpdc around last st worked] around; join with slip st in first hdc-130 hdc and 10 fpdc .

## All sizes:

Round 13 (15): Ch 1, [hdc2tog 6 (7) times, fpdc around next fpdc] around; join with slip st in first hdc-60 (70) hdc and 10 fpdc .
Round 14 (16): Ch 1, skip first st, hdc in next 5 (6) hdc, hdc in next fpdc, fpdc around same fpdc, [skip next st, hdc in next 5 (6) hdc, hdc in next fpdc, fpdc around same fpdc] around; join with slip st in first hdc.

Round 15 (17): Ch 1, hdc in first 6 (7) sts, fpdc around next fpdc, [hdc in next 6 (7) sts, fpdc around next fpdc] around; join with slip st in first hdc.

## Rounds 16 and 17 (18 and 19): Repeat

 Round 15 (17).Rounds 18-20 (20-22): Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc-70 (80) sc.

## Brim

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first 24 (26) sts; leave remaining sts unworked, turn-24 (26) sc.
Note: Work next row in Round 20 (22). Row 2: Ch 1, spike sc in first st, skip next st, spike sc in each st across to last 2 sts, skip next st, spike sc in last st, turn-22 (24) spike sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn22 (24) sc.
Rows 4-7: Repeat last 2 rows twice-18 (20) sc.

Row 8: Repeat Row 2-16 (18) sc. Fasten off, leaving a $24^{\prime \prime}(61 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail.

## FINISHING

Fold brim up to Round 13 (15), centering brim between fpdc. Working in ends of rows and each st across, sew brim to front of hat.
Weave in ends.

ch = chain(s); dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; $\mathbf{s c}=$ single crochet; $\boldsymbol{s t}(\mathbf{s})=\operatorname{stitch}(e s) ;$ [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
