What you will need:
RED HEART® Super Saver®: 3 skeins 360 Cafée Latte A RED HEART ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Boutique Treasure ${ }^{\text {m': }}$ 10 balls 1923 Tapestry B

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Circular Knitting Needles:
Throw: 6mm [US 10] 32"
( 81.3 cm ) long
Pillow: 6.5mm [US 10.5] 32"
( 81.3 cm ) long
Yarn needle, 16 " x 16 " ( $41 \mathrm{~cm} \times 41 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) pillow form

## Mitered Square Throw and Pillow

This gorgeous Boutique shaded yarn is combined with a solid shade of plain yarn that blend beautifully. This mitered knit design is the perfect choice for shaded yarn and will create a throw and pillow that you'll love living with!

## GAUGE

Throw: 14 sts $=4 "(10 \mathrm{~cm}) ; 26$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in Garter Stitch using $\mathbf{A}$ and 15 sts = $4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$; 22 rows $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in Mitered pattern using $\mathbf{B}$.
Pillow: 14 sts $=4 "(10 \mathrm{~cm}) ; 20$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10$ cm ) in Mitered pattern using B. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Throw measures: 45 " $(114 \mathrm{~cm}) \times 60$ " ( 152 cm )

## NOTE

Throw and Pillow are worked back and forth in rows on circular needles, do not join.

## TIPS \& HINTS

Join a new ball of yarn when there are approximately 6 " $(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ of yarn left from the old ball, also leaving a 6 " $(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail of yarn with the joined yarn. Weave these ends in neatly on the wrong side of the fabric in a zigzag pattern for a few inches, and then trim off excess.

## Special Stitches

K2tog/P2tog = Knit 2 stitches together/purl 2 stitches together. To knit/purl 2 stitches together, insert the right needle into two stitches at the same time and knit or purl. This will result in a decrease of one stitch. This decrease will slant to the right.
PSSO = Pass slipped stitch over.
SSK = Slip next 2 sts, one at a time, to right needle; insert point of left needle into the fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together from this position - dec made. SI $1=$ Slip 1. To slip one stitch, insert the right needle into the next stitch on the left needle as if you were knitting the stitch. Pull this stitch off the left needle. The stitch is now on the right needle and twisted.

## THROW

Square \#1
With A, cast on 79 sts.
Row 1 (Wrong Side): Knit across row. Row 2 (Right Side) Decrease: Knit 38, (slip1, k2tog, psso), knit 38 sts. Row 3: Knit across row. Row 4 Decrease: Knit 37, (slip1, k2tog, psso), knit 37 sts. Continue working in alternating knit row and established Decrease row pattern for 12 rows total.

Change to B. Row 13: Knit Decrease row.
Row 14: Purl across row.
Row 15: Knit Decrease row.
Row 16: Knit across row.
Repeat Rows 13-16 until 3 sts remain.
Next Row (Wrong Side): Slip1, p2tog, psso.
Bind off. Pull yarn through last st.
With RS facing and $\mathbf{A}$, pick up and knit 39 sts along the top of first square starting where you just bound off to top left corner. Then cast on 40 sts — 79 sts

Make Square \#2. Repeat picking up/casting on sts to make each square until you have 5 squares in a row complete. Panel \#1 is complete.

With yarn A, cast on 39 sts and pick up 40 sts along first square's right edge. Knit first row. Work mitered squares in same pattern as above. You will continue picking up stitches along the top of each square and the side of the first column until you have completed Panel \#2 of the Throw. You now have 2 columns of 5 squares. Continue in this fashion until you have 4 columns of 5 squares. Continued...

## BORDER

Using A, pick up 190 sts along right edge on longer side of Throw, knit 12 rows. Bind off and leave last stitch to use as first stitch to begin picking up sts along top edge. Along top edge pick up and knit 160 sts. Knit 12 rows. Pick up and knit 190 sts along left edge on longer side and 160 sts along bottom edge in same manner. Bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in ends.
Block piece very lightly.
Pillow measures: 16 " $\times 16$ " ( $41 \mathrm{~cm} \times 41 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## PILLOW

Make 2 (Front and Back)
With B, and circular needles, cast on 91 sts. Row 1 (Wrong Side): Knit across row. Row 2 (Right Side) Decrease: Knit 45 sts, (slip1, k2tog, psso) knit 45 sts.
Row 3: Knit across row.
Row 4: Knit 44 sts, (slip 1, k2tog, psso), knit 44 sts.
Rows 5-12: Continue working in alternating knit row and established Decrease row pattern. Row 13: Purl across row.
Row 14: Knit 39 sts, (slip 1, k2tog, psso), knit 39 sts.
Rows 15-21: Continue working in alternating purl row and established Decrease row pattern. Row 22: Knit 35, (slip1, k2tog, psso), knit 35 sts. Row 23: Knit across row.
Rows 24-32: Continue working in alternating knit row and established Decrease row pattern. Row 33: Purl across row.
Row 34: Knit 29, (slip1, k2tog, psso), knit 29 sts. Rows 35-41: Continue working in alternating purl row and established Decrease row pattern.

Row 42: Knit 25, (slip1, k2tog, psso), knit 25 sts.
Row 43: Knit across row.
Rows 44-52: Continue working in alternating knit row and established Decrease row pattern Row 53: Purl across row.
Row 54: Knit 19, (slip1, k2tog, psso), knit 19 sts.
Row 55: Purl across row.
Rows 56-61: Continue working in alternating purl row and established Decrease row pattern. Row 62: Knit 15, (slip1, k2tog, psso), knit 15 sts.
Row 63: Knit across row.
Rows 64-73: Continue working in alternating knit row and established Decrease row pattern Row 74: Purl across row.
Row 75: Knit 9, (slip1, k2tog, psso), knit 9 sts. Rows 76-82: Continue working in alternating purl row and established Decrease row pattern Row 83: Knit 5, (slip1, k2tog, psso), knit 5 sts. Row 84: Knit across row.
Rows 85-92: Continue working in alternating knit row and established Decrease row pattern Row 93: 3 sts remain. (slip1, k2tog, psso), pull yarn thru last loop and tie off.

## FINISHING

Block front and back pillow pieces lightly to remove wrinkles and flatten curling edges. With right sides facing, place front and back pieces together. Using yarn needle, stitch seams together on three sides. Turn piece right side out and insert poly pillow form. Stitch the fourth side seam closed. Weave in all ends.

$\mathrm{A}=$ Color $\mathrm{A} ; \mathrm{B}=$ Color $\mathrm{B} ; \mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{k 2 t o g}=$ knit 2 sts. together; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{p}=$ purl; RS = right side; sl = slip; sl st = slip stitch; st (s) = stitch(es); St st = Stockinette stitch; tog = together; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated; yo = yarn over; WS = wrong side.
