What you will need:

## Size Child

RED HEART ${ }^{\star}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\star}$ : 1 skein 4971 Retro Stripe B

## Size Woman

RED HEART ${ }^{\star}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\text {® }}$ : 1 skein each 3862 Jade A and 625 Guava C

Size Man
RED HEART ${ }^{\star}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\circledR}$ : 1 skein 3862 Jade A

Susan Bates ${ }^{\star}$ Double Pointed Knitting Needles: 3.5 mm [US $4]$ and 3.75 mm [US 5]

Yarn needle, 3 stitch markers, small stitch holder

GAUGE: 18 sts = 4" (10 $\mathrm{cm}) ; 28$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in Stockinette st on large GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

## BUY YARN

RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\text {® }}$, Art E300 available in solid color 7 Oz (198 g) 364 solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 multis and he sthers, prints, g) 236 yds $(215 \mathrm{~m}$ ). flecks 5 oz ( 141 g ), $260 \mathrm{yds}(238 \mathrm{~m}$ ) skeins

Directions are for size Child. Changes for sizes Woman and Man are in parentheses.

Hand circumference: 5½ (71/4, 9½)" [14 (19.5, 24) cm] Finished length: 6 (10 $1 / 2$, 12)" [15 (26.5, 30.5) cm]

## Notes

1. Mittens can be worn on either hand
2. Sizes Child and Man are worked with 1 yarn with no color changes; size Woman is worked with 2 colors in a stripe pattern. Refer to Color Sequences for each size.
3. To make a matching pair of size Child mittens, begin $B$ at same color in each section.

## Special Abbreviation

M1 = Make 1 (Increase) - Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and knit strand through the back loop twisting it to prevent a hole.

## Color Sequences

Size Child: Work all rounds with B
Size Woman: Work all rounds of Cuff with A; stripe sequence: *3 rounds with $\mathbf{C}, 2$ rounds with $\mathbf{A}$; repeat from * for Lower Hand, Thumb Gusset, Upper Hand, and Thumb; work Mitton Top with A.

Size Man: Work all rounds with A.

## MITTEN (make 2)

## Cuff Ribbing

With smaller needles and $\mathbf{B}(\mathbf{A}, \mathbf{A})$, cast on $24(36,44)$ sts. Divide evenly among 3 dpns, place marker for beginning of round; join, taking care not to twist sts. Round 1: *K2, p2; repeat from *
around-24 $(36,44)$ sts.
Repeat Round 1 for $11 / 4(3,31 / 2$ )" [4.5 (7.5, 9) cm$]$.

## Lower Hand

Change to larger needles, begin St st, and k $1(1,0)$ round even.
Size Woman only:
Join C and begin stripe sequence

## All sizes:

Work even until piece measures $21 / 4$ ( $41 / 2$, 5)" $[5.5(11.5,12.5) \mathrm{cm}]$ from beginning.

## Thumb Gusset

Round 1: K11 (17, 21), place marker, k1, M1,
k1, place marker, $k$ to end-25 $(37,45)$ sts.
Round 2 and all even rounds: Knit even
Round 3: K11 (17, 21), M1, k3, M1, k to end-27 $(39,47)$ sts.
Round 5: K11 (17, 21), M1, k5, M1, k to end-29 (41, 49) sts
Round 7: K11 (17, 21), M1, k7, M1, k to end-31 $(43,51)$ sts.
Sizes Woman and Man only:
Round 9: K17 (21), M1, k9, M1, k to end45 (53) sts.
Round 11: K17 (21), M1, k11, M1, k to end47 (55) sts.
Round 13: K17 (21), M1, k13, M1, k to
end-49 (57) sts.
Size Man only:
Round 15: K21, M1, k15, M1, k to end-59 sts

## Upper Hand <br> All sizes:

Next Round: K11 (17, 21), place next 9 (15, 17) sts on holder for thumb, cast on 2 (1, $0)$ sts, $k$ to end-24 $(35,42)$ sts. Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 5 (9, 10½)" [12.5 (23, $26.5) \mathrm{cm}$ ] from beginning.

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## Size Woman only:

End with round 3 of $\mathbf{C}$ and continue in A only.

## Shape Mitten Top <br> All sizes:

Round 1 and all odd rounds: Knit even.
Round 2: *K4 (5, 5), k2tog; repeat from *
around-20 $(30,36)$ sts.
Round 4: *K3 (4, 4), k2tog; repeat from *
around-16 $(25,30)$ sts.
Round 6: *K2 (3, 3), k2tog; repeat from * around-12 $(20,24)$ sts.
Size Child only:
Round 7: *K1, k2tog; repeat from *
around-8 sts.
Round 8: *K2tog; repeat from * around-4 sts.
Sizes Woman and Man only:
Round 8: *K2, k2tog; repeat from *
around-15 (18) sts.
Round 10: *K1, k2tog; repeat from *
around-10 (12) sts.
Round 12: *K2tog; repeat from * around-5 (6) sts.

## All sizes:

Cut yarn, leaving a $6^{\prime \prime}(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail.
Thread through remaining sts, pull tightly to secure and fasten off.

## Thumb

Divide $9(15,17)$ sts from holder onto 3 dpns. Continue in pattern as established and work 1 round even, picking up 1 st between hand and thumb at end of row-10 $(16,18)$ sts. Work even until thumb measures $3 / 4(11 / 2,13 / 4)$ " $[2(4,4.5)$ $\mathrm{cm}]$.

## Size Child only:

Round 1: K1, k2tog, k2, k2tog, k1,
k2tog-7 sts.
Round 2: Knit even.
Round 3: K2tog, k1, [k2tog] twice-4 sts.

## Size Woman only:

Round 1: *K2, k2tog; repeat from *
around-12 sts.
Round 2: Knit even.
Round 3: *K1, k2tog; repeat from *
around-8 sts.
Round 4: Knit even
Round 5: *K2tog; repeat from *
around-4 sts.

## Size Man only:

Round 1: [K2, k2tog, k1, k2tog] twice, k2
k2tog-13 sts.
Round 2: Knit even.
Round 3: [K1, k2tog, k2tog] twice, k1, k2tog-8 sts.
Round 4: Knit even.
Round 5: *K2tog; repeat from *
around-4 sts.
All sizes:
Cut yarn leaving a 6" $(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail. Thread
through remaining sts, pull tightly to
secure and fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc; $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; k2tog $=$ knit next 2 sts together; mm = millimeters; $\mathbf{p}=$ purl; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
