What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein 3901 Rouge

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.0mm [US H-8] for size Medium or 6.0mm [US J-10] for size Large

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Rounds 1-3 = 4" [10 cm] with smaller size hook. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles/hook to obtain the gauge given.

7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 236 yd (215 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Ridged Crochet Hat

Choose a favorite shade of this ever-popular, easycare yarn and crochet a hat that is perfect for all ages and genders. Vertical ribs are interesting to crochet and give the hat a nice texture. Hat directions are written for size Medium (Child's) with changes for size Large (Women's) in parentheses.

Finished Hat Size: 20" (22") [51 (56) cm] in circumference

Special Stitches

Fpdc = Front post double crochet. Yarn over, insert hook from the front side of the work to back and to front again around the post of the indicated stitch on a previous row; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through two loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through two loops (1 loop on hook). **Bpdc** = Back post double crochet. Yarn over, insert hook from the back side of the work to front and to back again around the post of the indicated stitch on a previous row; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through two loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through two loops (1 loop on hook).

Notes

The ch-2 worked at the beginning of a Round does not count as a stitch. Do not turn at the end of each Round.

HAT

Ch 3, slip st in first ch to make a ring. **Round 1 (Right side):** Ch 2, work 12 dc in ring; slip st in first dc to join—12 dc. **Round 2:** Ch 2, 2 dc in each dc around; slip st in first dc to join—24 dc.

Round 3: Ch 2, Fpdc around first 2 dc, *2 dc in each of next 2 dc, Fpdc around next 2 dc; repeat from * around, end with 2 dc in each of last 2 dc, slip st in first Fpdc to join—12 Fpdc, 24 dc.

Round 4: Ch 2, *Fpdc around next 2 Fpdc, dc in next 4 dc; repeat from * around, slip st in first Fpdc to join—12 Fpdc, 24 dc.

Round 5: Ch 2, *Fpdc around next 2 Fpdc, 2 dc in each of next 4 dc; repeat from * around, slip st in first Fpdc to join—12 Fpdc, 48 dc.

Round 6: Ch 2, *Fpdc around next 2 Fpdc, dc in next 3 dc, Fpdc around next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc; repeat from * around, slip st in first Fpdc to join—24 Fpdc, 36 dc.

Rounds 7-13: Ch 2, *Fpdc around next 2 Fpdc, dc in next 3 dc; repeat from * around, slip st in first Fpdc to join—24 Fpdc, 36 dc.

Round 14: Ch 2, *Fpdc around next 2 Fpdc, Bpdc around next dc, Fpdc around next dc, Bpdc around next dc; repeat from * around, slip st in first Fpdc to join—36 Fpdc, 24 Bpdc.

Rounds 15-17: Ch 2, *Fpdc around next 2 Fpdc, Bpdc around next Bpdc, Fpdc around next Fpdc, Bpdc around next Bpdc; repeat from * around, slip st in first Fpdc to join.

At end of Round 17, fasten off and weave in ends.

ch - chain; cm - centimeters; dc - double
crochet; mm - millimeters; st(s) - stitch(es); *
or ** - repeat whatever follows the * or ** as
indicated.
