

## Sea Creatures Throw

## WR2051



Designed by Carol J. Sorsdahl.
Throw measures 32" x 32".
RED HEART® "Super Saver®": 1 skein each: 672 Spring Green A, 319 Cherry Red B, 347 Light Periwinkle C, 324 Bright Yellow D, 254 Pumpkin E, 530 Orchid F, and 311 White G.

Knitting needles: 5 mm [US 8].
Double pointed needles: 4mm [US 6].
Crochet hook: 3.75 mm [US F].
Yarn needle, Polyfill stuffing, black floss or yarn for embroidery.

GAUGE: 18 Sts=4", 36 Rows = 4" in garter stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain given gauge.

## Special Abbreviations

Inc (increase) = Knit in front and back loops of the same st. M1 (make one stitch) = Lift running thread before next stitch onto left needle and knit into the back loop.
ssk (slip, slip, knit) $=$ Slip next 2 sts knitwise, one at a time, to right needle; insert point of left needle into the fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together from this position.

NOTE: Throw is made up of 5 strips, worked in 5 different color blocks each. The strips are then sewn together.

## THROW

Working in Garter st (k every row) work strips as follows:
Strip 1: With knitting needles and E, cast on 27 sts.
Work color blocks as follow: 54 rows $\mathbf{E}, 54$ rows $\mathbf{G}, 54$ rows $\mathbf{A}, 54$ rows $\mathbf{G}, 54$ rows $\mathbf{B}$.
Strip 2: With G, cast on as for strip 1. Work color blocks as follows: 54 rows $\mathbf{G}, 54$ rows $\mathbf{C}, 54$ rows $\mathbf{G}, 54$ rows $\mathbf{F}, 54$ rows $\mathbf{G}$. Bind off.
Strip 3: With D, cast on as for strip 1. Work color blocks as follows: 54 rows D, 54 rows G, 54 rows D, 54 rows G, 54 rows $\mathbf{D}$. Bind off.
Strip 4: With G, cast on as for strip 1. Work color blocks as follows: 54 rows $\mathbf{G}, 54$ rows $\mathbf{F}, 54$ rows $\mathbf{G}, 54$ rows C, 54 rows $\mathbf{G}$. Bind off.
Strip 5: With B, cast on as for strip 1. Work color blocks as follows: 54 rows B, 54 rows $\mathbf{G}, 54$ rows A, 54 rows $\mathbf{G}, 54$ rows $E$. Bind off.

## FINISHING

Arrange strips in numerical order from left to right. Sew edges together.

## Side Borders

Row 1: With right side facing and G, pick up and k 27 sts in each block along one long side of throw-135 sts.
Work 4 rows in Garter st. Bind off. Repeat border along remaining long side of throw.
Top and Bottom Borders
With right side facing and G, pick up and knit 6 sts in side border, 27 sts in each square along cast on edge of throw, and 6 sts in side border-147 sts. Work as for side borders. Repeat border along bound off edge. Bind off. Weave in ends.

## CREATURES (Make 2 of each) <br> CRAB <br> Bobble Eyes (Make 2)

With knitting needles and $\mathbf{B}$, cast on 1 st loosely, leaving a 12" tail.
Row 1: K in front and back of st 5 times- 10 sts.
Rows 2 and 4: Purl.
Row 3: Knit.
Row 5: [K2tog] 5 times-5sts.
Row 6: P2tog, p1, p2tog-3 sts.

Row 7: Slip 1, k2tog, psso-1 st. Fasten off last st, leaving long tail.
With G, embroider eye ball in center of bobble eye. Gather, stuffing strands of $\mathbf{G}$ inside. Use crochet hook to pull both tails of B to bottom of eye, Chain 4 sts for stalk of eye, fasten off.

## Body

With knitting needles and B, cast on 8 sts.
Next Row (wrong side): Purl.
Next Row: K1, m1, k across to last st, m1, k1-10 sts.
Repeat last 2 rows two times more-14 sts.
Work even in St st until piece measures $41 / 2 "$ from
beginning, ending with a wrong side row.
Next Row: K2tog, $k$ to end-13 sts.
Next Row: Purl.
Repeat last 2 rows until 8 sts remain.
Bind off, leaving long tail.
With G, embroider mouth with chain stitch.

## Large Legs (Make 2)

With dpns and B, cast on 9 sts, leaving 8 " tail.
Work back and forth in rows of St st for $1^{\prime \prime}$, ending with
a right side row. Do not turn. Continue leg in I-Cord, and work 1 row even.
Next Row (Dec): K2tog, $k$ to last 2 sts, k2tog-7 sts.
Work even for 3".
Next Row: Repeat Dec Row-5 sts.
Work even for 1".
Next Row: Repeat Dec Row-3 sts.
Work 2 rows even.
Next Row: Slip 1, k2tog, psso-1 st. Bind off, leaving long tail.

## Middle Legs (Make 2)

With dpns and B, cast on 7 sts, leaving 8" tail.
Knit 1 row. Do not turn. Continue leg in I-Cord, and work even for 3".
Next Row (Dec): K2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog.-5 sts.**
Work even for 2".
Next Row: Repeat Dec Row-3 sts.
K 2 rows even.
Next Row: Slip 1, k2tog, psso-1 st. Bind off, leaving long tail.

## Small Legs (Make 2)

Work same as for Middle Legs to **
Work even for 1 ".
Complete same as for Middle Legs.

## Finishing

Sew stalks of eyes to throw. Sew legs to body. Place body just over stalks and sew in place, leaving legs free and a small opening along bottom. Stuff body lightly, and sew opening.

## STARFISH

## Legs (Make 5)

With dpns and E, cast on 3 sts leaving long tail. Work back and forth in rows in St st:
Row 1: Knit.
Rows 2, 4, 6, and 8: Purl.
Rows 3, 5, 7: K1, inc, $k$ to last st, inc, k1-9 sts.
Next Row: Knit. Do not turn. Continue leg in l-Cord, and work 2 rows even.
Next Row: * K2tog, $k$ to last 2 sts, k2tog-7 sts.
Work 7 rows even.
Repeat from * two times more-3 sts.
Work 3 rows even.
Next Row: Slip 1, k2tog, psso-1 st. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew the tops of legs together as shown in photo. Attach to throw.

## OCTOPUS

## Legs (Make 8)

With dpns and F, cast on 4 sts.
Knit 1 row even. Do not turn. Continue leg in I-Cord, and work even for $43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. As legs are completed do not bind off, slip sts onto 2 spare dpns, 4 legs each.

## Body

Arrange dpns parallel with each other so that wrong sides of legs are together. With knitting needle, k1 from front needle, $k$ the first st from each needle tog across both needles to last st, k1.-17 sts. Working back and forth in rows in St st, knit 7 rows even.
Next Row (Inc) (right side): K3, M1, k to last 3 sts, M1, k3-19 sts.
Work 3 rows even.
Next Row: Repeat Inc Row-21sts.
Next Row: Purl.
Repeat last 2 rows once more-23 sts.
Next Row: P1, p2tog, p to last 3 sts, p2tog-tbl, p1-21 sts
Next Row: K1, ssk, $k$ to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.
Repeat last two rows 8 times more. Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends. Refer to chart, duplicate stitch eyes and embroider mouth. Sew body to throw, stuffing lightly.

## SEAHORSE

## Tail

With dpns and D, cast on 3 sts.
Slide sts to end of needle, continue in l-Cord, and work even for 1 ".
Next Row: * Knit to last st, inc, k1-4 sts.
Work even for 1". Repeat from * 3 times more-7 sts. Inc 1 st on left side every other row 5 times-12 sts.
Work 4 rows even.

## Chest

Next Row: K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1-11 sts.
Repeat last row 5 times more-6 sts.

## Head

Next Row: K1, inc, $k$ to last st, inc, k1-8 sts.
Next Row: Knit.
Repeat last 2 rows once more-10 sts.
Next Row: K to last st, inc, k1-11 sts.
Next Row (Dec): K2tog, $k$ to last 2 sts, k2tog-9 sts.
Repeat Dec Row 3 times more-3 sts. Thread yarn through remaining sts and pull tightly to secure. leaving tail for assembly.

## Mouth

Pick up and k3 sts in center at left side of head. K 4 rows of I-Cord; thread yarn through sts and fasten off.

## Fin

Pick up and k6 sts on right side of body below head.
Next Row (Inc): K1, inc in each st to last st, k1-10 sts.
Work 1 row even.
Repeat Inc Row once more-18 sts. Bind off.
Roll tail up towards belly and secure. Embroider eye with black yarn. Attach to throw, stuffing lightly.

## FISH

Body
With knitting needles and $\mathbf{D}$, cast on 9 sts.
Row 1 (right side): Begin St st, k even across.
Row 2: Inc in each of first 2 sts, $p$ to last 2 sts, inc in each of last 2 sts-13 sts.
Row 3: Inc in each of first 2 sts, $k$ to last st, inc, $k 1-16$ sts.
Row 4: Inc, $p$ to last 2 sts, inc in each of last 2 sts-19 sts.
Row 5: Repeat Row 3-22 sts.
Row 6: Inc, p to last st, inc, p1-24 sts.
Row 7: Inc, $k$ to end-25 sts.
Row 8: Repeat Row 6-27 sts.
Row 9: Inc, $k$ to last st, inc, k1-29 sts.
Row 10: Inc, $p$ to end-30 sts.
Row 11: $K$ to last st, inc, k1-31 sts.

Row 12: $P$ to last st, inc, $p 1-32$ sts.
Row 13: Repeat Row 11-33 sts.
Row 14: Repeat Row 12-34 sts.
Row 15: Repeat Row 7-35 sts.
Row 16: Repeat Row 12-36 sts.
Row 17: Repeat Row 9-38 sts.
Row 18: Inc, p to end, cast on 2 sts- 41 sts.
Row 19: Repeat Row 9-43 sts.
Row 20: $P$ to last 2 sts, inc in each of last 2 sts- 45 sts.
Row 21: Repeat Row 7-46 sts.
Row 22: Purl.
Row 23: K2tog, $k$ to end-45 sts.
Row 24: $P$ to last 2 sts, p2tog-44 sts.
Row 25: K2tog, k33; join second ball of yarn and bind off next st, k to last 2 sts, k2tog-41 sts.
Row 26: P2tog, p1, [p2tog] twice; with first ball p2tog, $p$ to last 4 sts, [p2tog] twice. -35 sts.
Row 27: Bind off 3 sts, k1, k2tog, $k$ to last 4 sts of first ball, [k2tog] twice; with second ball bind off 4 sts-25 sts.
Row 28: Working with first ball, p2tog, p to last 2 sts, p2tog-23 sts.
Row 29: K2tog, $k$ to last 3 sts, k3tog-20 sts.
Row 30: Bind off 3 sts, $p$ to last 4 sts, [p2 tog] twice-15 sts.
Row 31: Inc, $k$ to last 4 sts, [k2tog] twice-14 sts.
Row 32: $P$ to last st, inc, $p 1-15$ sts.
Row 33: Cast on 2 sts at beginning of row; $k$ across, cast on 4 sts at end of row-21 sts.
Row 34: Inc in each of first 2 sts, $p$ to last st, inc, p1-24 sts.
Row 35: Inc, $k$ to last 2 sts, inc in each of last 2 sts. -27 sts.
Row 36: P15, join second ball of yarn, bind off 2 sts, $p$ across, cast on 2 sts at end of row-27 sts.
Row 37: Inc, k6, [k2tog] twice; with second ball bind off 3 sts, $k$ to last 2 sts, k2tog-22 sts.
Row 38: P2tog, p3, [p2tog]3 times; with second ball [p2tog] twice, p to end-16 sts.
Row 39: K2tog, k2, [k2tog] twice, bind off second ball.
Row 40: Bind off first ball.
Fin
Stripe Sequence: 2 rows $\mathbf{C}$; 1 row $\mathbf{G} ; 2$ rows $\mathbf{A ;} 1$ row $\mathbf{G}$; 2 rows D; 1 row $\mathbf{G} ; 2$ rows $\mathbf{C}$
Repeat for stripe sequence.
With knitting needles and C, cast on 4 sts.
Row 1 (right side): Begin St st and Stripe Sequence, $k$ to end.
Row 2 and all wrong side rows: Purl.
Row 3: K1, inc, $k$ to last st, inc, k1-6 sts.
Row 5, 7: Repeat Row 3 two times more-10 sts.
Row 9: K8, inc, $k$ to end-11 sts.
Row 11: $\mathrm{K} 1, \mathrm{k} 2$ tog, k to end-10 sts.
Row 12: P6, p2tog, p1-9 sts.
Bind off leaving long tail. Pin fin $1^{\prime \prime}$ from side and $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from
top, sew in place. With black, embroider eye and mouth. Sew to throw, stuffing lightly.

## DOLPHIN

## Ball

With knitting needles and $\mathbf{E}$, cast on 1 st loosely.
Row 1: K into front and back of st 5 times -10 sts.
Rows 2 and 4: Purl.
Row 3: Knit.
Row 5: K1, [ssk] twice, [k2tog] twice, k1-6 sts.
Row 6: * P2tog; repeat from * to end-3 sts.
Row 7: Slip 1, k2tog, psso-1 st.
Fasten off leaving long tail. Thread tail through sts around edge. Gather and stuff.

## Body

First Half of Tail
With knitting needles and C, cast on 2 sts. Begin St st with a k row, work 2 rows even. Inc 1 st at beginning of next 2 rows4 sts. Inc 1 st at end of next 2 rows -6 sts. K 1 row even.
Next Row: Inc, p4, inc, p to end, cast on 2 sts at end of row-10 sts. Cut yarn and slip sts to stitch holder.

## Second Half of Tail

With C, cast on 2 sts. Begin St st with k row, work 2 rows even. Inc 1 st at end of next row-3 sts. Work 1 row even. Inc 1 st at end of next row-4 sts.
Next Row: Cast on 2 sts at beginning of row, turn; p6. Slip sts from holder onto same needle with right side facing and continue over 16 sts as follows:
Row 9: Ssk, k to end-15 sts.
Row 10: Purl.
Row 11: Knit.
Row 12: $P$ to last 3 sts, $p 2$ tog, $p 1-14$ sts
Row 13: $K$ to last 3 sts, k2tog, $k 1-13$ sts.
Row 14: $\mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{p} 2$ tog, $p$ to last 3 sts, p2tog, $\mathrm{p} 1-11$ sts.
Row 15: K 1 , ssk, $k$ to end-10 sts.
Row 16: P2tog, p to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1-8 sts.
Rows 17-18: Repeat Rows 10-11.
Row 19: Repeat Row 13-7 sts.
Row 20: Repeat Row 12-6 sts.
Row 21-22: Repeat Rows 10-11
Row 23: Inc, $k$ to end-7 sts.
Row 24 and 26: Purl.
Row 25: $K$ to last st, inc, k1-8 sts.
Row 27: Repeat Row 23-9 sts.
Row 28: Inc, p to end-10 sts.
Set up color pattern
Row 29: K2 G, k8 C.
Row 30: K8 C, K1 G, inc, k1-11 sts.
Keeping continuity of color pattern as established
throughout, continue shaping tail as follows:
Rows 31: Inc, k3; k to last st, inc, k1-13 sts.
Row 32: Purl
Row 33: K to last st, inc, k1-14 sts.
Row 34: $P$ to last st, inc, p1-15 sts.
Row 35 - 36: Work even.
Row 37: Inc, $k$ to end-16 sts.
Rows 38 and 39: Work even.
Row 40: P2tog, $p$ to last st, inc, p1-16 sts.
Row 41: Knit.
Row 42: P2tog, $p$ to end-15 sts.
Row 43: Work even.
Row 44: P2tog, p to last st, with C inc, p1-15 sts.
Row 45-46: Work even.
Row 47: Work even, cut G.
Row 48: With second ball of $\mathbf{C}$ cast on 3 sts onto empty needle, turn, p3, turn, k3, cast on 2 sts; with first ball p15-20 sts.
Row 49: K14, inc; cut second ball; $k$ to last st, inc, k1-22 sts.
Row 50: Purl.
Row 51: K2tog, $k$ to last 2 sts, k2tog-20 sts.
Row 52: P2tog, $p$ to last 2 sts, p2tog-18 sts.
Row 53: Repeat Row 51-16 sts.
Row 54: P2tog, $p$ to end-15 sts.
Rows 55-58: Repeat Rows 51 and 52 once more- 11 sts.
Rows 59: [K2tog] twice, k3, [k2tog] twice-7 sts.
Bind off pwise. With black yarn, embroider eye and blow hole.

## NOTE

Take care not to pull yarn around too tightly while working fin and flippers in I-Cord, so that pieces lay flat.

## Fin and Flippers

Dorsal Fin
With dpns and C, cast on 7 sts.
Work back and forth in rows in St st for 2 rows. Do not turn.
Continue in l-Cord, dec 1 st at end of next 4 rows-3 sts.
Next Row: Slip 1, k2tog, psso. Fasten off last st. Sew to top behind blow hole.

## Right Flipper

With dpns and C cast on 3 sts
Work 1 row even. Do not turn. Continue in l-Cord, inc 1 st at end of next 4 rows-7 sts.
Next Row: Slip 1, k2tog, psso, k3tog-3 sts.
Row 7: Slip 1, k2tog, psso. Fasten off last st. Sew to right hand side of dolphin.

## Left Flipper

With dpns and $\mathbf{C}$, beginning on the left side, under chin of dolphin, pick up and knit 7 sts. Turn and $p$ to end. Slide sts

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to end of needle and continue flipper in l-Cord.
Rows 1-3: Inc, k to last 2 sts, k2tog-7 sts.
Rows 4 and 5: Ssk, $k$ to last 2 sts, k2tog-5 sts.
Row 6: Ssk, slip 1, k2tog, psso-3 sts.
Row 7: Slip 1, k2tog, psso. Fasten off remaining st. Attach to throw, stuffing lightly.

## I-Cord Instructions

With double pointed needles, cast on number of sts as indicated in pattern.* Knit across ; do not turn, but slip sts to the other end of needle; repeat from *.
