



**GAUGE:** 15 sts = 4"; 28 rows = 4" in Garter st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

**SCARF**

With **A**, cast on 19 sts.

**\*\*Row 1 (Right Side):** K2, yo, [k5, yo] 3 times, k2–23 sts. Work even in Garter st (knit every row) until piece measures 6" from beginning, end by working a right side row.

**Next Row:** K2, drop next stitch from needle and unravel down to the yo made on Row 1, [k5, drop next stitch from needle and unravel down to the yo made on Row 1,] 3 times, k2–19 sts. Cut **A**, join **B**.\*\*\*

With **B**, work even in Garter st for 6", end by working a wrong side row. Cut **B**, join **A**. \*\*

Repeat from \*\* to \*\* 3 times more, then repeat from \*\* to \*\*\* 1 time. Bind off in **A**.

**FINISHING**

Weave in yarn ends.

**Scarf measures:** 5½" x 64".

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:** 1 skein each 387 Soft Navy **A** and 319 Cherry Red **B**.

**Knitting Needles:** 6mm [US 10].  
Yarn needle.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **A, B** = color A, B; **k** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over; **\*\*** or **\*\*\*** = repeat whatever follows the **\*\*** or **\*\*\*** as indicated; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
