

## Simple Knit Scarf

This easy scarf is Garter Stitch with yarn overs that are unraveled to form stripes in the navy sections.

Make it in your favorite shades or team colors.

Scarf measures: 51/2" x 64".

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 387 Soft

Navy A and 319 Cherry Red B.

Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10].

Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 15 sts = 4"; 28 rows = 4" in Garter st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.** 

## **SCARF**

With A, cast on 19 sts.

\*\*Row 1 (Right Side): K2, yo, [k5, yo] 3 times, k2–23 sts. Work even in Garter st (knit every row) until piece measures 6" from beginning, end by working a right side row.

**Next Row:** K2, drop next stitch from needle and unravel down to the yo made on Row 1, [k5, drop next stitch from needle and unravel down to the yo made on Row 1,] 3 times, k2–19 sts. Cut **A**, join **B**.\*\*\*

With **B**, work even in Garter st for 6", end by working a wrong side row. Cut **B**, join **A**. \*\*

Repeat from \*\* to \*\* 3 times more, then repeat from \*\* to \*\*\* 1 time. Bind off in **A**.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in yarn ends.



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins.

**ABBREVIATIONS: A, B** = color A, B; **k** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over; \*\* or \*\*\* = repeat whatever follows the \*\* or \*\*\* as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
