What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 311 White A, 718 Shocking Pink B, 319 Cherry Red C, 254 Pumpkin D, 324 Bright Yellow E, 672 Spring Green F, 347 Lt. Periwinkle G, 358 Lavender H, 312 Black I

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 3.75mm [US F-5]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in single crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Snowman Garland

Brighten your home during the long winter with these happy crocheted snowmen. We've shown them in a rainbow of hat and scarf colors that will certainly add a happy note to a wintry day. Each Snowman measures 3½" [9 cm] at widest point x 7" [18 cm] tall.

NOTE

Directions are for 7 Snowmen. Each Snowman is made with two body pieces. Details are worked separately and sewn on. Snowmen are then sewn on to a chain stitch garland.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

sc2tog: [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

sc3tog: [Draw up a loop in next st] 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

SNOWMAN (Make 14, 2 for each Snowman)

With A. ch 9.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 8 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in last sc - 10 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in last sc - 12 sc.

Rows 4-7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog – 10 sc.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc3tog, sc in next 4 sc, sc3tog – 6 sc.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in last sc – 8 sc.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in last sc - 10 sc.

Rows 12-14: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 15: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog – 8 sc.

Row 16: Ch 1, turn, sc3tog, sc in next 2 sc, sc3tog – 4 sc.

Row 17: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc – 6 sc.

Row 18: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in last sc – 8 sc.

Rows 19-21: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Row 22: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc,

Row 23: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog – 4 sc.

Row 24: Ch 1, turn, [sc2tog] twice – 2 sc. Fasten off.

NOSE (Make 7)

With **D**, ch 2.

sc2tog – 6 sc.

Round 1: Work 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook – 4 sc.

Round 2: Working in continuous rounds, sc in each sc.

Round 3: [Work 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] twice, slip st in first sc to join. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

ARM (Make 14, 2 for each snowman)

With **D**, ch 10, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and next 2 ch, ch 4, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and next 2 ch, ch 4, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and next 2 ch, slip st in remaining 6 ch of beginning ch-10. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

Please Note: Print this pattern using Landscape Orientation.

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HAT (Make 7 total, 1 each in colors B, C, D, E, F, G and H)

With desired color, ch 2.

Row 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, slip st in first sc to join -6 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around, slip st in first sc – 12 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, [sc in next st, 2 sc in next st] 6 times, slip st in first sc - 18 sc.

Rows 4-7: Ch 1, sc in each st around, slip st in first sc.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

POMPOM (make 7 total in colors to match each Hat)

Wrap yarn around two fingers ten times. Tie matching yarn around middle to secure tightly. Cut loops open and trim ends. Sew one matching Pompom to each Hat.

SCARF (Make 7 total in colors to match each Hat)

Ch 41, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off.
Tie short lengths at each end for fringe.

FINISHING

Following photo and with I, whipstitch eyes and front buttons to 7 Snowmen for front pieces. Sew Nose to each face.
With wrong sides together, hold front piece and second back piece of Snowman together, join A alongside edge with a sc, working through both layers, sc evenly around Snowman to join front and back pieces together. Repeat to make 7 Snowmen. Sew Hat to top of head on each Snowman. Tie matching Scarf around each Snowman's neck. Sew an Arm on either side of each Snowman. Weave in ends.

Garland

With **A**, make a ch for 60" [152 cm] long or desired length. Slip st in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off. Arrange Snowmen evenly spaced along Garland and tack in place.

Abbreviations

A, **B**, **C** = Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.



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
