What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 3620 Glowworm **A** and 312 Black **B**

Susan Bates® Knitting
Needles: 4mm [US 6]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 18 sts = 4" [10 cm];
24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in
Stockinette stitch. **CHECK**
YOUR GAUGE. Use any size
needles to obtain the gauge.

BUY YARN



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yds (333 m); stripes, prints, multis and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yds (215 m); flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Spooky Frankenstein Jar Cozy

Here's the perfect jar cozy for your Halloween treats! It's easily knit with a rib stitch and given personality with simple embroidery stitches.

Cozy to fit quart size Mason jar

PATTERN STITCHES

K1, p1 Rib (multiple of 2 sts)

Row 1: [K1, p1] to end of row.

Repeat Row 1 for K1, p1 rib.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

kfb: Knit 1 front and back (increase) Knit next st, then knit it through back loop.

COZY

Beginning at bottom edge, cast on 44 sts with **A**.

Work in K1, p1 rib until piece measures 4½" [11.5 cm] from beginning, end with a right side row.

Knit 1 row on wrong side.

Change to **B**.

Knit 1 row.

Work in K1, p1 rib until piece measures 5½" [14 cm] from beginning.

Bind off knitwise.

FINISHING

Sew side edges for back seam.

Embroidery


Note: It may be easier to work embroidery while Cozy is on the jar. Refer to photo for placements.

Use a double strand of **B** and back stitch to embroider horizontal eyebrow across front in **A** section for 2½" [6.5 cm], about 4 rows down from **B** section. Use satin stitch to embroider two eyes evenly spaced directly under eyebrow. Work mouth in straight stitches with **B**. Use single strand of **B** and straight stitches to work nose and scar. Work little straight stitches across scar.

EAR (make 2)

With **A**, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1: Kfb, k1, kfb - 5 sts.



Satin Stitch

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: K1, k2tog - 3 sts.

Bind off, leaving a long end for sewing. Sew an Ear on either side of head.

BOLT (make 2)

With **B**, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1: [Kfb] 3 times - 6 sts.

Row 2: Knit.

Cut yarn and draw through all sts on needle. Pull tightly to gather and secure end. Sew side edges. Sew a Bolt on either side of head.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; **cm** = centimeters; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
