What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\text {® }}$ 1 skein each 0400 Grey Heather A, 387 Soft Navy B, 3945 Blue Suede C, 381 Light Blue D, and 311 White E

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Stitch marker, pompom maker yarn needle

GAUGE: $11 \mathrm{dc}=4$ " [10 cm]; 6 rows $=4$ " [10 cm] in double crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\text {® }}$, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); prints, multis and heathers 5 oz ( 141 g ), 236 yd ( 215 m ), flecks 5 oz (141g), 260 yds ( 238 m ) skeins


## Striping Shells Hat

This pompom-topped hat makes crocheting an ombré effect with your favorite color family a breeze!

## Pattern re-written as of 1-31-17

Hat circumference at bottom edge: 20 (22)" $[51 \mathrm{~cm}$ (56) cm]

Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Large are in parentheses

## NOTE

Hat is worked in joined rounds with right side facing throughout.
Carry color not in use along wrong side of work.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

dc2tog: [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all loops on hook
dc3tog: [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 3 times yarn over, draw through all loops on hook
Fpdc: (front post double crochet) Yarn over, insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice. Skip st behind the Fpdc.
Shell: Work 5 dc in same stitch or space.

## HAT

With A, ch 54 (60), taking care not to twist sts, slip st in first ch to form a ring Place marker for beginning of round. Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in each chain around, slip st in top of beginning ch-3 to join 54 (60) dc.
Rounds 2-4: Ch 3, Fpdc in next st, *dc in next st, Fpdc; repeat from * around, slip st in top of beginning ch-3. Do not cut A. There was a typo here of an extra dc after the Fpdc.
Round 5: Change to B, ch 1 , sc in same st, *skip 2 sts, Shell in next st, skip 2 sts, sc in next st; repeat from * around to last 5 sts, skip 2 sts, Shell in next st, skip

2 sts, slip st in first sc - 9 (10) Shells with a sc in between each Shell. Cut B
Round 6: Change to A, ch 3, dc in st below first sc on Round 4, *ch 2, sc in 3rd dc of Shell, ch 2, 2 dc in st on Round 4 below next sc; repeat from * around to last Shell, ch 2, sc in 3rd dc of Shell, ch 2, slip st in top of beginning ch-3. 2 dc will be worked in st in row below sc between Shells to cover sc completely. This allows the contrasting colored Shell to "pop" out of main color.
Round 7: Ch 2, dc in next st (counts as dc2tog), *dc in each of next $2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{dc}$ in next sc, dc in each of next $2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{dc} 2$ tog; repeat from * to last 5 sts, dc in each of next $2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{dc}$ in next sc, dc in each of next 2 ch , slip st in first dc -54 (60) dc You will be working dc2tog over the 2 dc of previous row. This will return your st count to 54 ( 60 sts).
Round 8: Change to $\mathbf{C}$ and repeat Round 5. Cut C.

Round 9: Change to $\mathbf{A}, \mathrm{ch} 3$, dc in corresponding st in round below first sc, *ch 2, sc in 3rd dc of Shell, ch 2, 2 dc in corresponding st in round below next sc; repeat from * around to last Shell, ch 2, sc in 3 rd dc of Shell, ch 2, slip st in top of beginning ch-3. This is the same as Round 6, working the 2 dc in the st in the row below previous row to cover the sc of the previous row.
Round 10: Repeat Round 7.
Round 11: Change to D and repeat Round 5. Cut D.
Rounds 12-13: Change to $\mathbf{A}$ and repeat Rounds 9-10.
Round 14: Change to $\mathbf{E}$ and repeat Round 5. Cut E.
continued.


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Round 15-16: Change to $\mathbf{A}$ and repeat Rounds 9-10.
Round 17: Ch 2, dc2tog over next 2 sts (counts as first dc3tog here and throughout), dc in next 3 sts, *dc3tog over next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts; repeat from * 7 (8) more times, slip st in first dc2tog - 36 (40) sts.
Round 18: Ch 2, dc2tog over next 2 sts, *dc in next st, dc3tog over next 3 sts; repeat from * to last st, dc in last st, slip st in first dc2tog-18 (20) sts.
Round 19: Ch 2 (does not count as a st),
(dc3tog) 6 times, dc in each st to end of round if necessary, slip st in first dc3tog. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

## FINISHING

Using long tail, weave end through top of last row and pull to close. Secure end. Weave in ends.
With White, make a $4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ diameter pompom. Sew pompom on top of Hat.

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; $\mathbf{m m}$ $=$ millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) $=$ stitch(es); tog = together; * or ${ }^{* *}=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.


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
