What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:
1 skein each 722 Pretty n' Pink, 373 Petal Pink and 705 Grenadine

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5.5 mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

Gauge: Gauge is not important for this project.

RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yds (333 m); stripes, prints, multis and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yds (215 m); flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Sweet Hearts

These sweet little hearts have so many possibilities, and they are easy to make! We've included 8 photos so beginners can see exactly how this heart is made in just one round!

Heart measures: 2" [5 cm] wide x 1½" [4 cm] tall.

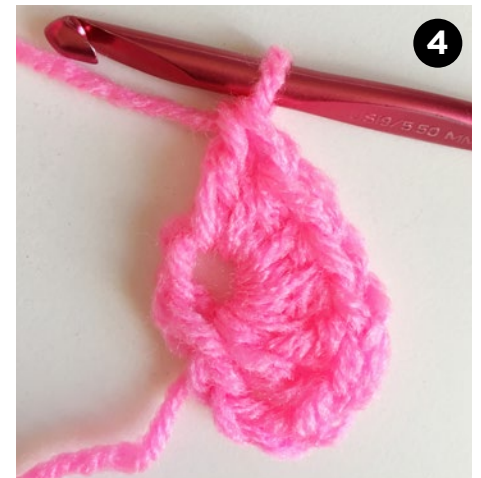
Note: One sweet heart is worked in a single round.

SWEET HEART (Make 3 in each color)

Using the photo as a guide, make a slip knot and place it on the hook. Chain 3. Slip stitch in first ch to form a ring.



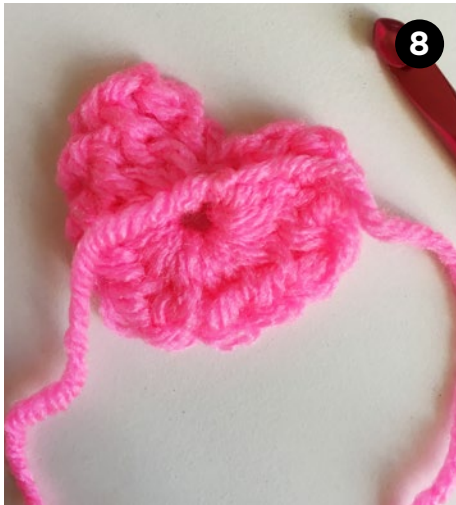
Round 1 (photos 2 to 7): Ch 3, work 2 dc in ring, 3 hdc in ring, dc in ring, 3 hdc in ring, 2 dc in ring, ch 3, slip st in ring.



continued...



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Fasten off and cut yarn. Tie the beginning tail and end tail together on the back of the heart.



Finishing

Weave in yarn ends.

A = Color A; B = Color B; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **ch** = chain; **sc** = single crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **ch** = chain
