What you will need: RED HEART ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\circledR}$ : 2 skeins each 3901 Rouge C and 726 Coral D, 1 skein each 321 Gold A, 774 Light Raspberry B, and 3950 Charcoal E

Susan Bates ${ }^{\bullet}$ Crochet Hook: 6.5 mm [US K-10 $1 / 2$ ]

Yarn needle, 16" ( 40.5 cm ) square pillow form

GAUGE: Rounds 1-3 = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Buy Yarn

RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd ( 333 m ); prints, multis and heathers $5 \mathrm{oz}(141 \mathrm{~g})$, 236 yd ( 215 m ), flecks $5 \mathrm{oz}(141 \mathrm{~g})$, 260 yds ( 238 m ) skeins


## Times Square Pillow and Throw

Use dramatic bright shades and add a wonderful pop of color to your life. Or change the mood with whatever colors you desire. You'll love these big granny squares. They are quick to crochet with a decidedly modern approach.

## Pillow measures 16 " x 16" (40.5 x 40.5

 cm).Throw measures 42 " $\times 42$ " ( $106.5 \times 106.5$ cm).

## PILLOW

Sides (make 2)
With A, ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
Round 1 (right side): Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 2 dc in ring, *ch 3,3 dc in ring; repeat from * twice, ch 3; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-12 dc and $4 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces.
Round 2: Slip st in next 2 dc , (slip st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in first ch-3 space, ${ }^{*}$ ch 1 , ( 3 dc ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch -3 space; repeat from * twice, ch 1 ; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-24 $\mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}-1$ spaces, and 4 ch-3 spaces.
Round 3: Slip st in next 2 dc , (slip st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3,3 dc) in first ch-3 space, *ch 1,3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1 , ( 3 dc, ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-3 space; repeat from * twice, ch 1,3 dc in last ch-1 space, ch 1 ; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-36 dc, $8 \mathrm{ch}-1$ spaces, and $4 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces. Fasten off.
Round 4: With right side facing, join B with slip st in any ch-3 space, (ch 3,2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in same space, *(ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in each ch-1 space to next ch-3 space, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3,3 dc) in next ch-3 space; repeat from * twice, (ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in each ch- 1 space to beginning ch, ch 1 ; join with slip st in top of beginning ch $-48 \mathrm{dc}, 12 \mathrm{ch}-1$ spaces, and $4 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces. Rounds 5-8: Slip st in next 2 dc , (slip st, ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in first ch-3 space, *(ch 1, 3 dc ) in each ch- 1 space to next ch-3 space, ch 1 , ( 3 dc, ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-3 space; repeat from *twice, (ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in each ch-1 space to beginning ch, ch 1 ; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.
Fasten off.

Rounds 9-12: With C, repeat Rounds 4-7. Fasten off.
Rounds 13 and 14: With D, repeat Rounds 4 and 5.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING PILLOW

Weave in ends.
Joining Round: With wrong sides held together and working through both thicknesses, join $\mathbf{E}$ with slip st in any ch-3 space, (ch 3, 2 dc , ch 3, 3 dc ) in same space, *(ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in each ch-1 space to next ch-3 space, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc ) in next ch-3 space; repeat from * twice, insert pillow form, (ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in each remaining ch-1 space to beginning ch, ch 1 ; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off. Weave in remaining ends.

## THROW

## Squares (make 4)

Rounds 1-12: Work same as Rounds 1-12 of pillow side.
Rounds 13-15: With D, repeat Rounds 4-6. Fasten off.

## FINISHING THROW

Sew squares together to form large square. Edging
Round 1 (right side): With D, repeat Rounds 4-6.
Fasten off.
Continued...


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Rounds 4 and 5: With E, repeat Rounds 4 and 5.
Fasten off.
Fringe (make 4 - 1 each with $\mathbf{A}, \mathbf{B}, \mathbf{C}$, and $\mathbf{D}$ ) Cut twelve 24 -inch strands of yarn. Fold hank in half. Insert crochet hook from front to back in any corner ch-3 space. Place fold on hook and draw fold through, forming a loop. Thread ends of strands through loop and pull to tighten. Repeat to attach fringe in remaining corner ch-3 spaces. Trim ends evenly.
Weave in ends.

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.;
$\mathbf{c h}=$ chain(s); dc = double crochet;
$\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); ( ) = work directions in parentheses into same st; * $=$ repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
