What you will need:

RED HEART[®] Super Saver[®]: 3 skeins 3977 Lapis

Susan Bates* Circular Knitting Needles: 5mm [US 8] 36" [91.5cm]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 11½ sts = 4" [10 cm]; 15 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Lace stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

BUY YARN

RED HEART* Super Saver*, Art. E300 available in solid

MEDIUM available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yds (333 m); prints, multis and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yds (215 m); flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238m) skeins



Triangle Tassel Shawl

This long, skinny shawl is a fun way to keep warm, either inside with a cup of tea, or outside tucked into your favorite coat. The tassels on each point add a touch of whimsy, but feel free to leave them off if that's not your style. Shawl measures 96" [244 cm] wide x18" [45.5 cm] deep

NOTE

A circular needle is used to accommodate large number of stitches; do not join.

STITCH PATTERN Lace

Row 1 (Right Side): *K1, k1 in the stitch below; repeat from * to last st, knit 1 Row 2 (Wrong Side): K1, slip 1, ssk, pass slipped stitch over, knit to last 4 stitches, k3tog, k1.

Row 3: *K1 in the stitch below, k1; repeat from * to last st, k1 in the stitch below. Row 4: Repeat Row 2.

SHAWL

Cast on 275 stitches. Work Lace pattern until 3 sts remain, ending after a RS row. Bind off.

TASSELS (make 3)

Cut twenty-five 6" [15 cm] strands and one 12" [30.5 cm] strand of yarn. Put all 6" strands together and tie in center with the 12" strand. Fold 6" strands down over tie and tie again, with 12" strand, about ½" [1 cm] down from fold. Trim tassel if necessary.

Finishing

Sew a tassel to each corner of the shawl. Weave in all ends

ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeters; K = knit; k3tog =
knit next 3 stitches together; mm =
millimeters; P = purl; st(s) = stitch(es);
ssk = slip, slip, knit
